ACE UP OUR SLEEVE: Sacramento won yesterday's game, 9-5, after initially trailing 2-5...Spencer Bivens made his second start of the season but did not factor into the decision...allowed four runs (3 earned) on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 2.0 innings of work and a season-high 45 pitches...Tristan Beck earned the win, his first of the season, throwing 1.2 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and fanning two batters...Buddy Kennedy went 2-for-5, his 10th multi-hit game...knocked his second home run of the season in the sixth, a 388-foot, two-run shot to left field...Turner Hill went 3-for-3, his sixth multi-hit game of the season and second three-hit game...is the fifth River Cat to have multiple three-plus-hit games this year...he is batting .354 (17-for-48) with three doubles, nine RBI, three walks, three stolen bases and an .809 OPS in 14 games with the River Cats.

DARTH BADER: Outfielder Harrison Bader joined the River Cats on a rehab assignment on Tuesday after being placed on the 10-day IL on April 12 due to a left hamstring strain...in two games in Sacramento he has gone 1-for-6 with one walk and two strikeouts...was hit by a pitch on the left arm/wrist in the sixth inning yesterday, his first time being plunked since September 10 with Philadelphia.

DANNY DIMES: Catcher Daniel Susac also joins Sacramento on a rehab assignment today...Susac was placed on the 10-day IL on April 21 (retroactive to April 20) due to right elbow ulnar neuritis...in 11 games with the Giants this season, Susac was batting a team-leading .478 (11-for-23) with two doubles, one triple, five RBI, one walk and a 1.152 OPS.

ACED OUT: The River Cats dropped last night's game, 0-4, marking their second shutout defeat this season (also, April 22 vs. ABQ, 0-6)...the Cats have been shut out by the Aces 11 other times in their history, most recently on August 30, 2025 where they lost 0-5...the last time Sac was shut out by Reno at home was August 2, 2024 (0-3)...the Cats are now 4-11 in games where they do not homer...Carson Seymour was the starter and was dealt his second loss of the season...allowed four runs on five hits, with a season-high four walks and a season-high six strikeouts in 5.2 innings of work and on a season-high 91 pitches...Nate Furman and Victor Bericoto each had multi-hit nights, Furman's sixth and Bericoto's 11th.

DOUBLE DOUBLES: The River Cats recorded their first and only multi-double play game on April 23...they were the last team at the Triple-A level to do so...through May 7 last year, they had already had nine multi-double play games, including one game with four DPs...every other Triple-A team has at least two multi-double play games...as of today, their total double plays sit at 22.

- They are ranked 9th in the PCL and T-23rd in Triple-A in DPs...in 2025, Sac ranked third in Triple-A in DPs with 145, behind Reno (151) and Albuquerque (149).
- Bryce Eldridge ranks first on the team with 17 double plays, followed by Osleivis Basabe (11), Nate Furman (10) and Thomas Gavello (7).

SPRING INTO ACTION: The River Cats batted .282 over 24 games in the month of April...they hit 42 doubles, three triples, 24 home runs, 136 RBI, drew 96 walks, and struck out 175 times...they had a .367 on-base percentage and a .434 slugging percentage, totaling an .801 OPS...last season, the Cats batted .241 in the month of April with a .338 OBP and .363 SLG for a total .701 OPS...below are players who batted particularly well last month:

DEAR JOHN: Southpaw John Michael Bertrand will take the mound tonight for the River Cats...last pitched on May 2 at Salt Lake where he earned his second win in back-to-back games, something he also did in his two games with Sacramento last season...allowed three runs on four hits, with three walks and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings...through six games (5 starts) this season, Bertrand has posted a 4.73 ERA (26.2 IP, 14 ER) with 14 walks, 17 strikeouts and a .312 opponent batting average...spent a majority of the 2025 season with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels...in 25 starts with the Squirrels he posted a 2.87 ERA (131.2 IP, 42 ER) with 15 walks, 91 strikeouts and a .249 opponent batting average...was promoted to the River Cats on September 19...played two games with the Cats (1 start) where he had a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER), one walk, 10 strikeouts and a .273 opponent batting average...Bertrand pitched three innings of relief in the River Cats' season-opener on March 27 where he allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR), one walk, and two strikeouts.

BOYS IN THE BIGS: After being called up Monday afternoon, Jesús Rodríguez had his first major league hit on Tuesday, an RBI single in the second to score Willy Adames...following that, he knocked his first home run, a 339-foot, solo-shot to right field in the seventh...Bryce Eldridge, also called up on Monday, also recorded his first hit of the season, a single in the sixth...four Cats batters are currently playing on the major league roster, here is a look at their stats so far this season:

LAST GAME: Last pitched on May 2 at Salt Lake where he earned his second win of the season, and second consecutive, in Sacramento's 7-4 victory...Bertrand also recorded back-to-back wins in his two starts for the River Cats last season...Bertrand allowed three runs on four hits, with three walks and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...racked up five whiffs for a rate of 13.8 percent...averaged a 84.6 pitch velocity and topped out at 92.5 with his sinker.

AGAINST THE ACES: Bertrand has never faced the Aces...they become his eighth new PCL team faced in his Triple-A career...the only PCL team (aside from the River Cats) he has yet to face is Sugar Land, who the Cats will face in their next homestand from May 19-24.

NIGHT KNIGHT: Is 24-19 in 77 night game appearances (65 starts)...has posted a 3.32 ERA (371.0 IP, 137 ER) with 27 home runs, 121 walks and 284 strikeouts, compared to 5-5 in 18 day games (15 starts) with a 4.63 ERA (81.2 IP, 42 ER), 25 walks and 59 strikeouts.
