**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, continuing a nine-game road trip that began with winning two of three at Fort Wayne. The Nuts are 9-6 this season against Lake County, 5-4 at Classic Auto Group Park, after losing the first two games of this series before winning last night.

**Last Night: Lugnuts 13, Captains 4.** Jonny Butler crushed a pair of two-run homers, Cameron Masterman went 4-for-6 with four RBIs and keyed a seven-run sixth inning with a solo homer and a two-run single, and the Lugnuts romped to a satisfying rout over the Lake County bullpen.

**On the Air:** Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jakska and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts and Captains play through Sunday, leading into the four-day Major League Baseball All-Star Break. Then the Nuts return home to welcome in the Great Lakes Loons for a three-game series from July 19-21.

### LUG•NOTES

**The Future is Here:** Lugnuts right-hander Luis Morales, the youngest player on the team, will represent the Oakland Athletics in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game tomorrow at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas. Morales, the A's top pitching prospect and No. 2 overall prospect, is the fifth active Nut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining Denzel Clarke (2022), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2017) and Ángel Perdomo (2016).

**All-Star Alumni:** Speaking of Vladdy Jr., the 2017 Nuts alum and 2022 Lansing standout Mason Miller were each named American League All-Stars; for Vladdy, this is his fourth consecutive All-Star nod while rookie Miller makes his first All-Star appearance, continuing a stellar first full season that has him in Rookie of the Year conversations.

**Powering On:** The Lugnuts have six home runs in this series, giving them a league-leading 12 homers this month and 63 homers this season – 22 of which have come against the Captains in 15 games, compared to 41 homers in their other 68 games.

**Troubled Waters:** Lake County's pitching staff leads the Midwest League with a 3.62 ERA, but they have a 6.25 ERA against the Lugnuts (.303 avg. / 1.76 WHIP in 134 innings) compared to a 3.01 ERA against the rest of the Midwest League.

**Team Effort:** The Nuts' offense leads the Midwest League in total bases (1104), triples (32) and OPS (.744).

**Prospecting:** Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Oakland Athletics prospects on its roster: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2, and the A's No. 1 pitching prospect), corner infielder Will Simpson (No. 24), tomorrow's starting pitcher, Will Johnston (No. 27), and outfielder Brayan Buelvas (No. 29).

**What a Crowd!** The Nuts' 9,917 attendance on July 3 was the largest crowd in the Midwest League this season, leading all High-A single game attendances this season. It topped all but one Class A team (Fresno), all but one Class AA team (Frisco), and was larger than 14 Class AAA teams.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2015:** Ryan McBroom had gone 5-for-5 at Dayton earlier in the season. On this day he topped himself, going 6-for-6 to tie the franchise and Midwest League records with three singles, two doubles, a home run, a walk and four RBIs. But Argenis Aldazoro hit a walk-off RBI single in a three-run 13th to give the Dayton Dragons a 10-9 win. The Dragons had previously rallied to tie the game in the 9th and 11th innings, with the Lugnuts blowing leads of 6-5, 7-6 and 9-7. In the bottom of the 9th, Paul Kronenfeld's RBI single brought in the tying run, but LF David Harris threw out Luis Gonzalez at the plate to force extras.

**2018:** Chavez Young hit a grand slam to erase a 6-2 deficit, and the Lugnuts defeated the Burlington Bees at Community Field, 11-8. Bees starter Oliver Ortega threw six wild pitches (one short of the league record) and struck out nine batters in 4 1/3 innings.

**In a Nutshell:** Excelled in his Lugnuts debut on May 2 vs. South Bend, becoming the club's 11th different starting pitcher this year and the 939th all-time player to put on the Lansing uniform... replaced the demoted Eduardo Rivera and tossed five scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six Cubs... followed up with eight strikeouts in three hitless innings with his mother in attendance at Great Lakes, May 8... grew up idolizing Max Scherzer... enjoys the great outdoors... notable splits:

**Prospecting:** Rated the A's No. 27 prospect and No. 12 pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline... grades: fastball 50, slider 45, change-up 55, control 50, overall 40... they write, "With low expectations, Johnston began his first full season of pro ball at age 23 with Single-A Stockton, but he threw so well out of the gate he earned a quick promotion up to High-A Lansing at the end of April... Johnston has shown a better feel for his three-pitch arsenal than some expected given his college numbers. He adds and subtracts from his fastball, throwing it typically in the 89-94 mph range, though he's shown in the past the ability to reach back for a 95 or 96-mph heater on occasion. The pitch has played up a bit because he can pitch north and south with it. His best pitch is now his split-changeup, which flashes plus and can be a true out pitch at times. His low-80s breaking ball can be on the slurve side, but it can be effective."

**Stockton Sensation:** Opened 2024 with the Class A Ports... made two relief appearances and two starts, facing 46 batters and whiffing 26 of them ... debuted with 4 2/3 hitless innings with eight strikeouts on April 6... followed up with three perfect innings with 7 K on 4/12.

**Gig 'Em:** Majored in finance at Texas A&M... pitched primarily out of Aggies' bullpen; career stats: 6-4, 5.77 ERA, 66 G, 8 GS, 8 SV, 98 1/3 IP, 57 BB, 132 K... finest year at College Station was in 2022: 3.25 ERA, 23 G, 2 GS, 4 SV, 36 IP, 2 HR, 18 BB, 49 K... struggled in 2023 to 5.89 ERA due to 9 HR and 31 BB in 47 1/3 IP, though he struck out 70 batters... drafted following his fourth season at A&M... joined fellow Aggies Micah Dallas (8th round, 2022) and Nathan Dettmer (5th round, 2023) as Aggies drafted by the A's, and one of seven Aggies drafted overall in 2023... signed for \$150,000... notable Aggies in the pros include Chuck Knoblauch, Davey Johnson, Wally Moon, Michael Wacha, Ross Stripling and A.J. Minter.

**Back Home:** Batted .413 with seven homers during senior year at Keller High School; ascended from closer as a sophomore (posting 11-0 record with 11 saves) to ace as senior; compiled three-year record of 21-2... Keller High School also produced Shea Langeliers and Max Muncy 1.0.
