**YOUNG AND GROSHANS GO YARD IN CLOSE FOUGHT WEDNESDAY WIN:** Five one-hit innings from Luis Quiñones and solo home runs from Chavez Young and Jordan Groshans led New Hampshire to their second straight win on Wednesday. Adrian Hernandez struck out three in the ninth to pick up his second Double-A save while stranding the tying runner at third base. Chavez Young drove home the first run of the game with a single, before hitting his solo shot in the eighth.

**SOME RECORDS:** The 16.1 inning scoreless stretch that was broken last night in the seventh was the longest such streak for the Fisher Cats pitching staff this year. New Hampshire also tied the franchise record with three runners caught stealing yesterday, and Adrian Hernandez tied the record for most wild pitches in a game with four.

**UP NEXT:** The Fisher Cats conclude the season series with Hartford this week, before returning home for a 13-game homestand against Binghamton and Portland which will include the completion of a suspended game from July.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** August 19, 2018—The Fisher Cats wrapped up a series at ARM & HAMMER Park with a 12-1 win over second-place Trenton. New Hampshire staked Jordan Romano to an early lead on homers by Max Pentecost and Jon Berti, then erupted for seven in the ninth. Lourdes Gurriel Jr. hit a two-run homer in the frame and finished as one of six NH players with at least two hits. Romano improved to 11-7 and Kirby Sneed and Francisco Rios pitched scoreless relief.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays dropped their second straight game to the floundering Nationals, giving up four runs in the eighth to lose 8-5. The Blue Jays bullpen has surrendered 17 runs in the last four games. Buffalo and Syracuse were postponed for a second straight day, as Vancouver fell to Tri-City 6-3 and Fort Myers and Dunedin were suspended in the third inning. The DSL Blue Jays split a double-header and the FCL Jays lost 9-6 to the Tigers.

Maximo Castillo is coming off of his best start as a New Hampshire Fisher Cat, as he looks to pick up win number 10 on the year. Castillo went six innings, giving up five hits and no runs in New Hampshire's 7-0 shutout over Harrisburg last week. Hartford have hit him ewll on the year, however, reaching base at a .368 clip.

For Hartford, the former Yankees first round pick Ian Clarkin will get the start. The lefty struggled with Triple-A Albuquerque before being assigned to Hartford on August 10<sup>th</sup>. Clarkin gave up nine hits and three earned runs in just four innings in his lone Hartford appearance, picking up the loss against Binghamton. The Rockies are Clarkin's fifth organization in his career.

Frazee, who's 23, was selected by the Blue Jays in the 22<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2019 draft (Texas State). Compiled a 3-2 record with a 2.14 ERA in 11G (nine starts) for Adv. A Vancouver with 46 K in 42 IP and an impressive WHIP of just 0.88.

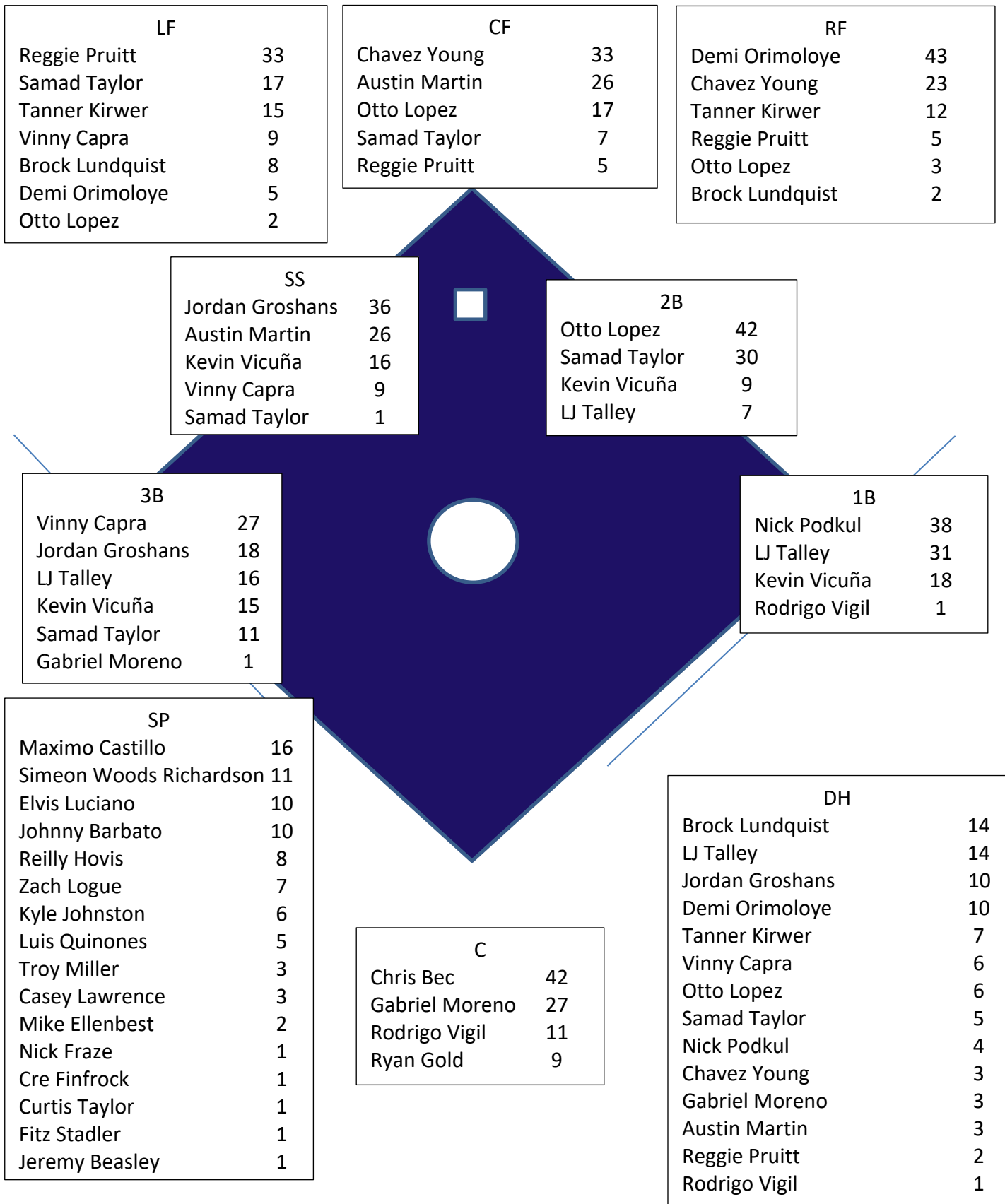
