FRISCO CANNOT HOLD 10-RUN LEAD IN CRUSHING DEFEAT:

Despite holding an 11-1 advantage in the seventh, the Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Amarillo Sod Poodles 12-11 in 10 innings on Wednesday night from HODGETOWN. With the RoughRiders (8-9) out in front 11-1 in the top of the seventh, Amarillo (10-7) scored three runs in the home half of the seventh and seven more to tie the game in the bottom of the eighth inning. Deyvison De Los Santos ripped a game-tying base hit to left in the inning after Jordan Lawlar made it a one-run game with a three-run homer. In the bottom of the 10th, Lawlar led off the inning against Riders reliever **Marc Church** (0-1) and hammered an RBI double down the right-field line to walk it off. Blake Workman (1-0) threw 3.1 hitless, scoreless frames in relief to earn the victory for Amarillo. On the offensive side for Frisco, both **Nick Tanielu** and **Scott Kapers** blasted solo homers in the third while **Luisangel Acuña**, **Kellen Strahm** and **Chris Seise** each collected two hits apiece.

THE LAW OF AVERAGES COMES BACK:

The RoughRiders bullpen was the second best in Minor League Baseball after the first nine games of the season with a 1.76 ERA. Since then, the Riders bullpen has a 7.27 ERA (28ER/34.2IP) in eight games.

O(wen), THAT'S QUALITY:

On Tuesday, Owen White threw the first quality start for the RoughRiders this season when he tossed six innings, allowing three runs while striking out four. He retired the first 10 he saw and allowed just one hit through five shutout innings before ceding a run in the sixth and left two on in the seventh when he exited, both of which came into score.

AND WE THOUGHT WE WERE SAFE:

The RoughRiders fell to the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Tuesday 9-7, twice leading by six runs. It was the first time that the RoughRiders lost a game leading by at least six runs since May 13th, 2007 when the RoughRiders dropped a game 9-8 to the Midland Rock-Hounds. In that game, Frisco led 8-1 in the top of the seventh before Midland scored seven runs in the bottom of the seventh to tie it and one in the eighth to take the lead. Similarly, on Tuesday, the Riders allowed six in the seventh to tie the game and two runs in the eighth for the go-ahead tallies. On Wednesday, Frisco led 11-1 before falling 12-11 in 10 innings. The 10-run lead that the Riders could not hold was the largest lead lost in a defeat in recorded franchise history (back to 2005).

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 23 RBIs with the bases loaded this season. As a team, they are hitting .350 (7-for-20)/.320/.900/1.220 with three grand slams and 23 RBIs. They are one of just two teams in Minor League Baseball with at least three grand slams this season already (Triple-A Round Rock) as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another on Sunday in San Antonio and **Luisangel Acuña** blasted on on Thursday.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed seven errors through 17 games and committed their first position player error on Sunday in San Antonio. The team's .988 fielding percentage is tied for first in Minor League Baseball (Sugar Land). Their seven errors are the fewest in the minors.

WALK THIS WAY:

The Riders hitters worked 40 walks in the six games against the San Antonio Missions, which was the sixth-most in the minors last week. On the season, Frisco's 95 walks lead Double-A while their .358 team OBP is second in Double-A. Both **Evan Carter** and **Dustin Harris** are tied for the Double-A lead with 16 walks and Carter is first in OBP (.514).

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders eight wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10, four runs, eight runs and three runs, respectively, while their nine losses have come by a combined 25 runs. That gives Frisco a +28 run differential through 17 games, which is second in the Texas League despite being fourth in the South Division. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 11-5 (+32). The RoughRiders have scored at least six runs 10 times (8-2) and scored three or fewer runs seven times (0-7).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 13 of his 14 games this season, batting .358 (19-for-53)/.514/.604/1.118 with a double, four home runs, 16 walks, 18 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is fifth in the Texas League in average (.358), tied for sixth in home runs (4), second in RBIs (18), tied for first in walks (16) and fifth in OPS (1.118). The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter is also the third-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo and 20-year-old Juan Santander of Corpus Christi. Since going 0-for-4 for the only time this season on Saturday in San Antonio, Carter has walked 11 times to one strikeout over six games with a 1.244 OPS.

ABOUT ROBY

-On his name Tekoah: Born in Hendersonville, North Carolina and, about two hours away in Georgia, there is a beautiful area named Toccoa Falls with waterfalls and outdoor activities. His parents were driving around there one day and liked the way it sounded, so they changed the spelling and named their son Tekoah.

-Originally committed to Troy University in Alabama.

-Paired a 7-3 record with a 1.19 ERA in his junior season at Pine Forest High School in Pensacola, Fla., earning the 2019 Pensacola News Journal Pitcher of the Year award...recorded 109 strikeouts against just 10 walks that season while contributing a .384 batting average and 28 RBI at the plate to lead Pine Forest to its first regional appearance in 12 years.

-Is one of several Texas minor leaguers enrolled in the club's 'RangersU Powered by ACU' program, which allows players and coaches to earn academic credit by taking online courses taught by Abilene Christian University faculty and staff in both English and Spanish.

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 12 prospect in the Rangers system per MLB.com.

-Struck out seven over six innings on April 15th in San Antonio, allowing all four runs with two outs (two runs in the second inning and two runs in the sixth before he exited).

2022 SEASON

-Was one of the youngest starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League, pitching the entire season at the age of 20.

-Late in the season, he added a slider to give himself a true four-pitch mix.

-Led the Crawdads staff in innings pitched (104.2) and strikeouts (126).

-Over his first six starts, he allowed 23 runs (7.67 ERA), but rebounded to collect a 3.59 ERA over his last 16 games (15 starts), starting on May 24th.

-In his last five starts, Roby owned a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP), striking out 36 batters to just five walks.

-On August 19th, he threw an immaculate inning against Winston-Salem (nine pitches with three strikeouts).

2021 SEASON

-Made only six starts because of an elbow sprain in June, but did not have surgery.

-It was a proximal tear in the UCL, which heals easier than a distal tear without surgery.

-In six starts, struck out 38.9% of hitters (35 of 90) and held opponents to a .177 batting average against.
