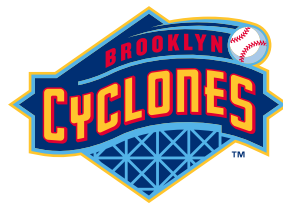

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn dropped their 2nd-straight contest to Hudson Valley on Wednesday night...Cyclones rallied to erase a 3-run deficit in the 7th...CF **Alex Ramírez** delivered an RBI single in that frame as part of a season-high-tying 3-hit night...C **Kevin Parada** provided the game-tying run-scoring triple...He collected 2 hits and 2 RBI...Renegades took the lead for good on a RF **Aldenis Sánchez** RBI knock in the 8th...He added a 2-run triple in the 9th, as part of a 2-hit, 3-RBI game...RHP **Robert Colina** whiffed 7 over 3.1 innings of shutout relief for Brooklyn...RHP **Nick Paciorek** recorded the game's final 4 outs, earning his 3rd save for the 'Gades.

**A-RAM IT:** OF **Alex Ramírez** tied a season-high with 3 hits — adding an RBI — on Wednesday night vs. Hudson Valley...In the month of June, the 20-year-old is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in walks (12)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (65) and is 4 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...He is also tied for 4th in hits (116), 5th in total bases (174), and 6th in doubles (26).

**PARADA DAY:** C **Kevin Parada** has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .319/.373/.489 with a .862 OPS and 136 wRC+ in 12 games...Parada has accrued 5 runs scored, a triple, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 3 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...Additionally, the Pasadena, Calif. native enters Thursday on a 4-game hitting streak (7-for-16) and a 9-game on-base streak (.324/.395/.471)...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Thursday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (14).

**TY-NAMIC:** RHP **Tyler Stuart** tossed 6.0 innings of 1-run ball last Friday night and is as imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.47)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (88.2%) and FIP (2.88), 3rd in xFIP (3.36), 6th in strikeout rate (30.0%), 7th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.96), 9th in batting average against (.218), and 10th in WHIP (1.15).

**RELIEF READY:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.23) in the entire South Atlantic League and 2nd-best among all High-A teams...The Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids leads (3.13) lead the classification...Hudson Valley (3.27) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 3rd best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.03).

**OH YEAH, OMAR:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** has picked up steam at the plate in June...Since the beginning of the month, De Los Santos is batting .279 (19-68) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 9 RBI, and 8 stolen bases...The right-handed swinger is tied for 3rd in the SAL in stolen bases (8) during June...Additionally, De Los Santos has added 26 stolen bases in 2022 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 95 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 5th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (103), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (100), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (98), and Red Sox INF **David Hamilton** (97)...De Los Santos has also snagged 56 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 40...Omar is already 6 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

**YO-JOANDER:** RHP **Joander Suárez** continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new-career-high with 6+ innings of work in Tuesday's defeat...Suárez allowed just 1 run on 2 hits, walking 3 and striking out a season-high-matching 8...His 91 pitches also set a career-high...Over his last 2 starts, Suárez has a 1-1 record and a 3.27 ERA (4 ER in 11.0 IP)...The Cumaná, Venezuela native has punched out 16 and walked 6, allowing just 6 hits...Suárez holds a rate of 13.09 strikeouts-per-9-innings and a strikeout rate of 35.6% (16/45) in that span.

**DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE:** RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 10 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.08 ERA (2 ER in 16.2 IP) on 5 hits and 7 walks, registering 25 strikeouts (13.50 K/9)...That equates to a 39.7 K% (25/63).

