LUG-NOTES

Marcheco's Home Charm: Tonight's Lansing starter, **Jorge Marcheco**, has allowed just two runs in 27 innings at home, a 0.67 ERA. Contrast that with his 8.28 road ERA, allowing 27 runs in 29 1/3 innings.

A Season of Milestones: This season, the Nuts' 30th in Lansing, has seen the club pass 1,000 all-time players, 2,000 all-time wins, and 4,000 all-time games, and **Carlos Beltrán** became the first Lansing Lugnut to be inducted into the Hall of Fame.

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have suited up 54 different players this year, 26 position players and 28 pitchers (plus one scoreless inning from **Gunner Gouldsmith**), bringing the total to 1,012 players all time. The team record for most players used in one season: 55.

Climb the Ladder: 18 members of the 2026 Lugnuts have advanced to the upper levels of the minors...

- **Ryan Magdic**, **Jake Garland**, **Devin Taylor** and **Davis Diaz** have reached Triple-A Las Vegas.

- **Kyle Robinson** was traded to Pittsburgh, then swapped again to the Angels at the deadline; he is now with Double-A Rocket City.

Alum Spotlight: **Devin Taylor** went 3-for-5 with three runs scored and a pair of sliding catches, helping the Aviators beat the El Paso Chihuahuas, 8-5. Taylor is 9-for-19, a .474 avg., in his first four games in Triple-A.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics. 48 former Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season, not including former Nuts managers / current MLB managers **Clayton McCullough** (Miami) and **John Schneider** (Toronto).

Streiking:

- **Jake Reinisch** went 2-for-5 last night to extend his on-base streak to 43 games; he's batting .315 with a .465 OBP and a .527 slugging pct. during the streak, with 46 base hits and 39 walks. It is the longest active streak in the minors.
- **Jared Davis** went 3-for-5 yesterday and has now hit safely in his first 11 games with the Lugnuts, batting .425 / .511 / .625 (17-for-40 with seven walks).

Formula for a Leadoff Hitter: After he went hitless in his first six High-A at-bats, **Alex Fernandes** has reached base in 10 of his last 15 plate appearances, going 7-for-11 with six singles, one double, three walks and a sacrifice fly, stealing two bases and scoring seven runs. The 23-year-old Fernandes was signed by the A's in July out of San Jose State; this three-game stint with Lansing constitutes his pro debut.

1-2 Punch: Combining the stats of Lansing's 1-2 hitters, **Alex Fernandes** and **Jared Davis**, for the first four games of this series: 14-for-34, 14 runs scored, 6 walks, 4 steals, 5 doubles, one triple, and a .412 / .488 / .618 slash line.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts lead all of High-A in turning double plays, 122. Fort Wayne is in 3rd with 114 double plays.

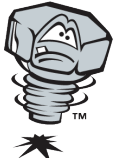

SEPTEMBER 5 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: In Game 1 of a doubleheader, Lake County SS Casey Frawley became the first player to homer off the Classic Park lighthouse in center field – the prize: \$1,000 split between Frawley and a random Captains fan – and the Caps beat the Lugnuts, 8-6. In Game 2, the Lugnuts' Daniel Webb came one out from throwing a seven-inning no-hitter before Chase Burnette broke it up with a single to center field. Casey Beck relieved Webb and finished off a 3-1 Lugnuts win.

2018: Taylor Walls scored from second base on a Ronaldo Hernandez infield single in the top of the 10th, and the Bowling Green Hot Rods won Game 1 of the playoffs, 4-3 over the Lugnuts at Cooley Law School Stadium. The game featured two different rain delays totaling 51 minutes, and the game was played in a tense three hours and nine minutes. The Lugnuts had rallied from 1-0 and 3-1 deficits, tying the score in the fifth on an Andres Sotillo oppo home run to right-center and again in the eighth on a two-out Norberto Obeso two-run triple to right. 19-year-old Maximo Castillo allowed only two hits and one run (a Jim Haley solo homer) in 5 2/3 innings in a no-decision.
