Top of the Morning

This morning, Reading opens up a six-game homestand with the Altoona Curve, the double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It's the first of 12 matchups between the teams this season, one in Reading and another in Altoona. After this week, Reading travels to Altoona from July 18-23. In 2022, the teams split their series in Reading and Altoona took 4/6 in September to win the season series 7-5.

Back from Portland

Last week, the R-Phils played six games on the road at the Portland Sea Dogs. Reading fell in the series four games to two and have yet to win a series in 2023. On Sunday, Portland held a narrow 2-1 lead for most of the game and then exploded for four runs in the eighth inning to put the game away for good. David Parkinson recorded eight strikeouts, which was a Reading season-high this season.

Home Luck

Though early, the Fightin Phils are playing much better at FirstEnergy Stadium this season, then away from the friendly confines. Through six home games, the R-Phils are hitting .303 and scoring 4.8 runs per game. On the road, Reading is slashing just .201 and scoring 3.2 runs per contest. Additionally, the R-Phils have 23 extra base hits at home compared to just 16 on the road in three more away games.

Wacky Numbers

Through 15 games, the Fightin Phils sit second in the Eastern League with a .244 batting average. But, Reading is ninth across the league in runs scored at 58, which is 3.9 per game. A culprit would be the R-Phils sit last in the league with a .203 average when runners are in scoring position. Also, Reading has struggled moving runners as the R-Phils are ninth in stolen bases and ninth in total home runs.

Fast Starts

Abelt their slow start, the Fightin Phils have started game quickly in 2023. Reading has scored first in nine of 15 games so far, but holds just a 3-6 record in such contests. Additionally, Reading is outscoring opponents by eight runs in the first innings of games this season. The third inning has been a trouble spot, as the R-Phils are being outscored by ten runs in that frame.

Around the Organization

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies took three-of-four games against the Colorado Rockies last weekend. Up next, the Phillies welcome the Seattle Mariners for a three-game series. Lehigh Valley starts off a series at Jacksonville this morning. Jersey Shore returns home to take on Brooklyn and Clearwater returns home and welcomes Port St. Lucie this week.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 25, 1967: At Williamsport, 40-year old Robin Roberts starts his comeback attempt with the Reading Phillies with a 1-0 loss to the Mets. Roberts allows eight singles, four of them infield hits, and strikes out nine, claiming after the game, "I was satisfied." The Phillies leave 11 men on base in absorbing their first loss.

Welcoming the Curve

The Altoona Curve enter this week's series with a 7-7 record on the season. Altoona just took four-of-five games from the Bowie Baysox at home. Saturday's game between the teams was rained out. Prior to the Bowie series, the Curve had just won three of their first nine games to start the season. After this week, Altoona stays on the road for a six-game series at Richmond next week.

Throw a Curve

Righty Kyle Nicolas gets the ball for Altoona to open the series. Nicolas enters today with 1-1 record and 5.79 ERA through three starts this season. He has walked eight and struck out ten over 14 innings this season. Nicolas last pitched on Tuesday, going six innings against Bowie, allowing three hits, one run and striking out two. Nicolas was traded to Pittsburgh in 2021 in the Jacob Stallings trade.
