FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders used strong pitching and defense to snap their four-game losing streak and defeat the Lakeland Flying Tigers 3-2 on Wednesday night at LECOM Park. Carlos Jimenez tossed a quality start, allowing just two earned runs in five innings. Javier Rivas belted a go-ahead two-run home run in the fifth to give Bradenton a 3-2 advantage. Garrett McMillan earned his first professional save. Omar Alfonzo and Shalin Polanco collected two hits while Garret Forrester paced the offense with a three-hit night.

HEATING UP: Pittsburgh Pirates No. 14 prospect **Shalin Polanco** is in the middle of one his best stretches of the season after hitting his way on for the fourth-straight game on Wednesday. During this streatch, Polanco is 6-for-13 with a HR, two RBI, one walk, and three runs scored. He's registered back-to-back multi-hit games against Lakeland on Tuesday and Wednesday.

BETTER IN PAIRS: Omar Alfonzo has tallied back-to-back multi-hit games against Lakeland to record 19 multi-hit contests on the season. He's recorded four multi-hit games over his last seven contests and his hitting .314/.368/.600 with one double, three home runs, six RBIs, three walks and five runs scored over his last 10 games.

LAKELAND'S BACK: The Bradenton Marauders welcome in the Lakeland Flying Tigers for the second and final time at LECOM Park this season. The Marauders ended the first half and started the second half of the seasón against the Detroit Tigers affiliate back in June. Shalin Polanco hit a walk-off grand slam in extra-innings on June 18 which in turn aided in the Clearwater Threshers winning the first half over the Flying Tigers.

NO FREE PASSES: LHP Magdiel Cotto allowed just one hit in two innings out of the bullpen on Tuesday against Lakeland. The southpaw hasn't walked a batter yet in July which spans four outings and 5.2 frames. Cotto had walked 19 in 25.2 innings in the first two months of the season, but since then has issued just three over his last 15.0 innings.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold three of the top seven home run leaders in the Florida State League, with Axiel Plaz leading the way, tied for third with 13 longballs. Esmerlyn Valdez is currently in fourth with 12 and Shalin Polanco is tied for seventh with 10. Carlson **Reed** to ssed four scoreless innings on Friday night in Tampa to lower his season ERA to 2.60. He is currently third in the FSL in ERA while also holding opponents to a .205 average, the fourth-best in the league.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Among players in Minor League Baseball this season aged 19 years old or younger, no player has more home runs than Axiel Plaz, who hit his 13th home run of the season on Tuesday against Lakeland. Plaz holds the third-highest SLG (.521) among players 20 years old or younger as well. Current New York Yankees slugger Giancarlo Stanton holds the record for most HR hit in a season as a teen when he mashed 39 in 2008 as a member of the Greensboro Grasshoppers in the South Atlantic League (now the current Pirates High-A affiliate).

BOMBS AWAY: Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 70 home runs in 70 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton has 19 in their first 17 games with Axiel Plaz accounting for six of the 19. Esmerlyn Valdez has three as well. The 19 home runs are the third-most in Single-A this month, trailing the Inland Empire 66ers who have 24.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, RHP Khristian Curtis entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Wednesday night's win over the Flying Tigers marked the Marauders' 33rd one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 18-15 record in those games

Last Time Out: In four scoreless innings last Friday against Tampa, Reed allowed just one walk in two hits before his outing was cut short due to a rain delay and the game was eventually suspended.

2024 Highlights:

- Named Opening Day starter. Struck out a career-high six batters in four innings of work. Four of the five runners left on-base were in scoring position.
- Struck out a career-high eight vs DAY (4/20)
- In a career-high six innings, allowed just one run in a 3-1 win vs Tampa (5/16)...also needed just 69 pitches in his outing. Became second Marauder this season, joining Michael Kennedy, to toss six innings.
- Earned the win in an 8-0 shutout after striking out nine in five scoreless frames against CLR (6/6). Was named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on 6/10 becoming the first Marauders pitcher to pick up that honor this season.
- Recorded best month ERA of season in June: 4 G, 4 GS, 1-1 w/ 1.69 ERA, 21.1 IP, 15 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 7 BB, 29 K
- Enters start on 7/25 with the best GB% in the Pirates org. and second-best in the FSL among qualified pitchers per FanGraphs (min. 60.0 IP). Among all MiLB pitchers with at least 60.0 innings thrown, Reed has 19th-best GB%.

- Enters the 2024 season as the Pirates' No. 26 prospect per Baseball America...moved up to No. 25 in May re-rankings.
- Became the first player from WVU to be drafted by the Pirates since Kim West in 1972.
- •Became the highest-drafted Mountaineer since Alek Manoah was selected 11th overall by the Blue Jays in 2019.
- At WVU: Was an All-Big 12 first-team selection in 2023...went 2-1 with seven saves, a 2.61 ERA (38.0 IP, 11 ER) and 60 strikeouts in 25 appearances in 2023.
- Made three appearances (three starts) for the WV Black Bears and the Trenton Thunder in the 2023 in the MLB Draft League.
- Named to 2023 National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper-of-the-Year Award watch list.
- Was West Virginia's Opening Day Starter in 2022 against Central Michigan
