### Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound today, needing a win to salvage a series split (won final game to split series in each of last three weeks). Iowa will counter with LHP **Ty Blach**. Columbus is 3-11 (.214) versus left handers this year. Blach has pitched against the Clippers twice in his career (both this season), going 1-1 with a 9.82ERA (7.1IP, 14H, 8R, 8ER, 5BB, 5K).

### vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 18-19 opposing the I-Cubs (33-26 in the last 59G). Individually, **Juan Brito** has 7HR and 25RBI in 30G against Iowa in his career, while **Nolan Jones** has hit 9HR with 34RBI in 36G (.303, 40x132) and **Milan Tolentino** has 9HR and 22RBI in 26G (.319, 29x91). **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .317 (26x82) with 4HR and 10RBI in 22G.

### Something in the Water

**Juan Brito's** grand slam on Friday was the 29th for Columbus since the start of 2022 and the 10th against Iowa (seven on the banks of the Raccoon River). Overall, the Clippers have 56HR in 50G in Des Moines since the beginning of the 2022 season (308 runs scored, 6.2 per game). Brito has 2HR from the right side this series, as the Clippers have 7HR in their last 212AB vs. LHP (1HR in first 188AB).

### Not Cashing In

The Clippers have drawn 34BB this week (most in the IL) to overtake Worcester (18BB) on the season (223BB to 213BB), but they have hit just .227 (24x75) with runners in scoring position (10AB more than any other team this week). In contrast, Iowa has hit .382 (21x55) with RISP this series. Columbus has stranded 53 on the bases this week and 339 on the season, both are the top marks in the IL.

### At the Top

**Stuart Fairchild** will start things off for the Clippers, batting leadoff for the fourth time (leadoff HR Friday). Fairchild is hitting .250 (6x24) since the calendar flipped to May, but has crafted a .471OBP (9BB; .435OBP in April). Following him will be **Juan Brito**, making his 169th start batting second (80G more than any IL player since debut). Brito has a hit in each of 8G this month (.333, 11x33).

### Watch Out for Watson

**Kahlil Watson** is hitting .313/.460/.552 with 9XBH in his last 19G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of his last 10G (.449OBP since 4/23). Watson drew his 30th walk of the season yesterday, but also recorded his 39th strikeout (only player in the IL with at least 30 of each) and, with his 4HR, he owns a three true outcome rate of 50.3% (7th highest among 93 IL hitters with at least 120PA).

### Eye is for Ingle

**Cooper Ingle** has drawn 22BB in his first 72PA (31%) this season, following 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .282 (34x131) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .469OBP and a +15 differential in the walk to strikeout department (43 to 28). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 43BB are tied for 5th most (**Travis Bazzana** is 3rd, 47, and **Kahlil Watson** is 4th, 46).

### Hot Huff

**Kody Huff** rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 7G this month (.520, 13x25, five multi-hit). His XBH streak was snapped at 5G yesterday, but he still owns 11XBH in his last 19G (.606SLG since 4/16). Huff is sitting at 24 runs and 29RBI through 32G (one of 15 in the IL with 20+ of both; had 31 runs and a career high 47RBI in 101G last year).

### POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .135/.274/.192 with 0HR and 2RBI in 14G (RBI in each of last 2G). Of 32 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off LHP (106AB; 27HR in 408AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .346 (9x26) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

### Frias Figures It Out

**Dayan Frias** scored for the 10th time in his last 13G in Friday, going 1x4. Since 4/23, Frias is hitting .304 (12x39) in 13G (started the year 8x64, .125, through first 19G), reaching base in all 11G with a plate appearance (.413OBP). Unfortunately, he has only 2RBI on his hot streak (5/3 vs. Toledo, snapped 14G streak without; 5/8 at Iowa), as he is just 5x29 (.172) with runners in scoring position (0XBH).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

Sunday, May 10

## This Date in Clipper History

5/10/2017

Columbus and Durham combined to score 16 runs on 11 hits in a wild 11th inning at Durham Bulls Athletic Park, one year prior to the adoption of bogus extra inning rules.

**Giovanny Urshela** grounded out with men in scoring position while the game was still tied at three in the 11th, but capped a 10-run barrage with a grand slam later in the inning to provide what would ultimately be the decisive runs (13-9, final).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 48-53 (.475) in pitch reviews, with batters going 31-38 (.449) and pitchers/catchers going 17-15 (.531). They have run out of challenges in 21G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

## Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 11th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 20G this season (11-9, .550), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Juan Brito** moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 5/7 at lowa and that runner came around to score in a 2-run win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 85-23 (.787) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 2-2 mark this season (.500, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 405-425 (.488), 375-379 with Columbus (.497).

### Workhorse

Allen is the only Clipper averaging over 80 pitches a start this season, at 85.8 (along with **Trenton Denholm**, only pitchers to throw more than 90 in a game multiple times). Averaging almost 93 pitches per outing in the Majors last season, Allen hit triple digits six times (Columbus has not had a pitcher reach 100 since **Peyton Battenfield** on 9/2/22, 502G ago)

### Stellar Support:

Through 6GS, the bullpen has graced Allen with a 0.73ERA in relief (24.2IP, 2ER), stranding one of two runners inherited. The defense has committed only 5E in Allen's starts, while the offense has put forward 4.7 runs per game. That all adds up to a 5-1 record for Columbus when he takes the hill.

### 2026 Spring Training:

Allen pitched four times for Cleveland during spring training, going 0-2 with an 18.00ERA (10.0IP, 25H, 20R, 20ER, 8BB, 9K). He was optioned to Columbus on 3/22, but did not join the team until 3/31.

### Last Season:

Pitched the entire season with Cleveland... after season opening loss at San Diego on 4/1 (5.1IP, 7H, 4R, 4ER, 5BB, 1K), went 1-0 with a 0.56ERA (16.0IP, 1ER) in next 3GS (4/9-4/20), before loss vs. Boston on 4/27 (4.1IP, 9H, 7R, 7ER, 3BB, 2K)... won with a scoreless start on 5/13 vs. Milwaukee (6.0IP, 3H, 1BB, 6K) and earned a win in a relief outing on 5/31 vs. Los Angeles (1.0IP, 2K)... went 3-3 with a 3.34ERA (35.0IP, 13ER) in 6GS (4QS) prior to the All-Star Break (6/11-7/11)... lost a pair out of the Break before winning vs. Colorado on 7/29 (7.0IP, 8H, 2R, 2ER, 1BB, 3K)... struggled over 5GS from 8/12-9/4, turning in a 6.66ERA (25.2IP, 19ER)... won a scoreless start on 9/20 at Minnesota, following a nine-day layoff (8.0IP, 4H, 1BB, 7K)... did not pitch in the AL Playoffs.
