2023: In his second start of the season and at the Double-A level on 4/12 @BNG, Fitts struck out a career-high 10 batters, which was the most he had struck out in a game since high school. Fitts matched this mark on 6/10 @HFD, when he also went 8.0 IP, matching his career-best mark.

2022: Split his pro debut season between Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley, winning Pitcher of the Week honors three times en route to being named a MiLB.com Yankees Organization All-Star in 2022. Began the season with 17 GS in Tampa, going 3-8 with a 5.01 ERA (79.0 IP, 73 H, 93 K, 17 BB). Won his first Florida State League Pitcher of the Week award on 6/27/22, after going 6.0 IP with 6 K, BB and allowing just one hit on 6/25/22 vs. CLR. During his final week with Single-A Tampa, won FSL Pitcher of the Week for a second time on 8/8/22, following another 6 IP, 0 R, 1 H, 7 K performance on 8/5/22 vs. CLR. Promoted to Hudson Valley on 8/9/22. Earned South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week honors after he took a perfect game into the eighth inning on 8/27/22 vs. HIC (8.0 IP, ER, 2 H, 0 BB, 7 K). Struck out a career-high nine batters in his penultimate start of the season on 9/1/22 vs. JS. Across 5 GS to end the season in Hudson Valley, Fitts went 4-0 with a 0.55 ERA (2 ER in 33.0 IP) with a 0.61 WHIP and .152 BAA. Cumulatively on the year, he went 7-8 with a 3.70 ERA and his 0.98 WHIP was the lowest of any qualifying Yankees minor leaguer in 2022.

Heading into his junior season at Auburn, he was named Second Team Preseason All-America by D1 Baseball, Third Team Preseason All-America by Baseball America and was named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.

Personal Notes: Attended Helena High School (AL) and was named a 2018 Rawlings-Perfect Game Honorable Mention All-American, after posting 102 K with a 1.68 ERA as a senior. Named a 2017 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention All-American, after he missed most of the season with an injury, but Helena won the AHSAA 6A State Championship and finished No. 1 in a national poll. Named All-Shelby County Honorable Mention as a sophomore. Brother, Trevor, played baseball at Mississippi State, before becoming an assistant coach at Austin Peay and now at the Tigers' High-A affiliate in West Michigan. Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL. Personal Notes: Sweeney attended St. Xavier High School in his hometown of Louisville, KY (same high school as actor Tom Cruise and golfer Justin Thomas, NFL quarterbacks Tony Romo and Jimmy Garoppolo). After entering his junior year at 5'4" in height, he hit an 8-inch growth spurt. Grew up a Reds fan, Ken Griffey Jr. was his favorite player and he would go to Red Triple-A games in Louisville as a kid. Sweeney went undrafted out of St. Xavier and EIU was the only college to offer him a scholarship.
