JACKSONVILLE TRIUMPHS 6-3 OVER CHARLOTTE

Xavier Edwards homered and Chi Chi González worked 7.1 strong innings on Wednesday to lead the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to a 6-3 victory over the Charlotte Knights. With the game scoreless, C.J. Hinojosa led off the third with a single. After a pair of flyouts, Charlotte (36-46, 1-6) starter Sammy Peralta (3-3) ceded a two-run homer to Edwards to make it 2-0 in favor of Jacksonville (37-45, 5-3). Edwards finished a triple shy of the cycle, going 3-for-4 with three RBIs, two runs scored and a walk.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 38 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 39-for-131 (.298/.374/.710/1.084) at the plate with nine doubles, 15 home runs, 35 RBIs and 26 runs scored. With three home runs at home back on Saturday, he became the first Jacksonville player since 2010 to homer three times at home and the first Jumbo Shrimp player since 2021 to blast three home runs in a single game. Among the 149 qualified hitters last week, Allen ranked 12th in batting average (.429), first in home runs (5), first in RBIs (15) and first in OPS (2.100).

YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 37-45 record is tied for 16th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-three of the club's 82 games, or 64.6 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is tied for the most in the league with Gwinnett (53). Charlotte hasn't had a picnic in 2023 either. The Knights are 17-24 vs. teams with a record above .500 and 19-22 vs. teams below .500. Jacksonville and Charlotte split their last series.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Despite a 14-6 win over Charlotte Tuesday night, eight of Jacksonville's last 11 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 82 games played thus far in 2023, 46 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 22-24 (.478) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer.

APRIL SHOWERS HAVEN'T BROUGHT FLOWERS

Jacksonville finds themselves near the cellar of the International League. After finishing the first month of the season with a 13-12 record, the Jumbo Shrimp haven't found a spark, going 22-31 since May 1. The club posted the sixth-best ERA through the first month of the season at 4.47 in 227.1 innings. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 306 earned runs in 484.0 innings for a 5.69 ERA that ranks tied for 14th in the IL. Offensively, the club is hitting just .252/.337/.413/.750, figures that all rank T-18th, 20th, 18th and T-19th in the circuit, respectively. Relatedly, the club's 260 runs scored places 19th.

SUN RISES IN THE WEST AND SETS IN THE EAST

Since returning to the International League in 2021, Jacksonville has only had one successful season against inter-division opponents, going 74-55 against the "Triple-A East, Southeast Division." After the realignment to two divisions last year, the Jumbo Shrimp have gone 56-71 (.441) against teams in the IL-East. On the flip side, they have seen plenty of success against teams from the International League West division, going 60-43 (.583). Jacksonville has played Charlotte in each of the last three seasons, going a combined 35-30 (.538). Despite losing 90+ games in 2022, the Knights clubbed 28 homers with a .773 OPS against Jumbo Shrimp pitching.

SERIES 7 CIRCUIT

After falling in the first two games of their series at Memphis on May 2-3, Jacksonville rallied to win the series, taking the final four games. After that, though, the Jumbo Shrimp lost four consecutive sets before finally splitting a pair of series with Nashville and Memphis. After splitting their series with Durham last week, Jacksonville has gone eight sets without a series win, their longest drought since June 11-August 11, 2015, when they went 12 consecutive series' without a win in what turned out to be a 57-81 (.413) campaign.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville needs two more wins this week to lock up their first series win since May 2-7 against Memphis... Last time against the Knights, the Jumbo Shrimp lost the final three games and split their series with Charlotte (April 11-16).

ABOUT RONALD

-Before coming to the United States, Bolaños played for Mayabeque of the Cuban National Series. He signed with the San Diego Padres as an International free agent on August 11, 2016.

-The Padres selected Bolaños' contract and promoted him to the major leagues for the first time on September 2, 2019. He made his major leagues debut on September 3rd vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks, allowing two runs over six innings pitched.

-On July 16, 2020, Bolaños and outfielder Franchy Cordero were traded to the Kansas City Royals in exchange for LHP Tim Hill.

-On April 16, 2023, Bolaños signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

-Entering the 2023 season, Bolaños has pitched in 18 major league games, including five starts with Kansas City and San Diego. In those games, he is 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA. Over 48.0 innings, he has yielded 49 hits and struck out 43 against 29 walks.

-When he was signed by San Diego, the then-19-year-old was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 20 international prospect in the 2016 class and ranked by Baseball America as the fourth-best Cuban pitcher available.

-In 2014, he played in the COPABE 18U Pan American Championship in Mexico.

-The Cuban native came up as an outfielder before converting to a pitcher.

2023 SEASON

2022 SEASON

-With Triple-A Omaha, went 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA in four starts. Over 15.1 innings, yielding 17 hits and struck out 16 against four walks. However, over 24 relief appearances with the Storm Chasers, he posted an 0-3 record with a 7.63 ERA. In those relief appearances, he allowed 42 hits in 26.2 innings and struck out 18 against 14 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Bolaños began the year with Triple-A Omaha and made four starts before joining the Royals on June 4th. He closed the season with the Storm Chasers.

2020 SEASON

-Made a pair of starts, July 26 at Cleveland and Aug. 1 vs. the White Sox... Took the loss in his first start, allowing two unearned runs on three hits and a walk over 2.0 innings.
