sox fell 5-2 to the Harrisburg Senators on Thursday night. Bowie notched both ies on solo home runs, as Jud Fabian went deep in the top of the second to tie the one and Silas Ardoin had an opposite-field solo homer in the sixth. Harrisburg took ge of three Bowie errors on the night. The Senators scored an unearned run in the fore plating three in the third and notching a late solo homer from Brady House.

BASALLO BITS

With a pinch-hit strikeout last night, C/1B Samuel Basallo's team-high 19-game on-base streak came to a close. During that stretch, he hit .356 (5th EL) with a 1.050 OPS. Basallo's five home runs during that stretch were fifth-most in the league. The 19-year-old is the youngest player in the Eastern League this season. He currently has the fourth-most hits (62) and fifth-most home runs (10) of all qualified players. Basallo's on-base streak is the fourth-longest in the league this season.

TEENAGE DREAM

With his two-run shot Friday night, **Samuel Basallo** became just the ninth teenager to reach 10 home runs in a season at the Double-A level since the year 2005. Basallo is the first teen in the Eastern League to reach the mark since Vladimir Guerrero Jr did so with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in 2018. Basallo's 55 games to reach 10 Double-A home runs makes him the third-fastest teenager to do so since 2005. Only Guerrero (44 GP in 2018) and Giancarlo Stanton (41 GP in 2009) reached 10 HR in fewer games.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B Dylan Beavers has reached base in 44 of 50 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.367) and leads the team in walks (31), the sixth-most in the Eastern League. Tuesday was the ninth time Beavers reached base at least three times in a game this season.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

Bowie's Jud Fabian hit his 11th home run of the season on Thursday night, tying him for the third-most long balls in the Eastern League this season. Fabian hit a leaguehigh six homers in the month of May and has three thus far in June. He's hitting .247 through 51 games this season after hitting just .176 in 64 Double-A games last season. His batting average on balls in play has jumped 70 points in that span.

TRAFFIC JAM

The Baysox have struggled to come up with the big hit so far during their week in Harrisburg. Bowie is hitting .236 this season with runners in scoring position - seventh in the Eastern League, but is just 2-for-19 (.105) this week, with 27 runners left on base. Three of Bowie's four runs this week have been via a solo home run.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (285.1) and strikeouts (326). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.18 WHIP, which is good for fourth-lowest in Double-A.

SCOUTING THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators sit at 32-25 on the season - tied for second in the Eastern League Southwest division and just a game out of first place. Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators are led by second-year manager and former Baysox player (1999) Delino DeShields. Harrisburg's roster includes four of the Nationals' top 8 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF Dylan Crews (WSH No. 2/MLB. No. 6), IF Brady House (WSH No. 3/MLB No. 36), IF Yohandy Morales (WSH No. 4/MLB No. 88), and OF Robert Hassell III (WSH No. 8).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Josiah Gray is set to get the ball tonight for Harrisburg in a Major League Rehab start. Gray was placed on the Nationals' injured list on April 9 with a right elbow/forearm flexor strain. He started just two games with the Nationals (8 IP) prior to landing on the IL in his fourth season with Washington, after coming over from the Dodgers in the Max Scherzer/Trea Turner trade in July 2021. He pitched for Single-A Fredericksburg this past Sunday, allowing three runs on three hits accross three innings.

Arsenal: 4-Seam FB (91-95), Changeup (82-85), Curveball (81-85), Slider (82-86) Acquired from LAA in Dylan Bundy deal, which included BAL RHP Kyle Bradish and BOW RHP Zach Peek Returns for his third stint with Baysox. First full healthy season since 2021.

2024: Coming off shortest start of Double-A career where he recorded just one out and gave up five runs on three hits (including two homers) and three walks on Sat. 6/8 vs BNG. Had previously thrown first 6.0 inning start by a Baysox pitcher this season with 6.0 shutout, no-hit innings and 6 K on Sun. 6/2 @ SOM. Began season in rotation for three starts before being bumped into long relief role for five straight outings. Holds a 3.33 ERA as a starter in six starts this season. Owns a 2.82 ERA on the road in five road outings. Baysox are 5-1 when he starts. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made four rehab appearances between FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen before being sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) with Baysox and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

2022: Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

2021: Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 K over 60.2 IP and an ERA of 3.86.

2019: Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

Personal: Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticus He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assist ant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2023 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1.363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
