- The Blue Jays stranded a season-high 15 men on base, going 1-12 with runners in scoring position, in a 5-4 defeat to St. Lucie on Friday night.
- The loss snaps the Jays' five-game win streak and the Mets' 8-game losing streak.
- Dunedin stranded runners in eight straight innings to end the game, including the bases loaded in the seventh and runners on second and third in the bottom of the ninth.
- Fernando Perez finished his start with six innings and four earned runs - with all the damage coming in a four-run, three-hit third inning.
- The game finished following an hour and 20 minute lightning delay with two outs in the bottom of the seventh inning after Dunedin scored two runs to tie the game at four.

## FEELING STREAKY

Following six straight wins to climb to 20-20 last week, the Blue Jays lost three straight to Bradenton. Following those three straight losses, Dunedin won five straight - a streak that was snapped last night.

## APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY HOMERS

After going 10-12 in April, Dunedin played to a 15-12 record in May, thanks in part to a surge in power. The Blue Jays belted 27 home runs in May - the most in all of Single-A, and six more than the next-closest FSL team (Clearwater, 21). The month was highlighted by two lengthy win streaks - a six-gamer from 5/15 to 5/21, and a five-game stretch from 5/25 to 5/30. The streaks followed a slow start, as the Jays lost 7 of the first 10 games of the month.

## COMFORTABLE WHEN IT'S CLOSE

Last night's game marked the fifth contest of the team's last eight decided by one run. Dunedin has played 18 one-run games (9-9). The Jays have won six of their last eight one-run contests. 34 of the Blue Jays 49 games this season (69%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 18-17 record in those games.

## JAYS JUICE

With three homers Thursday, the Blue Jays took the FSL lead with 38 home runs this season. The team trails Modesto by two homers for the Single-A lead. Dunedin has homered in 15 of their last 18 games. Across that stretch, 10 different players have gone deep. Last night's loss snapped a streak of seven straight games with a home run.

## A CAVEMAN COULD DO IT

Nolan Perry is set to make his fifth start with the Blue Jays this evening. Perry was drafted out of Carlsbad HS (NM) in 2022 after winning New Mexico's Gatorade Player of the Year award and a state championship. Carlsbad's team mascot is the Cavemen.

## NO BULL FROM THE 'PEN

Much of the Blue Jays' success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 3.14 ERA with a 1.22 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 5.63 ERA with a 1.72 WHIP. Last night's game-deciding run, an RBI double against JJ Sanchez, was unearned.

## REHAB CITY, USA

With Peyton Williams and Damiano Palmegiani assigned to the D-Jays this week, Dunedin has hosted eight MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. MLB rehabbers Alek Manoah and Erik Swanson both pitched on April 7 against Lakeland.

## PALMEGIANI PARTY

Damiano Palmegiani, the Blue Jays No. 14 prospect, joins the Blue Jays tonight on a rehab assignment from AAA-Buffalo. Palmegiani played 56 games with Dunedin in 2022, hitting .256 with 11 homers before his promotion to A+ Vancouver. Palmegiani belted 23 homers in 2023 between AA-New Hampshire and AAA-Buffalo.

## WELCOME BACK, WILLIAMS

First baseman Peyton Williams began a rehab assignment with the D-Jays last night. Williams, a 2022 7th round draft pick, has spent parts of the last two seasons with Dunedin, hitting .274 with 7 homers in 45 games. He was selected as the league's best first baseman according to Baseball America's survey of FSL coaches last season. Williams is the seventh minor or major league rehabber to appear in Dunedin this season.
