TODAY'S HEADLINES

Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 288-270 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints fell behind early 3-0, but rallied late and got a strong showing from the bullpen in a 4-3 win in Omaha. Travis Adams made his Triple-A debut, allowing three runs in the first inning but settled down after, not allowing a run over the next four frames. The Saints walked the bases loaded in the second, but did not score and did not collect a hit until the fifth inning. The Saints scored a pair of runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh, taking the lead on a Yunior Severino RBI double. The bullpen combination of Jeff Brigham, Giovanny Gallegos and Hobie Harris allowed just one hit over the final 4.0 innings, combining to retire the final 10 batters of the game in the victory.

EVERYONE SAY HELLO TO E-ROD: Emmanuel Rodriguez was transferred to the Saints' roster on Monday. Rodriguez is ranked as the #3 prospect in the Twins' organization by both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America, as well as the the #15 and #21 prospect in the game by both publications, respectively. In 37 games with the Double-A Wichita, Rodriguez hit. 298/.479/.621 with a 1.100 OPS before landing on the Injured List on June 7. Since then he played in two minor league rehab games with the FCL Twins on July 6 and July 8 before enduring a setback. He last played on August 30 with Single-A Fort Myers, going 0-for-3 with a walk.

REHAB RUNDOWN: Byron Buxton joins the Saints today on a Major League Rehab assignment, his second of the season. Buxton was placed on the Twins' 10-Day Injured List on August 15 (retro August 13) with right hip inflammation. In his previous rehab stint, Buxton went 0-for-6 with an RBI. In his 13 career games with the Saints, Buxton has hit .275 (11-40) with two doubles, a triple, three home runs

BULLPEN BRILLIANCE: The Saints' bullpen was masterful in their 4-3 victory on Sunday. The win snapped a streak of five consecutive Sunday losses and gave the Saints their first series finale victory since July 21 at Toledo out of the All-Star break vs. East.....14-16 and their first six-game series finale win July 7 against Gwinnett. The bullpen threw 4.0 innings of shutout baseball, allowing just one hit. It marks the third time this season the bullpen had thrown at least 4.0 innings, allowed one hit and did not allow a walk or a run.

> A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: DaShawn Keirsey Jr. has put together an impressive 2024 campaign, recording 116 hits, 14 home runs and 34 stolen bases. He is the only International League player and one of two in Triple-A (Samad Taylor - TAC) this season to record at least 100 hits, 10 home runs and 30 steals. He is one of 14 minor leaguers to amass those totals this season.

S Keirsey Jr. is now tied for third on the single-season hit totals at 116, trailing Jose Miranda (117, 2021), Tomás Telís (125, 2021) and the franchise record set by Andrew Stevenson at 132 hits last season.

Since the start of August, Keirsey Jr. ranks among league leaders in stolen bases (T-1st, 11), triples (T-1st, 3), hits (3st, 33), runs (T-5th, 20), total bases (7th, 52) and batting average (8th, .340).

ways to get on base, sporting a .408 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 40 of the 46 games he's played in, drawing 21 walks and been hit by a pitch seven times. He is fifth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .433 across three levels.

When Saints Score 4+......54-28 hit .319 (87-for-273), with 13 home runs, drawing 44 walks, owning a .923 OPS. In that time, Severino is third in the league in hits and in batting average, fifth with 52 RBI and on-base percentage at .407, sixth in OPS, and ninth in total bases with 140. His 44 walks in that span are the eighth most in the league.

Severing has now collected 109 hits on the season, becoming the sixth player in franchise history, and second this season (DaShawn Keirsey Jr.), to surpass the 100-hit mark in a single season.
