RIDERS AMBUSH DRILLERS IN 9-7 WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders beat the Tulsa Drillers 9-7 behind an early offensive flurry at Riders Field on Friday night to win the first game of the series. After **Leandro Lopez** gave up a first-inning run, Frisco (9-10) responded with four of their own off of Tulsa (14-5) starter Payton Martin (0-2). **Julian Brock** singled in **Frainyer Chavez** and **Dylan Dreiling**, before **Keith Jones II** and **Keyber Rodriguez** picked up RBIs for a 4-1 lead. Tulsa scored two more in the second, though the Riders' offense launched another four-run rally. **Marcus Lee Sang** and **Corey Joyce** started the inning off with hits and got knocked in on a Chavez single and Dreiling sacrifice fly. Brock then singled home another run and Rodriguez doubled in the eighth of the night. From there, Frisco's bullpen shut things down as **Eric Loomis** pitched a scoreless fifth and **Ryan Lobus** (2-1) spun three perfect innings with four strikeouts. Off the back of a Joyce solo home run in the fifth, Frisco carried a 9-6 lead into the ninth and **Ricardo Velez** picked up his first save of the season, working around two two-out hits.

YELLOW CITY HANGOVER:

The RoughRiders showed out on offense in Amarillo last week, hitting .318/.410/.592/1.002 with 14 home runs and 54 runs scored (9.0 runs per game) in six games. This week, in the first three games in this series, the Riders were hitting .156 (12-for-77)/.272/.299/.571 with 7 total runs before exploding for 9 runs on 11 hits in game four Friday. Including Friday, Frisco is now hitting .211/.323/.358/.681 in the four games with 16 runs (4.0 R/G).

LEE SANG IT AND BANG IT:

Marcus Lee Sang carried his dominance last week back home to Frisco. In his last 9 games, he has slashed .400 (12-for-30)/.514/.800/1.314 with 3 doubles, 3 home runs and 7 RBIs. In a two-home run game last week, he hit a laser that was 113 mph off the bat and a moonshot over the batters' eye, which went an estimated 466 feet. The former Phillies farmhand is now hitting .300/.382/.500/.882 in 17 games to start the season.

ORLANDO, WHERE DREAMS COME TRUE:

Orlando Martinez continues to hit for the Riders. The leading qualified hitter on the Riders, batting .318, Martinez is en fuego in his last 9 games, slashing .389 (14-for-36)/.450/.694/1.144 with 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBIs, 4 walks, 6 walks and 2 stolen bases.

CHAVEZ IN CHARGE:

RoughRiders infielder **Frainyer Chavez** has been on fire at the plate. In his 19 games, he has reached in 18, and is hitting .293 (22-for-75)/.396/.533/.929 with 3 doubles, 5 home runs, 13 RBIs, 13 walks and 20 runs scored. He hit his second leadoff home run of the season in game two of the doubleheader on Wednesday and his fifth home run of the year, tying his Double-A career high. In his first 4 years in Double-A he had averaged a home run every 63 at-bats, while he has averaged a home run every 15 at-bats this year. It took him 88 games to reach 5 Double-A home runs last year. His career high in home runs in a season is 8, which was last year, including his time in Triple-A Round Rock. The five-year RoughRider is 9th in the league in T-1st in runs (20), T-2nd in home runs (5), and T-5th in total bases (40).

KEEP YOUR FRIENDS CLOSE AND YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER:

The RoughRiders have played plenty of close games to start the season. Though they are 9-10, they are 9-5 in 9-innings games and 0-4 in games which have gone to extra innings. Frisco is just 3-5 in one-run games this year and all three losses in Amarillo came by two runs or fewer.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 19 games the RoughRiders are 1st in the Texas League with 182 hits. They are second in the league in batting average (.279) and 2nd in runs (116, 6.1 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. The Riders are 3rd in the Texas League in homers (26) while they are 2nd in SLG (.457) and OPS (.819). For perspective, the Yankees led MLB last year with a .787 team OPS.

QUITE THE DEBUT:

RoughRiders infielder **Corey Joyce** collected two hits, including a three-run home run, in his first Frisco start last Wednesday in Amarillo. After being signed as a MiLB free agent on April 8th, he joined the Riders on April 14th. In 7 total games, he is hitting .500 (12-for-24)/.556/1.000/1.556 with 3 doubles, 3 home runs and 10 RBIs. With Double-A Knoxville in the Cubs organization last year, he hit just two home runs in 92 games with a .272/.393/.347/.740 slashline.

VS. TULSA:

The Riders went just 2-4 against Tulsa in their only meeting last year and this series marks one of two times the Ranger and Dodger affiliates will clash in 2026, including a three-game series out of the All-Star Break from July 17th-19th. In their 34 games head-to-head in the last six seasons, Frisco is just 14-20 against Tulsa.

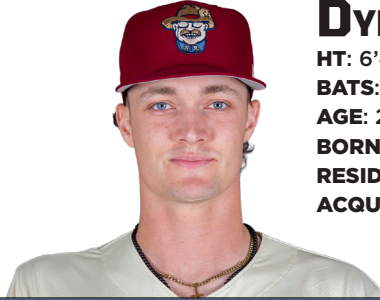

ABOUT DYLAN

- Drafted in 2020 out of Central Catholic High School in Portland, Oregon.
- Named 2019 Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year in junior year, leading all Oregon pitchers in wins (10), ERA (0.51), strikeouts (128) and WHIP (0.71). Led Rams to 6-A State Championship game against Jesuit (nicknamed the "Holy War") and faced now-Phillies pitcher Mick Abel. Jesuit won 2-1 in 13 innings.
- Was named as the No. 2 pitcher in Oregon's 2020 class behind Abel.
- At 13 years old, he pitched for Oregon in the opening round of the 2015 Little League World Series. In 1-0 loss to Texas, he threw 5.2 innings, striking out 12 batters.
- Before signing with the Rangers, MacLean was committed to the University of Washington.

2026 SEASON

- Opening the season as the Saturday starter for the RoughRiders

2025 SEASON

- Returned from injury to High-A Hub City, dominating at home (2.45 ERA as opposed to a 4.08 ERA on the road)
- After allowing five runs in his second appearance, he dominated in his last 19G (10GS), to the tune of a 3-1 record and 2.70 ERA.
- Started two games in the playoffs, allowing three runs in 8.0 innings, striking out 7 to 1 walk

2024 SEASON

- Missed the entire season with "Tommy John" surgery.

- As a starter, went 1-1 with a 2.89 ERA over 7 games. As a reliever, went 6-4 with a 3.38 ERA.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
