Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the penultimate contest in a six-game series at the Fort Wayne TinCaps, the High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. The Lugnuts won the series opener, but Fort Wayne has prevailed the last three nights. Today is the 428th all-time meeting between Lansing and Fort Wayne.

Starting Matchup: Native Indianan right-hander Jack Perkins, the Athletics' fifth-round selection in 2022 from Indiana and No. 30 A's prospect, starts in front of his family and friends against Padres No. 7 prospect Victor Lizarraga, who signed for \$1 million as an international free agent in 2021.

Last Night: TinCaps 1, Lugnuts 0 (10 innings). In two hours and 14 minutes, a fine pitchers' duel ended with a Joshua Mears opposite-field RBI double in the bottom of the 10th inning, giving the TinCaps a walk-off win in their first extra-inning game of the year.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with John Nolan, and via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and TinCaps wrap up this series tomorrow, enjoy a day off on Memorial Day, and then Lansing returns to Jackson Field to host the Cedar Rapids Kernels.

Lug•Notes

Home / Road Splits: At home, the Lugnuts are outhitting the opposition by a .255 to .235 avg. (though they've been outscored by 25 runs), but on the road, the disparity is .214 to .277 (and they've been outscored by 18 runs). The biggest contrasts among players: **Danny** Bautista, Jr., is hitting .315 at home compared to .180 on the road, Daniel Susac is batting .329 at home (with a .404 OBP and .544 SLG) compared to .237/.318/.322 away from Lansing, and Jack Winkler is hitting .301 with a .402 OBP at home while batting .159 with a .256 OBP away from Michigan's state capital.

Keep it Down: The Nuts lead the MWL with a 1.16 GO/AO ratio and 36 ground-ball double plays turned, including two more yesterday.

And Keep it Clean: Yesterday was Lansing's 22nd error-free game out of 43 total games played this season. The Nuts have committed only one error in the last seven games and have 31 total errors this year, tied for second lowest in the league.

A Matter of Days: The Lugnuts' loss yesterday dropped the ballclub to 1-6 on Fridays, a day in which they're hitting .199, have a 6.75 ERA, and have been outscored 48-24. But on Saturdays, the Nuts are 4-1 this year with a .262 batting average (compared to the opponent's .195 avg.) and have outscored the opposition 22-21. (The run differential is as close as it because of an 11-0 loss to Dayton on May 6, the only Saturday defeat of the year.)

Soder Pop: 2022 Nuts prospect Tyler Soderstrom blasted two home runs for Triple-A Las Vegas in a 12-11 victory last night over Tacoma. The 21-year-old Soderstrom is now slashing .274/.324/.549 for Las Vegas with 13 doubles, one triple and 10 home runs.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

In a Nutshell: One of five 2022 draftees on the roster, joining Daniel Susac, Clark Elliott, Jacob Watters and Jake Garland... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Lugnuts teammate Blake Beers and such other notables as Max Schuemann (promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas), Jeff Criswell (traded in the offseason to Colorado), Jack Weisenburger and Nuts teammate OF Clark Elliott... unrelated to former Phillies MiLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother... has 17 family members and friends attending today's game.

Prospecting: Moved into the No. 30 slot on the A's MLB Pipeline Top 30 Prospects list; fastball 60, curve 50, cutter 50, control 40, overall 40... the summation: "After a solid high school career in Indiana and being taken late in the 2018 Draft by the Braves, Perkins first went to Louisville to continue his amateur pitching career. After two years of flashes of stuff without command, he moved to Indiana for the 2022 season. Better feel for the strike zone improved his stock and landed him in the fifth round with the A's. He had a brief summer debut and went to High-A Lansing, getting off to a strong start, as he began his pro career in earnest in 2023."

Glory Days: Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation.... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildkats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by Atlanta, but elected to attend college instead.

Study Skills: Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

Life in Louisville: Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts... missed 2020 due to undergoing Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

Off to Bloomington: Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

Draft Day: Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

Pro Debut: Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
