Last Game: Dragons 5, Lugnuts 4. Jose Torres led off with a home run, Alex McGarry hit a two-run homer three batters later, and Dayton held off Lansing to prevail in the series opener. Dragons starter Joe Boyle tossed 4 2/3 hitless innings, walking six and striking out seven, though his scoreless streak to begin the year ended at 21 2/3 innings after reliever Evan Kravetz allowed an inherited runner to score.

Streaks, Extended and Halted: INF Euribiel Ángeles delivered an RBI single in four at-bats yesterday, increasing his team-high hitting streak to nine games. C Jared McDonald, meanwhile, extended his on-base streak to nine games though his eight-game hitting streak ended in an 0-for-2, 2-walk game. OF Lawrence Butler went 0-for-4, snapping his 11-game on-base streak.

By George, Brettl 3B Brett Harris's monster game yesterday (3-for-3, 2 HR, BB) marked his seventh multi-hit game of the year. Harris, slashing .346/.452/.846 this month, now ranks second in the Midwest League in both on-base percentage (.432) and OPS (1.002)

Others Among the MWL Leaders: OF Lawrence Butler is fourth in the Midwest League with 19 walks, INF Euribiel Ángeles is fourth with 34 hits, and reliever Angello Infante is first with 11 appearances tied for second with five saves.

Logue Won: 2018 Nuts ace lefty Zach Logue shut out the Detroit Tigers over seven five-hit innings last night, walking none and striking out six in the Athletics' 9-0 win at Comerica Park. It was just Logue's second career MLB start and third career MLB appearance.

Warming Up: Yesterday's gametime temperature of 79 degrees was the second-warmest first pitch of the year, trailing only April 23rd's 83-degree day. The Lugnuts have played 12 games this year with first-pitch temperature at 50 degrees or colder.

Athletics Farm Spotlight:

• Double-A Midland: DH Jordan Diaz, who excelled for the Lugnuts last year, went 2-for-4 with a double in the RockHounds' 3-1 loss to Corpus Christi. Diaz is hitting .280/.333/.520 in 25 games, riding the crest of a red hot May (13-for-37, 4 2B, 4 HR, .351/.385/.784).

165 Major League Nuts...: Infielder **Vinny Capra** (2018 in Lansing) debuted for the Blue Jays on May 1, becoming the 165th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fourth this year, joining A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and Oakland infielder **Christian Lopes**.

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in Tyler Soderstrom, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of seven Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager Brayan Buelvas (No. 9) and Euribiel Ángeles (No. 10), starting pitcher Joey Estes (No. 15), first baseman/outfielder Lawrence Butler (No. 17), pitcher Jeff Criswell (No. 18) and pitcher Grant Holman (No. 30).

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: The Lugnuts started right-hander Ryan Koch (pronounced "Cook") against South Bend Silver Hawks right-hander Ryan Cook (pronounced "Cook"). Johermyn Chavez and Brian Van Kirk hit back-to-back solo home runs in the 7th, but those were the only runs allowed by Ryan Cook in a 6-2 Silver Hawks win at The Cove.

2012: Kevin Pillar, batting sixth in the order, tied both the Midwest League and the Lugnuts franchise records, going 6-for-6 with a ninth-inning grand slam and six RBIs in a 16-4 rout at Fifth Third Field against the Dayton Dragons. Noah Syndergaard picked up the win in relief, striking out seven Dragons in four innings.

Personal: Criswell played the trombone, cello and guitar while growing up "but I didn't have any serious musical talent, that's probably why I took the career path I did"... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff's mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

Hail to the Victors: Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

The Run to Omaha: A look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

NCAA Regional: Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

NCAA Super Regional: Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and gamewinning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings. Michigan went on to eliminate UCLA in Game 3. advancing.

College World Series: Pitched the final two innings scorelessly, earning the save, in a 5-3 CWS-opening win over No. 8 Texas Tech, striking out Brian Klein with the tying runs aboard to end the game. Earned another save in a rematch with Texas Tech six days later, firing the final three innings scorelessly with six strikeouts to complete a 15-3 romp, sending the Wolverines into the CWS Finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt. Secured the final two outs in Game 1 against the Commodores, a 7-4 UM win. Worked the final five innings in relief, striking out seven, in Michigan's Game 3 series-clinching 8-2 loss to Vandy.

National Pride: Following the 2019 college baseball season, Jeff was invited to pitch for the Team USA Collegiate National Team... recorded yet another crucial save, firing the final three innings against Taiwan in Game 2 of their three-game series... limited opposing batters to a .120 average, best of all pitchers on the team.

Prospecting: Criswell is currently Keith Law's No. 12 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 9 A's pitching prospect and No. 22 overall prospect, and Fangraphs' No. 15 A's prospect... MLB Pipeline's grades: Fastball 60, Curve 50, Slider 55, Change 55, Control 45, writing about him, "Criswell's success as both a starter and reliever at the University of Michigan led to him landing a \$1 million signing bonus from the A's as a second-round pick in the 2020 Draft. After injuries limited him to just 12 innings pitched at High-A in what would have been his first full season with the organization, he did manage to end his year on a high note by returning in time to play in the Arizona Fall League and ranking among the league's top strikeout leaders.... He's been described as Bassitt-ish in reference to Chris Bassitt for similarities in their athletic builds."

2021 Pro Debut: Began 2021 as the highest ranked prospect on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster: Keith Law's No. 5 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 3 A's pitching prospect and No. 14 overall prospect, and Baseball America's No. 14 A's prospect. Wrote Law, "Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he'd had before the shutdown. Criswell's slider was a swing-and-miss pitch in college and it's gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too." ... started the fifth game of the Lugnuts season, May 8 vs. Lake County, and tossed two easy scoreless inings, but then spent May 12-August 27 on the Injured List, limiting season... made six appearances, three starts, for the Arizona Fall League champion Mesa Solar Sox: 2-1, 6.75 ERA, 22 2/3 IP, 26 H, 17 R/ER, 5 HR, 12 BB, 32 K, 3 HBP, 1 balk, 1.68 WHIP... 12.7 K/9 IP.

2022: Debuted as Lugnuts starter in the third game of the year, April 10 vs. Lake County... gave up two third-inning runs, but that was all in 4 2/3 innings in a no-decision... departed with the Nuts leading, 3-2... Lansing went on to win, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep... started April 16 at West Michigan; gave up 1st-inning (two-run) and 3rd-inning (solo) home runs to West Michigan's Jake Holton in suffering his first professional defeat... Midwest League Pitcher of the Week: started Game 2 of a doubleheader April 30 at Lake County, taking a no-hitter into the 7th inning before allowing a Petey Halpin single; finished with a one-hit shutout in 8-0 Lugnuts win: 68 pitches, 1 H, 1 BB, 6 K.

Last start: May 7 vs. West Michigan – appeared to be on his way to finishing five scoreless innings with a 4-0 lead to his back before serving up a three-run HR to Corey Joyce; that spelled the end, with final line 4 2/3 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 7 K... 89 pitches, 55 strikes... Lugnuts ran out of pitching after nine innings, using Joshwan Wright on the mound in a 7-7 game in the 10th; West Michigan scored four runs off of Wright and hung on for an 11-10 win.
