LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones finished off a three game sweep of the Blue Rocks thanks to a 4–0 victory on Sunday...The win marks Brooklyn's first 3–0 start in 2012... All told, Brooklyn outscored Wilmington 27–5 in the series...In Sunday's win, Brooklyn utilized a pair of long balls to carry them to the win...RF Eli Serrano III clubbed his first of the year – to right field no less, a difficult feat at Maimonides Park – to give the 'Clones a 1–0 lead in the fourth...Later on, C Chris Suero launched his second homer of the season, a three-run shot in the eighth...Brooklyn's pitching continues to be sublime as well...LHP Zach Thornton started his 2025 campaign with a bang, tossing five shutout frames while surrendering just two hits and striking out a career-high eight en route to the win...RHPs Jace Beck, Austin Troesser and Anthony Nunez went on to hurl four shutout innings without allowing a single hit or walk.

'PEN = NAILS: Brooklyn's bullpen has been outstanding amidst the Cyclones 3-0 start... Through thee games, the Cyclones bullpen has surrendered only 3 runs over 14.1 innings of relief work...The 1.88 bullpen ERA is tops in the South Atlantic League, and fourth in all of High-A...Sunday's win over Wilmington saw the trio of RHPs Jace Beck, Austin Troesser and Anthony Nunez record four shutout innings, during which, they faced the minimum 12 batters...8 of the 12 outs recorded were strikeouts...On Saturday, RHPs Ben Simon, Joel Diaz and Dylan Ross combined for 6.1 frames of scoreless relief work...Simon picked up with win, while Diaz logged the save...The quartet struck out a combined 15 Wilmington batters throughout the course of the day...It's been a similar native for Brooklyn starters as well, who have compiled a 1.42 ERA through the first three games.

**SUERO SUAVE:** C **Chris Suero** is off to a scorching start in 2025...The Bronx native is the only player on the Cyclones with multiple home runs through the first three games...Suero is a blistering 6-for-14 at the dish, with four extra-base hits, six runs batted in, and boasts an impressive .500 on-base percentage...Suero is one of only two players to have belted multiple home runs through the first weekend of SAL play...Asheville's **Joseph Sullivan** is the other...The 2022 international free agent signee is coming off an impressive 2024, that saw him play in 87 games at the High-A level, with seven home runs and 45 RBI, while also swiping 15 stolen bases

**THOR'S HAMMER:** LHP **Zach Thornton** picked up right where he left off in 2024 in his season debut on Sunday...The Grand Canyon University product collected his first win of the year, behind five shutout innings against Wilmington...Thornton allowed only two base hits and one walk, while striking out a career-high eight Blue Rocks batters...In 2024, Thornton pitched in four games with Brooklyn down the stretch, starting four games to the tune of a 3.67 ERA

YOU GET A HIT! YOU GET A HIT! YOU GET A HIT!...YOU GET THE POINT: In Saturday's lopsided victory over Wilmington, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win...Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday are the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...3B Richard Lucas went 5-for-6 at the dish, while CF Travis Taijeron was a perfect 4-for-4 with 5 RBI...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007. YOU GET A HIT! YOU GET A HIT! YOU GET A HIT!...YOU GET THE POINT: In Saturon July 13, 2007.

**REIM TIME!**: It's difficult to get out to much of a hotter start than Cyclones INF **Jacob Reimer** through the first three games of the season...Through three games, the California native is an impressive 6-for-13 at the plate with eight RBI, four runs scored, two doubles and a triple...Reimer paces the SAL in numerous offensive stats despite the small sample size...The 2022 draftee paces the circuit in RBI (8), and is tied for 2nd in the league in doubles (2), hits (6), and tied for 4th in runs scored (4)...Reimer collected more RBI through his first two games played this season than he logged all of last year through 25 games scattered across three different levels.

**THE LONG HALL:** RHP **Noah Hall** spun his best career pro outing on Opening Day for Brooklyn...The 2023 draftee picked up the win, thanks to five innings of one run ball...Hall surrendered only three hits, and gave up just one run...The righty also punched out three batters and walked four...The University of South Carolina product became not only the first player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the first player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days...Last year, was placed on the IL on April 26th and did not pitch again until September 7th with Single-A St. Lucie.

**BOARDWALK BENGE:** OF **Carson Benge** started his 2025 on the right foot thanks to a keen eye at the plate...The 2024 first round draftee by the Mets made Wilmto a keen eye at the plate...Ine 2024 first round draftee by the Mets made Wilmington pitchers work, drawing three free passes, while going 2-for-6 at the plate in the first weekend of the season...The Oklahoma State product laced a double to left field on Friday for the first High-A hit of his career, and then went 1-for-4 on Sunday...Five of Benge's 15 hits with Single-A St. Lucie went for extra base hits at the tail end of last year...The Yukon, OK native clubbed 2 home runs and 3 doubles in the Florida State league during his time in PSL.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones welcome in the Hudson Valley Renegades for the first installment of the SAL Subway Series of installment of the SAL Subway Series of 2025...The Yankees High-A affiliate went 2-1 against Jersey Shore to start the new year, including an 8-7 walk-ff victory on Saturday... Hudson Valley boasts eight top 30 Yankees prospects including INF George Lombard Jr. (2), RHP Ben Hess (4), RHP Bryce Cunningham (6), RHP Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz (8), RHP Cade Smith (16), RHP Carlos Lagrange (19), LHP Kyle Carr (20) and INF Roc Riggio (27).

