Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third in a six-game series against the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Nuts won the opener on Tuesday, handing the Whitecaps their first loss of the year, before West Michigan returned the favor last night, tying the all-time series at 215-215.

Starting Matchup: Opening Day starter **Joelvis Del Rosario** makes his second Lugnuts start, looking to follow up on 4 2/3 scoreless innings last Friday in Midland. Del Rosario was acquired by Oakland in December as the No. 1 overall pick in the Rule 5 Draft's MiLB portion. The Caps counter with 24-year-old lefty **Carlos Peña**, who started their second game of the season against Fort Wayne and fired four shutout innings.

Last Night: Whitecaps 9, Lugnuts 4. West Michigan collected six doubles and a home run amid a 15-hit barrage, knocking the Nuts from the ranks of unbeaten.

LUG•NOTES

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

RiSPy Business: The Nuts went 1-for-14 with runners in scoring position yesterday, leading to defeat, following a 5-for-11 performance with RiSP in the series opener. Lansing had struggled in the same situation during the season-opening three-game series at Great Lakes (2-for-12, 2-for-12, 1-for-4) but overcame those issues to win all three games.

Streiking: **Max Muncy**, **Caeden Trenkle** and **Jack Winkler** have reached base in all five Lugnuts games this year. Winkler, after going 0-for-4 with a walk on Opening Day, has hit safely in the last four games.

Clean Baseball: The Nuts have a league low two errors (committed by SS **Max Muncy** and P **Blake Beers** in the first two games) through five games, posting a fielding percentage of .989 with zero passed balls and (tied for 1st) six double plays turned.

Doubling Their Pleasure: West Michigan and Lansing are the top two teams in the league in doubles, with the Whitecaps hitting six yesterday giving them 14 for the year, and the Lugnuts hitting two more yesterday to give them 10 two-baggers. Three different Lugnuts players (**CJ Rodriguez**, **Max Muncy** and **Daniel Susac**) have had games with two doubles this year.

Fast Start: Thanks to a pair of steals yesterday from **Lazaro Armenteros**, the Nuts are second in the MWL with 12 stolen bases, trailing only South Bend. Armenteros leads the circuit with six steals.

Transaction: Earlier today, the Nuts placed pitcher **Serafino Brito** on the Injured List retroactive to April 10th and transferred pitcher **Brady Basso** (IL) to Double-A Midland.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: With the score tied at 1-1 in the top of the ninth inning at Great Lakes, the Lugnuts called upon slugger (and future Major Leaguer) Brad Glenn to pinch-hit. Glenn came through with a tie-breaking home run to give the Lugnuts a three-game sweep at Dow Diamond with a 2-1 win.

2012: The Lugnuts (7-1) suffer their first loss, falling 5-4 to West Michigan on a Danry Vasquez two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth.

2018: Seventh-inning magic: The Lugnuts (6-3) scored four runs in the seventh to beat the West Michigan Whitecaps (6-2), 4-2, in a battle of Eastern Division powerhouses at Cooley Law School Stadium.

The King: First name is pronounced “yo-elvis,” with the emphasis on the middle syllable... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball.

Lugnuts Lineage: Del Rosario tossed 4 2/3 scoreless innings on Opening Day, April 7 at Great Lakes... he joined such other Opening Day Lugnuts starters as: Blaine Mull (1996), Steve Hueston (1997), Justin Pederson (1998), Mike Wuertz (1999), Matt Bruback (2000), Wilton Chavez (2001), Angel Guzman (2002), Andrew Sisco (2003), Sean Marshall (2004), Casey Janssen (2005), Chi-Hung Cheng (2006), Zach Dials (2007), Trystan Magnuson (2008), Henderson Alvarez (2009), Ryan Shopshire (2010), Misaul Diaz (2011), Noah Syndergaard (2012), Javier Avendano (2013), Jairo Labourt (2014), Chase De Jong (2015), Jon Harris (2016), Justin Maese (2017), Yenny Diaz (2018), Josh Winckowski (2019), Seth Shuman (2021) and Grant Holman (2022).

Home Cooking: Also from Santiago: Jose Lima, Santiago Espinal, Joaquin Benoit, Willy Adames, Julian Tavarez, Jhonny Peralta and Jose Reyes.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.