**LOVE THE DRAKE!** C **Drake Osborn** posted a career-best performance in Saturday's win at Aberdeen...The 24-year-old tallied a professional-high-tying 3 hits and collected his 1st career multi-home run game...Osborn added a season-best 4 RBI, as well...His 1st 3-hit night came on April 30, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie vs. Daytona...The multi-home run performance was the first by a Cyclone since RF **Alex Ramírez** blasted two long balls on July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...Osborn is the first 'Clone to record 2+ home runs, 3+ hits, and 4+ RBI in a single game since DH **Brett Baty** (3/4, 2 HR, 4 RBI) accomplished the feat on June 3, 2021, at Jersey Shore...3 of Osborn's last 4 hits have been home runs and 4 of his last 6 have left the ballpark, as well...He holds a 108 wRC+ and .342 ISO since being reinstated from the injured list on June 2...Osborn is tied for the team lead in home runs with 6...This is despite having 39 fewer plate appearances than INF **Mateo Gil** (6 HR/134 PA), 52 fewer than OF **Stanley Consuegra** (5 HR/147 PA), 155 fewer than OF **Alex Ramírez** (5 HR/250 PA) and C **Kevin Parada** (5 HR/250 PA).

**BLADE RUNNER:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old registered a career-high 7.0 innings of shutout ball, earning the win on Saturday night at Aberdeen...Tidwell is the first Cyclone to post 7+ innings in

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** Brooklyn returns home to open up a 12-game homestand, starting with 6 contests against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades posses 3 of new York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Spencer Jones** (7), RHP **Drew Thorpe** (8), and C **Antonio Gómez** (29)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21...The Cyclones went 4-2 in the set, taking 4-straight games from May 17 until Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The Cyclones are 130-138 (.485) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

a shutout victory since RHP **Jeffrey Colón** did the same in a 3-0 win at Winston-Salem on September 9, 2022...He tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts in his previous start on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 6 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 3-0 with a 1.32 ERA (4 ER in 27.1 IP) with just 13 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 22 and struck out 39 (12.84 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 34.2% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .141 batting average (13-92) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.141) and is tied for 4th in ERA (1.32) since that date (min. 25.0 IP)...He is also tied for 5th in strikeouts (39).

**DINKY DONUTS:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7.0 IP) and RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (2.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 5-0 win at Aberdeen on Saturday night...That marked the Cyclones' 1st donut of an opponent since an 8-0 victory at Jersey Shore on May 30...Tidwell (3.2 IP) also started that night...RHP **Jace Beck** (2.1), RHP **Brendan Hardy** (1.2), RHP **Michael Krauz** (0.1), and RHP **Joshua Cornielli** (1.0) also united on a 5-hit blanking of the BlueClaws...The 'Clones have accumulated 5 shutouts through the first 62 games of 2023...Brooklyn pitching tallied 7 shutouts throughout the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

**DOWN TO THE WIRE:** DH **Kevin Parada** delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C **José Mena**'s added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B **Chase Estep** delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramírez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 5 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after last Friday's loss at Aberdeen...21.8% (14-of-64) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 24.3% (9-of-37) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...39.1% (25-of-64) have been determined by just 1 run, including 7 of the team's last 10 affairs.

**POWER OF PAUL:** RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and added another 4.0 more scoreless frames out of the bullpen at Aberdeen on Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase has the league's lowest ERA (1.26)...Gervase averages 13.81 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.1% strikeout rate.

**WILKIN'S WAY:** RHP **Wilkin Ramos** has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023...Over his last 3 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 7.1 innings, allowing only 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 8...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.64 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 29.1% strikeout rate with a 11.2% walk rate.

**CROWN PRINCE OF CONEY ISLAND:** IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Thursday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (197), at-bats (646), plate appearances (773), runs scored (99), walks (106), and stolen bases (47)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (67) on May 23 and is 2 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (197), 4th in home runs (16), and tied for 4th in hits (116).

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (15), RHP **Christian Scott** (16), and RHP **Tyler Stuart** (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (19), RHP **José Butto** (23), RHP **Luis Montas** (24), OF **Rowdey Jordan** (25), and RHP **Matt Allan** (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** After dropping June 3rd's twinbill vs. Greenville, Brooklyn dropped to 1-9 in doubleheader games in 2023...4-of-5 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...This year, the 'Clones are 26-28 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games.

**NEW ROLE:** Despite primarily serving as a relief pitcher in college, Stuart is expected to make his 12th professional start on Friday...In those outings, he is 1-0 with a 1.58 ERA (9 ER in 51.1 IP), adding 66 strikeouts (11.57 SO/9)...The Kankakee, Ill. native made only 4 starts throughout his collegiate tenure, all coming in his final season during 2022.
