NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster for Omaha, with the Storm Chasers experiencing significant ups and downs in the last month.

Of 23 series this year, Omaha has won 8, lost 11 and split 4 ... the Storm Chasers have lost 3 consecutive series, after a stretch of going unbeaten in 4 straight.

After going a Minor League-best 17-5 (.739 win %) from July 10 to August 8, the Storm Chasers have gone 4-13 (.235) over their last 17 games since August 9 ... the offense has cooled right along with the record, dropping from 6.26 runs per game during the surge to 4.00 since, with starters' run support falling from 4.13 per outing to 2.06 – including 0 runs of support in 7 of the last 17 starts.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Chasers have 34 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 38 losses this year.

34 comeback wins are the 6th-most in the International League, 9th-most in Triple-A ... 38 blown leads rank as the 2nd-most in the International League and tied 3rd-most in Triple-A.

Over the last 94 games (since May 9), Omaha is 43-51 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 28 of their 43 wins in that stretch, and led at some point in 28 of their 51 losses – meaning 56 of Omaha's last 94 games (60%) have featured a comeback from the eventual winner ... it's also been a tight stretch overall: 56 of those 94 games (60%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer.

CROSS ME UP

Gavin Cross had one of the league's slowest starts to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.

Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 68 games (since May 16), he's hitting .310 (79-for-255), with 33 extra-base hits and 44 RBI, as well as 24 multi-hit games, including 15 of his last 29 games ... since May 16, Cross is 4th in the International League in slugging percentage (.573), 5th in OPS (.932) and 8th in average (.310) and total bases (141).

July 2 to 28, Cross worked a career-best 19-game hitting streak, Omaha's longest since 2018 ... he also homered in a club record 6 straight games, July 22 to 28.

Cross has recorded hits in 13 of his 17 games against St. Paul this year, with 7 extra-base hits and 9 RBI against the Saints.

THE SUMMER OF SQUIRES

Brett Squires has swung the bat especially well over the last 2 months.

In his last 52 games (since June 27), Brett Squires is slashing .271/.346/.548 (54-for-199) with 37 RBI ... in this stretch, he ranks tied 2nd in the IL in extra-base hits (27), 4th in total bases (109), tied 5th in home runs (13) and tied 8th in RBI (37).

Since his Triple-A debut (May 12), Squires ranks tied 2nd in the International League in extra-base hits (44), 3rd in total bases (175), 4th in home runs (22), 5th in RBI (61), 5th in SLG (.554), tied 7th in doubles (19) and 10th in hits (84).

Despite spending the first 6 weeks of the season in Double-A, Squires is tied 6th in the IL this season in home runs (22) and 3rd among IL qualifiers in 2026 in SLG (.554).

Squires' average home run distance with Omaha this year is 404 feet, tied for the 4th-longest among 51 International League hitters with 15+ homers.

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May.

Toro hit just .189 (21-for-111) from March 27 to May 10, but since May 12, he has a .310 average (90-for-290) ... since May 12, he ranks 5th among qualifiers in the International League in OPS (.926), 6th in AVG and 8th in SLG (.545).

Overall in 2026, Toro ranks tied 4th in the International League in triples (5), 7th in total bases (200) and 8th in extra-base hits (46) ... he leads Omaha in RBI (69) and is 2nd in home runs (19), but hasn't homered in his last 21 games (since August 2) and hasn't driven in a run over his last 11 games (since August 30).

END OF AUGUST

While the Storm Chasers had a losing record (9-15) in August, there were still several players that experienced success last month.

In 19 August games, infielder Peyton Wilson hit .324 (22-for-68) with 6 doubles, 3 homers and 11 RBI ... he reached base in 16 of the 19 games where he took a plate appearance, reaching 3 times in each of the 4 games he played last week in Iowa.

In 15 August games, infielder Alejo Lopez hit .340 (17-for-50) with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 4 RBI ... he drew 7 walks to just 6 strikeouts, reaching base in 14 of 15 games ... Lopez did not strike out in his first 9 games with Omaha, a 25-plate appearance stretch from July 23 to August 2.

- ✓ Gonsolin will be making his 1st career appearance against St. Paul and the Twins and their affiliates ... the Saints will be the 15th Triple-A team and 51st overall team he has faced in his career.

TALK ABOUT TONY

- ✓ **RETURN TO FORM:** Gonsolin is making his second start of the season after undergoing right elbow surgery that has kept him sidelined since June 2025 ... he made 11 appearances between the Triple-A and Major League levels last April to June and started for the first time in over a year last Wednesday in Iowa.
- ✓ **CHAMPIONSHIP RESUME:** The right-hander has been a part of several championship teams in his career, including a pair of World Champion Dodgers teams (2020 & 2025) ... he also pitched for the 2016 Midwest League Champion Great Lakes Loons (A), as well as the 2018 California League Champion Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (A+) and 2018 Texas League Champion Tulsa Drillers (AA) ... he also made a rehab start for the 2023 Pacific Coast League Champion Oklahoma City Dodgers (AAA).

LAST OUTING: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 26 @ IOWA

- ✓ Made his first start back from injury after being kept out for over a year ... opened the game with a 1-2-3 bottom of the 1st inning, striking out **Matt Shaw** ... returned with a scoreless bottom of the 2nd inning, navigating a one-out walk for a clean frame ... retired all 3 batters he faced in the bottom of the 3rd inning and did not return for the 4th inning, with Ethan Bosackier taking his place.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on November 6, 2025 and subsequently elected free agency ... spent the first part of 2026 rehabbing from right elbow surgery before signing a Major League contract with the Royals on August 13, and was placed on Kansas City's 15-day Injured List that same day.

CAREER NOTES

2025

- ✓ Injuries limited him to just 11 games between the Triple-A and Major League levels, sidelining him with Los Angeles to begin and end the season.
