DRILLERS CRUSH RIDERS IN SERIES FINALE:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Tulsa Drillers 14-4 on Sunday evening from Riders Field. Tulsa (14-12, 48-47) opened the scoring in the top of the second against Frisco (16-11, 60-36) starter **Winston Santos** (1-2) when Damon Keith mashed a leadoff homer to give the Drillers a 1-0 lead. The Riders answered in the home half of the second inning with a homer from **Abimelec Ortiz**, his third long ball of the series. Frisco ran into trouble in the top of the third inning as the Drillers struck for six runs to retake the lead, 7-1. Brandon Lewis provided a solo homer and Jose Ramos added a pair of runs with a double to highlight the frame. Santos exited after 2.2 innings, allowing six runs on six hits and a walk while striking out two. Tulsa added two more in the top of the fourth against **Nick Krauth**, using an RBI single from Lewis to push the lead to 9-1. Krauth worked 3.1 innings, surrendering three runs on seven hits and no walks while fanning five. In the bottom of the fourth, **Josh Jung** cut into the deficit with a two-run double off the wall in left field that scored **Geisel Cepeda** and **Alejandro Osuna** to make it a 9-3 game. Frisco added another run in the sixth inning where Cody Freeman delivered a sacrifice fly to right, plating Cooper Johnson to cut the deficit to 9-4. In the eighth and ninth innings, Tulsa used five unanswered runs to take a 14-4 lead. The 10 run loss is tied for the largest loss of the season for the Riders. Offensively, Ortiz paced the RoughRiders with a 3-for-5 night as he fell a triple shy of the cycle. Aaron Zavala also collected a pair of hits. Jung posted a 2-for-3 evening with a double, finishing the weekend going 4-for-10 with two hit-by-pitches.

LOOK AT ALL THOSE MOVES:

The RoughRiders had a flurry of moves over the last three days, starting on Sunday when both catcher Liam Hicks and reliever Tyler Owens were traded to the Tigers in exchange for catcher Carson Kelly. On Monday, both Josh Jung and Cody Bradford finished their rehab assingments with the Riders and then on Tuesday, starter Mitch Bratt and outfielder Luis Mieses were added to the Riders roster while infielder Frainyer Chavez was sent to Triple-A Round Rock and outfielder Geisel Cepeda was released.

Riders slugger **Abimelec Ortiz** has been crushing the baseball recently. While he is hitting well over his last 12 games, batting .391 (18-for-46).451.674/1.125 with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs and eight runs scored, the success goes back even further. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting just. 176,241/.309/.550, but has hammered the ball in 23 games since, batting .325(.411/.519/.930. He has raised his average 46 points (.217), his slugging percentage 58 points (.367) and his OPS 107 points (.657) in the last 23 games.

MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:
The RoughRiders face their division opponents for the third time this season, but the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2023, Frisco went 13-11 against San Antonio and have gone 52-26 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021, including 29-8 at the Wolff. In the 12 games, in which they are 11-1, they have a 2.84 team ERA, outscoring the Missions 58-33. **Josh Hatcher** has driven in 11 runs over his 10 games against the Missions, hitting .324 with an .825 OPS.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Maximo Acosta has been swinging a hot bat for the RoughRiders in July, hitting .281 (18-for-64)/.338/.406/.744 with three doubles, a triple, a home run, eight RBIs, 10 runs scored and seven stolen bases. As one of six qualified players in the Texas League age 21 or younger, Acosta is hitting .341 (14-for-41)/.404/.512/.916 over his last 11 games. He has also excelled with runners in scoring position, placing third in the Texas League with a .333 average with RISP and first with a .462 average with RISP and two outs.

HOME COOKING:

HOME COOKING:
The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .700 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 25-21 with a 3.41 ERA, but a +17 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .633 OPS. Cody Freeman is slashing .339/394/.992 at home this season with nine of his 12 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 21 games, he is hitting .308 (24-for-78)/.415/.564/.979 with seven doubles, two triples, three home runs and 14 RBIs. Over his last 18 games, he is batting .323 (21-for-65)/.444/.600/1.044 with five doubles, two triples, three home runs and 14 RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with three doubles and a 1.005 OPS for the Riders.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.07 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.58), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .230 BAA is on pace to be the second-best in the franchise's history.

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out thee side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging $10.0 \, \text{strikeouts}$ per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.
