Welcome to the Postseason

For the first time since 2019, the Fightin Phils open up the postseason on Tuesday night against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. The teams met 24 times during the regular season, with the season-series being split at 12 games a piece. In the 12 meets in both ballparks this season, both Reading and Hartford each won six games. Following Tuesday's game one in Reading and an off day on Wednesday, the teams will head to Dunkin' Park in Hartford for game two on Thursday at 6:30 p.m. and if needed, game three on Friday at 6:30 p.m.

Finished the Season in Style

The Fightin Phils wrapped up the 2026 regular season with a 17-7 win over Erie on Sunday, clinching a 4-2 series victory over the postseason-bound Sea-Wolves. Ryan Dromboski started for Reading and earned his first Double-A win in just his second start with Reading, striking out eight over five innings, while allowing four runs on four hits. Kevin Warunek, Sam Carlson, Daniel Harper and Estibenzon Jimenez each tossed an inning each of relief, combining to allow one-earned run on four hits over the final-four innings of the contest. Reading was led by four hits from catcher Luis Caicuto, who doubled twice and hit his first Double-A home run. Bryan Rincon lifted two home runs, one from each side of the plate, along with three hits and five RBI. Aroon Escobar, Carson DeMartini and Austin Murr each also chipped in two hits. Reading had five home runs on the day, including shots from DeMartini and Escobar, while they slugged 10 extra-base hits in the regular season-ending win.

It's Been a While

Tuesday's playoff game against Hartford will be Reading's firstpostseason game since Sept. 6, 2019, at Trenton; marking 2,566 days between postseason games for the Fightin Phils. The R-Phils have not won a playoff game since a 13-5 win over Trenton on Sept. 9, 2016, which was 3,658 days ago. If Reading is to win this series and qualify for the Eastern League Championship, it would be the Fightin Phils first playoff series win, and Championship appearance, since the 2015 season, 11 years ago.

Season in Review

The Fightin Phils finished the 2026 season with a 70-67 overall record, which was their first 70-win season, and most wins, since they won 80 games in 2019. Reading finished 30-39 in the first half and turned things around with a 40-28 record in the second half, winning the Northeast Division Title for the latter half of the season. This comes after the R-Phils won 55 games in 2025, which was their second-fewest wins in a season in franchise history, marking a 15-win improvement from last season to this year. Reading Manager Al Pedrique finished the 2026 campaign with 243 wins with the Fightin Phils, ranking as the sixth-most managerial wins in R-Phils history.

The First Fightin

Phillies Top Prospect, and MLB's No. 32 prospect, Gage Wood gets the ball for game one of the Eastern League Divisional Series. Over 17 Double-A appearances this season, Wood went 1-3, with a 4.72 ERA (36 ER, 68.2 IP). He also struck out 99 batters, finishing the season with a 12.98 strikeout-per-nine-innings ratio. He earned his first-career win last Wednesday against Erie, allowing two runs over five innings, while firing 78 pitches and 54 strikes. Wood was selected by the Phillies in the first round (26th overall) of the 2025 draft out of Arkansas, where he famously threw a 19-strikeout no-hitter in the College World Series.

Brining Prospects to the Postseason

The Fightin Phils enter the postseason with three of MLB Pipeline's Top-100 prospects on their roster. Gage Wood (No. 32) leads the way, and he is joined by Aidan Miller (No. 60) and Bryan Rincon (No. 100). Reading's roster also features nine of the Phillies Top-30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline: Gage Wood (1), Aidan Miller (2), Bryan Rincon (4), Aroon Escobar (6), Dante Nori (7), Cody Bowker (15), Wen-Hui Pan (21), Carson DeMartini (24) and Mavis Graves (27).

Leading the Way

Bryan Rincon finished off a career-year in 2026, ranking all over the Eastern League leaderboards. Over 118 games, Rincon slashed .267/.410/.517 (.927 OPS), along with 92 runs, 24 doubles, 26 home runs, 67 RBI and 30-34 in stolen bases. Rincon finished the season leading the Eastern League in home runs (26), on-base percentage (.410), OPS (.927) and walks (95), while finishing second in runs. Raylin Heredia also turned in a career-year in 2026, posting a .278/.317/.473 (.790 OPS) slash line across 135 games. He asssed 84 runs, 35 doubles, one triple, 23 home runs, 74 RBI and was 25-32 in stolen bases. Heredia finished the season leading the Eastern League in hits (151), doubles (35), extra-base hits (59) and total bases (257). Both players finished the seasons as members of the exclusive 20-20-20 club, finishing with more than 20 doubles, 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases.

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 15, 2015: At Reading, Zach Eflin leads Reading to a 3-1 victory in Game 1 of the Eastern League Championship Series by holding Bowie scoreless on 5 hits over 6.0 innings. Brock Stassi gets the Phils on the board with a solo homer into the pool in the 4th inning while Art Charles crushes a solo shot that hits off the top of the brick wall in right field in the 7th.

On the Other Side

Hartford finished the 2026 season with a 66-71 overall record and won the Northeast Division First Half Title with a 39-29 overall record, before going 27-42 in the second half. The Yard Goats most recently dropped four-of-six games at Somerset to finish the regular season. Hartford's roster features five of the Rockies' top-30 prospects (MLB Pipeline): Jackson Cox (8), Jared Thomas (10), Andy Perez (15), Konner Eaton (17) and Roynier Hernandez (30).

Goats Game One Starter

Righty Connor Staine gets the ball in game one for Hartford. Staine appeared in 25 games this season, making 22 starts, and went 7-3, with a 4.60 ERA (63 ER, 123.1 IP), while striking out 117 batters. Staine last pitched on Wednesday at Somerset, allowing no runs over four innings, with four strikeouts. Across five games/three starts against Reading this season, Staine was 1-1, with a 6.35 ERA (16 ER, 22.2 IP), along with 17 strikeouts and 16 walks. Staine spent all of last season with Hartford, 2024 with Spokane (A+) and '23 with Fresno (A). The 25-year old was drafted in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Florida, where he pitched in 2022. Before that, Staine pitched at Maryland in 2020 and '21.
