**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Memphis Redbirds continue a nine-game homestand and wrap up a six-game series against the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Right-handed pitcher Michael McGreevy is slated to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Logan Henderson for Nashville.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Memphis Redbirds continued a nine-game homestand and six-game series against the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) with a 9-8 loss on Saturday night at AutoZone Park. Down 8-1 entering the bottom of the sixth, Memphis rallied for seven runs in the frame to tie the game. Right fielder Michael Siani smacked a two-run single to bring the tying run to the plate. A batter later, left fielder Matt Koperniak drilled a triple off the top of the right-center field wall. Center fielder Nathan Church followed with a hustle infield single to tie the game. The Redbirds rallied against two Nashville pitchers, both entered the game with a season ERA under 2.00. Church reached safely four times in five plate appearances with two walks and two singles. The left-handed hitter scored a run, drove in a run and earned an outfield assist to end the four-run top of the sixth inning. Starting pitcher Quinn Mathews allowed four runs on two hits, walked four and struck out six in 4.2 innings pitched. After striking out the first two batters of the fifth inning, Mathews allowed the next three to reach and was taken out of the game. All three runs scored. Chris Roycroft (1-1) allowed a solo home run in the top of the ninth and was given the loss. The right-handed pitcher struck out two in 2.0 innings pitched and rolled a double play to escape the top of the eighth.

**RED, WHITE & BOOM:** Friday marked the first Memphis Redbirds home game on the Fourth of July since the Redbirds defeated the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 2-1 in 2021. Before the 6-1 loss to Nashville, Memphis had not lost a July 4 home game in regulation since 2013 against the Nashville Sounds (2-1 overall, only loss: 2-1 in 12 innings against Omaha, 2018). Last year, Memphis defeated Nashville 10-3 at First Horizon Park in Nashville. Matt Koperniak, Jordan Walker and Luken Baker each drove in two runs in the win. Baker smacked a home run and a double. Gordon Graceffo allowed one earned run in a rain-delay shortened 2.0-inning start.

Ben Johnson enters his seventh season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his seventh year in the Cardinals organization.

- Became the all-time winningest manager in franchise history on May 21, 2025 (368 wins)

- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contension for division until 2nd to last day of the
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
  • Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona
- Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

 Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

#### PLAYING CAREER

 Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

 Clark is beginning his third season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season.
