DON'T MOUND IF I DO: LHP Thomas Pannone will make his fourth start of the year and fifth overall appearance on Wednesday against Iowa. After missing all of 2025, the southpaw has continued to see an uptick in pitches, throwing a season-high 62 last Thursday in Louisville. He's made one previous appearance against Iowa on May 26, 2023 at First Horizon Park when he allowed four runs on eight hits with five strikeouts and three walks without a decision in Nashville's 7-4 win.

DOUBLE-UP: Eddys Leonard extended his double-streak to five consecutive games on Tuesday night with his team-leading 11th total two-bagger of the season. The five straight games with a double is a new career-high for Leonard and he is just **one of two Triple-A players with a double in at least five consecutive games this season and one of six total across all levels of the minors.** He is tied for the second-longest doubles streak by a Sounds batter since 2005. It was the 155th double of his career and he is tied for the fourth-most doubles across all full-season minor leaguers since 2021 with 138. **He ranks first in the International League with his .608 SLG and 1.040 OPS on the year and also ranks top 10 in AVG (2nd, .350), doubles (T-3rd), OBP (4th, .432), XBH (T-6th, 18), and total bases (10th, 73)**

LU-THREES LARA: Brewers no. 11-rated prospect Luis Lara earned his 13th multi-hit game of the season in Tuesday night's win against the I-Cubs, going 3-for-4 with two RBI. Lara currently ranks second on the team behind Eddys Leonard (14) in multi-hit games this season and leads the club with seven three-hit performances. Nobody else on Nashville's roster has more than two 3+ hit games. Lara is currently tied for third in the International League with 47 hits, leads the league in runs scored (35), is tied for sixth in OBP (.429), and ranks ninth in AVG (.329) and total bases (74). **He posted eight 3+ hit performances in 136 games with Double-A Biloxi but didn't have his first until May 24th of last year and didn't record his seventh until August 16th.**

THROUGH THE QUAD: Brewers no. 21-rated prospect Brock Wilken extended his on-base streak to 28 consecutive games with a walk in the bottom of the first inning and added a hit and pair of RBI to finish Tuesday night 1-for-3 with two walks. **His 28-game on-base streak is the longest-active streak in the International League, tied for the fourth-longest in the Triple-A, and tied for the fifth-longest in all minor league baseball.** The 28-game streak is the fourth-longest on-base streak for a Sounds player since the start of the 2023 season and the 10th-longest dating back to 2005. Since beginning his streak on April 10, Wilken is hitting .239 (22-for-92) with 12 XBH, 21 RBI, 22 walks, and has 15 runs. His nine doubles during the streak are tied for the fourth-most in the International League and ranks fourth with his 22 free passes.

GASS-ED 'EM UP: Left-hander Robert Gasser made his second career start against the I-Cubs in Tuesday night's matchup, allowing two runs (1 ER) and striking out seven batters in a no-decision. Gasser made his 50th career appearance for the Sounds Tuesday night (45th start) and has posted a 14-6 career record with a 3.72 ERA in 227.1 IP and struck out 282 batters in five seasons with Nashville. Since making his organizational debut with the Brewers following a trade from the Padres during the 2022 season, The Brewers no. 16-rated prospect ranks fifth in the farm system in strikeouts (313), GS (52), and IP (252.2).

THE YOHO YOYO: Brewers no. 28 rated prospect Craig Yoho worked another scoreless appearance, his eighth in nine games with Nashville this season. After allowing 2+ earned runs for just the second time in his Triple-A career and the first two home runs he has surrendered in Triple-A (66 G) on April 25 in Charlotte, Yoho has allowed just one hit over his last 6.1 IP and has nine strikeouts to one walk over his last six appearances.

JUST THE START: Infielder Ethan Murray earned his third multi-hit game of the season in Tuesday night's win over the I-Cubs, going 2-for-3 with a double and an RBI in the process. It was his first multi-hit game since matching his career-high with four hits on April 25 in the first game of a doubleheader in Charlotte.
