PLAYOFF BOUND

- The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.
- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

- While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today 31 games over .500 with an overall 76-45 record (.628 winning percentage).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .628 winning percentage overall this year is the BEST in the Minors ... the next-best team in Minor League Baseball is the Palm Beach Cardinals (72-43 / .626 winning %), St. Louis' Single-A affiliate.
- 76 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, one ahead of Triple-A Sugar Land and 1 of 9 Minor League teams with 70 wins.
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 92 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season ... over 54 seasons of Triple-A Omaha baseball, there have been seven 80-win seasons, most recently the 2012 (83 wins) and 2015 (80 wins) Storm Chasers.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

- 73 of Omaha's 121 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (60%), including 28 of 45 losses in 2024, with 15 of 45 losses by just one run (33%).
- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 14 of its last 27 save opportunities, since June 5 (52%).
- Omaha is 23-15 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 5th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron lead MiLB with 26 1-run wins.
- Omaha's 34 saves are tied for the most in the league, tied 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and tied 8th in the Minors ... Evan Sisk has recorded 7 of the team's last 8 saves.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

- Omaha has outscored its opponents 661 to 532 this season, a +129 run differential.
- A +129 run differential this year ranks both as the best mark in the International League and at the Triple-A level, ahead of the next closest AAA team, Tacoma (+96).
- Omaha is 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Midland RockHounds lead the Minors in run differential at +146 (583 to 437).

KICKSTART MY GAME

- Storm Chaser starting pitchers have been some of the best in Triple-A in August.
- Omaha's starters have combined for a 2.41 ERA (27 ER in 101.0 IP) over 19 games this month, 5th-best in the Minors ... a 0.97 WHIP is tied 3rd in MiLB.
- Omaha has a quality start in 8 of 18 games this month, with 3 from Noah Cameron and Daniel Lynch IV each ... 15 of 19 August starts have been at least 5.0 innings.
- 101.0 innings this month from Omaha's starters rank as the 4th-most in Minor League Baseball ... in the 2nd half, 32 of Omaha's 48 starts have been at least 5.0 innings.

HOME RUN HAPPY

- While the 2024 Storm Chasers have not relied on the long ball, Omaha has not only had success hitting home runs, but also limiting the long balls on the mound.
- Omaha ranks tied 2nd in the league with 165 home runs this year, closing in on the 2023 team's 176 (over 145 games).
- 4 Storm Chasers hitters this year have 15+ homers, one of six Triple-A teams that can make that claim ... last year's Omaha club only had 3 players, and 1 with more than 15.
- 127 home runs allowed are tied for the 3rd-fewest in the league ... the team has had stretches in the last month of 5 straight games without a homer allowed, July 31 to August 4 and August 15-20 ... Omaha did not go more than 3 games without allowing a home run in the last 40 games.

BACK IN BUFFALO

- This week, the Omaha Storm Chasers travel to Sahlen Field in Buffalo, New York to play the Buffalo Bisons, the first meeting between the clubs since 1997.
- Omaha and Buffalo previously played in the Triple-A American Association together from 1985 until 1997 ... in 1998, Omaha moved to the Pacific Coast League and Buffalo joined the International League, with Omaha joining the IL in 2021.

Joins the Royals in 2024 to mark his 4th MLB organization ... spent parts of the first 7 seasons of his professional career from 2014-20 with Seattle before being traded to San Diego for two seasons (2020-21) and spending two seasons with Boston (2022-23) ... signed as a minor league free agent with the Royals last December. Over parts of 6 Major League seasons, he has appeared in 119 MLB games (all in relief) with a 8-7 record and 4.03 ERA (52 ER in 116.0 IP) and 129 strikeouts to 60 walks ... his last MLB outing was on April 16, 2021 vs. Los Angeles (NL) ... has had five Injured List stints since reaching the Majors, including four for right arm injuries ... spent all of 2022 and most of 2023 rehabbing from Tommy John Surgery he underwent in April 2021, after pitching just two games that season with the Padres. In 2023, he made 8 rehab appearances between the FCL Red Sox (R) and Greenville Drive (A+) ... with 7 strikeouts in 12.0 innings during July and August.
