CARDS COME FROM BEHIND TO TRIP TRAVELERS: The Cardinals scored three times in the top of the 7th inning and got another lights-out performance from their bullpen as Springfield won their second game in a row to start the 2024 campaign, 6-5 over the Arkansas Travelers on Saturday night. Bryan Torres, Jimmy Crooks and Jeremy Rivas each had two hits, while Nathan Church drove in a pair. The relief duo of Ryan Shreve and Matt Svanson combined to retire the final five hitters of the game in order to nail down the victory



DPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Danny Wirchansky** makes the start for Arkansas in the series finale...Making his debut in the Mariners system and in affiliated professional baseball...Signed with Seattle on February 23, 2024 as a minor league free agent...Made 21 appearances (20 starts) for the Charleston Dirty Birds of the Atlantic League and went 6-5 with a 3.28 ERA, allowing 102 hits with 105 K over 120.2 IP...Also pitched for Mayaguez in the Puerto Rican Winter League going 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA in 21 relief appearances...Spent the 2021 & 22 seasons with the New York Boulders of the independent Frontier League...Originally drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 25th round of the 2019 draft out of Div II Pace University...Released before ever throwing a pitch in the Brewers organization...Went 6-2 with a 1.38 ERA in 2019 at Pace and was named an NSCA All-American...Set single-season program record with 102 strikeouts...26 years old

CARDS OPEN SEASON ON ROAD AGAINST NORTH DIVISION RIVAL: The Cardinals kick off the 2024 season with a three-game series at Dickey-Stephens Park against the Arkansas Travelers (Seattle Mariners). Springfield went 11-13 against the Travelers last season, including a 4-8 mark in Little Rock. The Cards lost four of six twice: April 11-16 and June 28-July 3.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

TOP-RANKED BIRDS: The Springfield Opening Day roster offers no shortage of talent, especially on the mound. The Cardinals boast seven of St. Louis' Top 30 Prospects (per *MLB Pipeline*), six of whom are pitchers.

Opening Day starter **Tink Hence** is back in Springfield after making his final 12 starts of the 2023 season sporting the Springfield birids on the bat. The 63rd overall pick in the 2020 draft out of Watson Chapel HS in Arkansas, the right-hander is the top prospect in the Cardinals' organization. *MLB Pipeline* also ranks **Hence** as the 60th-best prospect in all of baseball.

The Springfield rotation also features the Cards' 2nd-ranked prospect (94th in MLB), right-hander **Tekoah Roby**. The right-hander shined in Springfield after being acquired by St. Louis from the Texas Rangers at the trade deadline in 2023 as part of the package for LHP Jordan Montgomery. **Roby** went 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA in 4 starts with Springfield after registering a 2-3 mark with a 5.05 ERA in 10 starts with Frisco before the trade. All together **Roby** struck out 69 batters with just 15 walks in 58.1 IP.

Right-hander **Max Rajcic** is making his Double-A debut in 2024 and checks in at 13th. The UCLA product split his pro debut season going 9-6 with a 2.48 ERA between Low-A Palm Beach and High-A Peoria. **Rajcic's** performance earned him an invite to MLB Spring Training and was annointed with the "Best Control" in the Cardinals organization entering the season by *Baseball America*.

Right-hander **Ian Bedell** checks in a No. 19 on *MLB Pipeline's* list and also makes his Double-A debut after spending all of 2023 with High-A Peoria. Went 4-2 with the Chiefs, and his 2.44 ERA led Cardinals minor league starters. It was an encouraging campaign for the Mizzou product, his first full season post-Tommy John surgery, a procedure he underwent in May 2021.

Edwin Nuñez opens the season in Springfield's rotation as the Cardinals' 23rd-ranked prospect. When the right-hander takes the ball in the series finale in Arkansas on Sunday, it will be his first appearance above A-ball. **Nuñez** split the 2023 season between Palm Beach and Peoria going a combined 6-4 with a 3.39 ERA in 41 relief appearances.

Springfield's closer in 2023, right-hander **Andre Granillo** (No. 27) returns for his second straight Opening Day in the Texas League. **Granillo** led the circuit with 14 saves in 2023, striking out 72 batters in 55 IP. The right-hander has the "Best Slider" in the Cardinals system according to *Baseball America*. For his work in 2023, the UC Riverside product earned his first MLB Spring Training invite

The only Springfield position player to be named to the list is C **Jimmy Crooks**, who comes in at 11th. **Crooks** spent all of last season at High-A Peoria where he batted .271 with 12 HR and 73 RBI while finishing 4th in the Midwest League with 29 2B. The former Oklahoma Sooner backstop was the first position player selected by the Cardinals in the 2022 draft (4th round).

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards: **Bryan Torres** (Richmond, 2021) and **Matt Lloyd** (Chattanooga, 2021-22) have Double-A experience.

Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the Springfield franchise recod in 2023 with 31 longballs.

NO-NO BID: The Cardinals took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on Friday night, the longest Springfield has gone without allowing a hit in nearly two years. The last time the Cardinals took a no-hitter into the 7th inning came on April April 16, 2022 also at Arkansas. **Diego Robles** allowed his first hit leading off the seventh inning, just as the Cardinals did on Friday night

The Cardinals have never thrown a no-hitter in franchise history.

CARDS LOOKING FOR BEST START IN FRANCHISE HISTORY:

The Cardinals' 2-0 start to the 2024 season is only the third time in franchise history (since 2005) the Redbirds have won their first two games, with the other two insances coming in 2016 and 2017. The Cards have never started a season 3-0 and have also never swept their opening series.


