**Today's Game:** Nashville takes on Memphis in game three and four of the six-game series at AutoZone Park. Both contests will be seven innings and the second game will start 30 minutes after the completion of the first game. Carlos Rodriguez will pitch for the Sounds in game one against Gordon Graceffo for the Redbirds. Game two will be Tobias Myers versus Adam Kloffenstein.

**Carlos Rodriguez:** The 22-year-old right-hander is making his third appearance (2nd start) of the season. Rodriguez has been charged with the loss in both outings posting a 6.43 ERA (7.0 IP/5 ER) with eight walks and 11 strikeouts. In 2023, he went 9-6 with a 2.77 ERA (123.2 IP/38 ER) and 152 strikeouts for Double-A Biloxi. He has a 14.14 K/9 which is top among Sounds starters. He is ranked as the #8 prospect in the Brewers Organization according to MLB.com.

**Gordon Graceffo:** The 24-year-old right-hander out of Villanova is making his third start of the season for the Redbirds. Graceffo has a 0-2 record with a 9.39 ERA (7.2 IP/8 ER) in his starts including allowing seven earned runs in 2.2 innings at Indianapolis on April 6. Last season in 21 appearances (18 starts) he had a 4.92 ERA (86.0 IP/47 ER) and 81 strikeouts. Graceffo was drafted in the fifth round of the 2021 Draft. He is the #8 ranked prospect in the Cardinals Organization according to MLB.com.

**Tobias Myers:** The 25-year-old right-hander will be making his third start of the season in game two of the doubleheader. In his last start, Myers went 5.2 innings, five hits, three earned runs, one walk and 10 strikeouts. It was his second career 10-strikeout game (w/Durham on September 9, 2021 vs. Norfolk) and the earliest a Sounds pitcher has gotten 10+ strikeouts in an outing (8 games) since 2004. He leads the Sounds overall in strikeouts with 14 and is second in WHIP (1.34).

**Adam Kloffenstein:** The 23-year-old right-hander will be making his third start of the season for the Redbirds. He is 0-1 with a 7.56 ERA (8.1 IP/ 7 ER). In his last start at Indianapolis, Kloffenstein went 4.1 innings, three hits, five earned runs, five walks and one strikeout. Last season for Double-A New Hampshire and Triple-A Memphis he went 7-6 with a 3.16 ERA (128.0 IP/45 ER) with 140 strikeouts. He started last season in the Blue Jays organization and was traded along with Saturday's starter Sem Robberse to the Cardinals for Jordan Hicks on July 30. He is the Cardinals #16 prospect according to MLB.com.

**Das Haase:** Eric Haase hit his first home run in a Sounds uniform last night with his blast to left field in the ninth. It was his 174th career professional homer and 52nd at the Triple-A level. It was his first home run since September 13, 2023 at Toledo while playing for Columbus. Haase has recorded a hit in four of his five games this season and reached base in all five. He is 6-for-18 on the season with four RBI and two doubles.

**Cuban Flair:** Vladimir Gutiérrez made his Sounds debut last night with 2.0 scoreless innings, zero hits, zero earned runs, and one strikeout. Gutiérrez was claimed off waivers from Miami on April 5 after one appearance in the big leagues in 2024...4.0 IP, 3 H, 3 ER, 2 BB, 4 K. He has 33 career appearances (30 starts) in the MLB across three seasons for the Reds and Marlins. He is 10-12 with a 5.47 ERA (154.2/94 ER) with 121 strikeouts. The 29-year-old Cuban was signed to a contract by the Reds in 2016.

**Bullpen Beat:** The Sounds bullpen continued to be the best at the Triple-A level with another 3.2 scoreless innings. Nashville relievers have four wins on the season and boast the best ERA (1.18), WHIP (0.85) and opponent batting average (.135) at the Triple-A level. Enoli Paredes (5.0 IP), Harold Chirino (3.2 IP), Rob Zastryzny (4.2 IP), Nick Bennett (4.0 IP) and Darrell Thompson (2.0 IP) have yet to allow an earned run in multiple appearances this season. The next best ERA among Triple-A bullpens is Columbus at 2.68 (47.0/14 ER) and the next closest opponent batting average is Omaha at .203.

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 688-588 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,280-2,108 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).
