LAST TIME OUT

Charlotte, NC (May 16, 2023) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders hammered the Charlotte Knights 14-5 Tuesday evening at Truist Field. Estevan Florial and Rodolfo Duran each homered twice as the RailRiders launched six home runs in the series opener.

The RailRiders plated a run in the top of the first on a pair of singles and a groundout and added to the lead with back-to-back home runs in the second. Jamie Westbrook drove a 1-1 pitch from Nate Fisher 383 feet to the right field stands for a 2-0 lead. Jesus Bastidas followed with a 424-foot blast to left to extend the lead.

Former RailRider and Yankee Clint Frazier singled in a run in the home half of the second off Scranton/Wilkes-Barre starter Sean Boyle, but the right-handed received a stellar double play turn from Oswald Peraza and Bastidas to close the inning.

Peraza doubled in Florial in the top of the fourth to push the lead to three runs and the RailRiders added two more on a single by Westbrook with two outs in the fifth for a 6-1 advantage. After Westbrook's single plated Andres Chaparro and Rodolfo Duran, umpires called for the tarp as sheets of rain waivered across Charlotte.

After a 50-minute delay, Bastidas singled on the first pitch as play resumed and Florial hit a 2-0 offering from reliever JB Olson to the seats in left-center to extend the lead to 9-1. Duran hit his fifth home run of the season in the top of the sixth for a 12-1 edge.

Victor Reyes home run in the bottom of the sixth, a two-run shot, drew the Knights back within nine at 12-3.

Florial's second home run of the game came in the seventh off Alex Mateo; a 421-foot blast to center. After the Knights scored twice in the bottom half of the inning, Duran's eighth-inning solo shot off of big-league rehabber Liam Hendriks capped the RailRiders offense.

Despite the delay, Boyle (2-2) pitched into the bottom of the sixth, striking out six and walking one. Fisher (3-4) allowed the first seven runs, four of which were earned, on seven hits.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's six home runs are a new season-high and one off the franchise record set in 1998.

NEWS & NOTES

WHO'S ON FIRST - The RailRiders have had six different first basemen this season. Billy McKinney leads the way with fourteen starts, while Andres Chaparro has made eleven starts there. Mickey Gasper and Jake Bauers have also played their hands at first base this season. Last night, Rodolfo Duran played his first ever professional contest in the corner infield position. Every defensive player at first, except Gasper, has made at least one error in the position. Carlos Narvaez, in just his third Triple-A contest, got his initial start at first.

ALL OFFENSE ALL THE TIME - For the second time this season, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre plated five runs in a single inning. In the fifth inning, they plated five runs on four hits amidst a fifty minute rain delay.

FIELDING FAUX PAS - With one miscue last night, the RailRiders totalled 44 errors on the season as a team. This puts tied for first in the Triple-A in this category. Andres Chaparro has ten, eight at third base and two at first. The team has one game with five miscues committed. SWB has had 12 error-free games.

DOUBLE THE FUN - Last night, SWB recorded three double plays in one contest. It was the second time this season they did this. Oswald Peraza made an excellent behind the back throw to start the first one. Second baseman Jesus Bastidas and Andres Chaparro were involved in all three.

PERAZA REHAB - Oswald Peraza joined the RailRiders for a rehab assignment on Sunday to end the series against Omaha. Peraza was recalled by New York and played in 12 big league games. He recorded six hits before being placed on the 10-day Injured List with a right ankle sprain on May 9. Peraza is set to continue his rehab assignment as the team travels to Charlotte.

HOMER HEAVEN - Last night, the RailRiders hit a season-high six home runs in a game. Estevan Florial and Rodolfo Duran each had a pair. Jamie Westbrook and Jesus Bastidas went back-to-back in the second. The team is now tied for third for homers hit in all of Triple-A. Albuquerque leads with 69 hit this summer.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN - On May 4, Andres Chaparro turned 24 years old and the RailRiders will celebrate five more birthdays to come this May. Mitch Spence turns 26 on 5/6. Deivi Garcia turns 24 on 5/19. DJ Snelten turns 31 on 5/29, while Elijah Dunham turns 25 the same day. Matt Bowman turns 32 on 5/31.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#16 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#12) and Sean Boyle (#28) are both set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debut with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

LONGEST OUTING: Tossed the team's first quality start of the season on 4/23 @ St. Paul...6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 ER, 5 BB, 6 SO...Got two big double plays...Allowed a homer to the second batter of the game

IN THE FIRST: Vasquez typically settles in after the first inning...in the first inning this season, batters hit .310 against him with three home runs and eight runs batted in

SPRING START: For the second year in a row, Vasquez recieved the invite to Major League spring training and appeared in Grapefruit League contents. This spring he went 1-0 in three appearances with one start. He tossed 7.0 innings allowing four runs on 10 hits. He struck out seven and walked four.

PITCH CLOCK VIOLATION: On 4/1/23, Vasquez committed the first pitch clock violation of the season. He took too long to come set on the mound to deliver his pitch and an automatic ball was issued to his batter.

BRING ON THE CURVE: Following the season, was tabbed by Baseball America as the Yankees' No. 9 prospect and labeled as having the "Best Curveball" among Yankees farmhands... combining low-80s power with vertical and horizontal movement produced by spin rates that top 3,100 rpm

PLAYOFF RANDY: He capped his 2022 season with eight no-hit innings in the deciding game of the Double-A Eastern League playoffs before getting added to the 40-man roster in November.

INITIAL SIGNING: Vásquez has gone from signing for just \$10,000 out of the Dominican Republic at the relatively old age of 19 in May 2018 to becoming one of the Yankees' better pitching prospects.
