SHOREBIRDS LOSE SEVENTH STRAIGHT: The Delmarva Shorebirds dropped their seventh game in a row on Wednesday night as they fell to the Lynchburg Hillcats by a score of 8-2. Robert Lopez played a major part of putting Lynchburg ahead as he drove in the first four runs for the Hillcats with a pair of RBI singles, and a two-run homer. The lead would increase to 7-0 for Lynchburg before Delmarva got on the board in the seventh with an RBI triple by **Brayan Hernandez** to break the shutout. Each team would register a run in the ninth and Delmarva would fall 8-2 to drop the first two games of the series against the Hillcats.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT: Juan Rojas** makes his first start as a Shorebird on Thursday night and he'll pitch against **Abel Brito** for the Hillcats. Brito is making just his fourth start as a Hillcat and has thrown just 9.2 innings and has allowed 13 runs on 11 hits with 9 walks. Brito had a blow-up start where he gave up 9 runs on 7 hits against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers on July 22 in a two-inning start. The right-hander made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before being called up to Lynchburg on July 8.

**HEY STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo** has come out of the All-Star break hot as he's reached base in 13 of 16 games he's played in since the break. He has especially thrived batting in the leadoff spot in his last 12 starts as he has 6 multi-hit games while scoring 8 runs, and stealing 5 bases in that short span. His run at the top included a leadoff home run on the first pitch of the game versus Kannapolis on July 25.

**JUST FALLING SHORT:** The Delmarva Shorebirds are currently in a tough stretch as they've entered the month of August as they are enduring a seven-game losing streak, where they've been held to one run in four of their past five games. Delmarva on the season is 5-14 in games decided by one run with and have struggled to find the clutch gene late in games as they are 2-37 in games where they've trailed after seven innings and 0-46 when behind following the eighth inning.

**HEATING UP AT THE HOT CORNER:** Third basemen **Anderson De Los Santos** has begun find his stride at the plate. De Los Santos is coming off his best month of the season in July where he batted .267 with an OPS of .785 with 7 extra-base hits and 12 RBI. Most notably, De Los Santos has trimmed his strikeout rate as he has struck out 24 times since the month of June after striking out 25 times in April and 29 in May.

**TWO MORE MOVE UP: Samuel Basallo** & **Trendon Craig** are the latest Shorebirds to earn promotions to the High-A club in Aberdeen. Basallo was not just the best offensive performer on the Shorebirds, but in all the Carolina League as the 18 year old had his way in his debut season in affiliated baseball as he became a Top 100 overall prospect. Craig moves up after a strong 39-game run with Delmarva where he batted .302 with 14 extra-base hits, along with 18 stolen bases. With the promotions of Basallo and Craig, there have now been a total of 11 Shorebirds from their Opening Day Roster who have earned a call-up to the next level.

**NEW MONTH, FRESH START:** The Delmarva Shorebirds will look to right the ship after a tough finish to the month of August where they lost 10 of their final 12 games, including losing 5 of 6 in their last two series against Charleston and Kannapolis. Delmarva has had success this season against the Lynchburg Hillcats as they've taken four of six games in each of the first two series, giving them an 8-4 overall record against the Cleveland Guardians affiliate.

**LAST OUTING (7/28 @ KAN):** Rojas made his debut appearance in Kannapolis last Friday as a reliever and impressed by throwing three innings, allowing just one hit, which was a home run to Brooks Baldwin in the 8th inning. Struck out 4 batters with no walks.

**vs. LYNCHBURG:** This will be the first time Juan Rojas will face the Lynchburg Hillcats.

**2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** Rojas pitched the first half of last season in the FCL for the Minnesota Twins where he struck out 38 with just 4 walks in 30 innings while holding an ERA of 3.60. The left-hander was then involved in the trade for the Orioles at the 2022 deadline that sent RHP Jorge Lopez to Minnesota. Rojas threw just 8.2 innings in 3 appearances for the Orioles FCL team where he did not allow any runs with 12 strikeouts.



## FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

## MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

## **PITCHING COACH**



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

## FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.