**2024 IN REVIEW:** Although the Cyclones did not qualify for the postseason last year, 2024 saw a bevy of achievements on the boardwalk...Numerous franchise records were set, including the all time games played, hits and stolen base records, in addition to the single season hits and stolen base records being set...The 2024 'Clones tossed the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history thanks to a combined effort, and six players appeared in Brooklyn on big league rehab assignments.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After four former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, three alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C Hayden Senger ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager Gilbert Gómez embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33 year old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since Edgardo Alfonzo (2017-2019)... Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls... Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League

**FAMILIAR FACES:** 21 players on the Cyclones break camp roster have previous playing experience in Brooklyn...Notables include: INF **Boston Baro** who played in 11 games with Brooklyn towards the end of last season...INF **Jacob Reimer** suited up in 39 games for the 'Clones over the last 2 years...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had a hand in the first nine inning no-hitter in franchise history last year...RHP **Ben Simon** logged 22 appearances, the most amongst any returning pitcher outside of Hawkins.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Seven members of the Mets' 2024 draft class will begin the 2025 campaign with the Cyclones...RHP Ryan Lambert is the lone '24 draftee that returns to the Brooklyn roster, while 1st round selection OF Carson Benge, 2nd round pick LHP Jonathan Santucci and 4th rounder OF Eli Serrano III all will make their High-A debuts...RHP Brendan Girton, RHP R.J. Gordon & INF Nick Roselli round

ROSELLI RAKES: INF Nick Roselli is slated to make his Cyclones debut this weekend...The 2024 Mets draftee grew up 34 miles northeast of Maimonides Park in Long Island's Levittown...The 11th round pick played his college ball at Binghamton University, where he was a career .349 hitter for the Bearcats...The Division HS product grew up a huge Mets fan, and was considered to have the "Best Pro Debut" of any member of the 2024 Mets draft class by Baseball America...Rosell hit the ground running last year in the Florida State League, notching an .869 OPS across 18 games with Single-A St. Lucie.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On April 8, 2016, RHP Luis Cessa ('12) made his Major League debut for the New York Yankees in Detroit against the Tigers, allowing 1 run on 2 hits with 2 strikeouts in 2.0 innings of relief...In 2017, RHP Paul Sewald ('12) debuted in the Majors for the New York Mets at Citi Field against the Miami Marlins.

**KEEP IT IN THE BALLPARK!:** With so much of Brooklyn's pitching staff returning from last year, it's worth noting that Cyclones pitchers led the South Atlantic League by a wide margin in home runs allowed (59)...Hudson Valley was the next closest (78)...Of the 59 long balls permitted, only 20 of them came at Maimonides Park...Over the last two seasons, Brooklyn arms have surrendered just 55 home runs in 132 home games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's Opening Day Roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 7 of the Mets Top 30 prospects... Those include OF Carson Benge (3), LHP Jonathan Santucci (13), INF Boston Baro (14), INF Jacob Reimer (21), C Chris Suero (22), OF Eli Serrano III (23) and C Ronald Hernandez (27)...Of those seven, four have previous experience playing in Brooklyn.

**MAIDEN VOYAGE:** Gordon is making his professional debut on Tuesday night...The 23-year-old did not pitch after signing with the Mets on 7/22/24 for \$150,000...Gordon is the first player to make his professional debut for the Cyclones since teammate RHP **Ryan Lambert** debuted in relief on 9/1/24 at Winston-Salem...LHP **Jonathan Santucci**, New York's second-round pick in 2024, is slated to make his pro debut on Wednesday afternoon.

**DUCK TALES:** Gordon spent his four-year collegiate career at the University of Oregon...As a junior in 2024, the Santa Clarita, Calif. native accumulated a 7-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (54 ER in 94.2 IP), 46 walks, and 87 strikeouts in 17 starts for the Ducks...Gordon was named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention and was recognized on the University's Dean's List in the Winter of 2023...Served as Oregon's Opening Day starter in 2024...Was the Game 1 starter in every regular-season series, as well as the Santa Barbara Regional and the Bryan-College Station Super Regional...Led the PAC-12 in games started (17)...Also ranked 2nd in innings pitched (94.2), tied for 3rd in wins (7), and 8th in strikeouts (87).

**ON THE MEND:** The 23-year-old returned to the bump for the Ducks in 2024 after missing and redshirting the entire 2023 season due to a UCL injury that required internal brace surgery to correct...Despite missing an entire campaign, Gordon still finished his career at Oregon tied for 10th in program history in games started (28)...Finished his college career with a 14-9 record, a 5.22 ERA (106 ER in 182.2 IP), 1 save, 89 walks, and 155 strikeouts in 51 appearances (28 starts).

**SUMMER FUN:** Following his freshman season at Oregon, Gordon spent his summer of 2021 pitching for the Bend (Ore.) Elks of the West Coast League...In four starts, the right-hander posted a 2-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (10 ER in 22.2 IP), 7 walks, and 29 strikeouts...Gordon was teammates with a pair of former Cyclones that summer, spending time on the pitching staff with LHP **Eli Ankeney** (2023) and RHP **Kade Morris** (2024).

**BOTH WAYS:** Gordon finished his high school career at West Ranch High School in Stevenson Ranch, Calif. before attending the University of Oregon...The 23-year-old spent his sophomore and junior seasons at Notre Dame High School...During his time in high school, the right-handed pitcher also served as a gifted outfielder, hitting .414 (12-for-29) with a home run, 4 RBI, and 1.204 OPS in a COVID-shortened senior season...In high school, Gordon faced off as a hitter against 2024 National League Rookie of the Year and Pittsburgh Pirates RHP **Paul Skenes**, who attended El Toro High School (Lake Forest, Calif.), registering a double.

**FORE!:** R.J. is far from the only athlete in the Gordon family...R.J.'s father, **Jason**, is an accomplished professional golfer who has played on the Canadian PGA Tour, the PGA Tour, and the Nationwide Tour.
