ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The Express earned a 9-4 win over the Isotopes on Thursday night. 1B Yohel Pozo cranked a 424foot home run to start the second frame to give the E-Train a 1-0 lead. In the fourth, C Sam Huff blasted a home run to center field and extended the lead to 2-0. A two-out double from Isotopes 1B D.J. Peterson scored two runs and leveled the score at two apiece. In the seventh, after Huff and LF Nick Solak singled, SS Davis Wendzel doubled to score Huff and give the E-Train a 3-2 advantage. With one out, 2B Ryan Dorow reached on an error from Albuquerque and both runs scored to increase the lead to 5-2. In the home-half, Treio singled with one out before a two-run bomb to left field from DH Michael Toglia trimmed the Round Rock lead to 5-4. The Express answered again in the eighth inning. With the bases loaded, Huff knocked in two runs with a double. Round Rock led 7-4. The E-Train offense added two more in the ninth inning. Dorow and 3B Josh Smith singled before Hernandez added a third consecutive single to bring the lead to 8-4. DH Josh Jung singled to add another run and the advantage increased to 9-4. RHP Tyler Duffey came in and threw a scoreless ninth inning to secure the win for Round Rock.

HERE COMES MILLER

Round Rock RHP Tyson Miller is slated to make his 25th appearance and 13th start of the season on Friday. Miller is 2-6 with a 4.89 ERA (38 ER/70.0 IP). He's issued 36 walks and collected 92 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting .263 against him.

HEAPING HELPING OF HUFF

C Sam Huff powered the Express offense last night, thanks to a 3-for-5 game with a home run, RBI and two runs scored. Huff's fourth-inning home run was his 18th of the season and it traveled 446 feet. The right-hander is hitting a home run once every 12.4 at-bats and leads the E-Train in home runs despite playing in only 58 games this year. He has an OPS of 844

MORE POZO PLEASE

C Yohel Pozo hit his first home run since June 9th and went 2-for-4 with a home run, RBI and a run scored yesterday. Pozo's on-base streak reached 20 games on Thursday. He has the second longest active streak in the Pacific Coast League behind Sacramento's 3B David Villar who sits at 27 games. Pozo is slashing .351/.388/.532 in 44 games this year. He has six home runs and 33 RBI.

CHASE-ING ZEROES

RHP Chase Lee extended his scoreless inning streak to 13.1 innings on Thursday. Lee last allowed an earned run on July 15. The right-hander surrendered 11 earned runs in his first five outings this season before allowing only two earned runs over his next 14 appearances out of the E-Train bullpen. In seven outings this month, he owns a 0.89 WHIP and has not issued a walk.

BULLY BULLPEN

The E-Train bullpen put together another phenomenal performance on Thursday. In their last nine games, they have posted a 1.43 ERA (7 ER/44.0 IP). RHP Ryder Ryan started the relief effort with 2.0 scoreless innings which included two hits and one strikeout. LHP John King allowed four runs but only two were earned. RHP Chase Lee earned his sixth hold of the year after a 1.1-inning performance that included only one hit and two strikeouts. RHP Tyler Duffey pitched a scoreless ninth with one hit, two walks and a strikeout.

PCL PLAYOFF RACE

The E-Train's win yesterday, coupled with an Oklahoma City Dodgers loss, puts the Express only 4.0 games back of first place in the PCL East.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.



Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball. men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
