FLYING TIGERS FALTER LATE: After jumping out to a 6-3 lead, Lakeland relinquished its three-run advantage in the eighth in Saturday's 8-6 defeat to the Dunedin Blue Jays. Hunter Dobbins gave the Flying Tigers the lead on his second run-scoring extra-base hit in as many games, a two-run homer in the second. After allowing three unanswered runs, Javier Osorio tied the game on an RBI double and Jesus Pinto put Lakeland back in front with a three-run blast in the fourth. After Win Scott allowed just one hit over 3.1 innings in relief, the Blue Jays stormed back to take the lead with four runs in the eighth and added one more in the ninth.

LAKELAND'S LATE-INNING LAPSES: Lakeland's recent late-inning woes continue after surrendering leads in the seventh inning or later in three games this series. Entering last week, 11 of the Flying Tigers last 18 nine-inning games had been decided in the bottom of the eighth inning or later. All 11 of those contests were decided in the winning team's final at-bat. Lakeland went 4-7 in those games. This week they host a Dunedin side that has also had its recent fair-share of late-inning dramatics. Six of its last nine games have been determined in the seventh inning or later, with all six games decided in comeback fashion.

STEADY EDDY: Following a two-walk performance on Saturday, Edian Espinal remains the most consistent hitter in the Lakeland lineup, currently riding a team-high 16-game on-base streak. He owns the club's two longest on-base streaks this season, with each at 16 games. The catcher has performed even better with a larger sample size. He's hitting .404 with 22 RBIs over his last 26 starts. Espinal has also reached base in 33 of his last 34 starts while hitting .342 and drawing 25 walks over that span. Espinal's patience at the plate has been key to his success, walking 26 times to just 27 strikeouts on the season.

SERIES SUPREMACY: The Flying Tigers look to keep their home series dominance alive with a win on Sunday. Their series loss to Fort Myers earlier this month snapped the club's unbeaten run of 23 consecutive six-game sets at Joker Marchant without a series loss. The defeat marks the first of its kind since June 2023, with 14 wins and nine splits over that span.

2025: A SEASON TO REMEMBER: Lakeland looks to defend its 2025 Florida State League title as it returns home for the first time since last year's championship-clinching victory. The Flying Tigers steamrolled through both the regular season and postseason. They became the first team in the FSL's 106-year history to win the first and

second half titles while also going undefeated in the postseason. Additionally, they were just the third club in league history to win both the first and second halves. With its postseason appearance last year, Lakeland has reached the playoffs in three consecutive seasons for the first time in 32 years.

TIGERTOWN IS TITLETOWN: 2025 marked Lakeland's first league title in 13 years. It was the club's fifth championship all-time, previously taking the league crown in 1967, 1977, 1992 and 2012. Two unrelated Lakeland teams (the Lakeland Highlanders and Pilots) won titles in 1924 and 1954, respectively.

BATTLE WITH THE BIRDS: Lakeland faces the Dunedin Blue Jays this week for the first time in 2026. Led by first-year manager Ryan Casteel, Dunedin comes in with the worst record in the Florida State League West but is arguably the hottest team in the league, winning eight of its last nine games. The team has rode a streaky last three weeks, beginning with a four-game winning streak, followed by six losses in its next seven games, proceeded by seven consecutive wins. The club is headlined by Toronto's top prospect JoJo Parker, who is a top 30 overall prospect in the Minor Leagues. Toronto's No. 6 prospect Juan Sanchez leads the way at the plate, hitting .382 with 14 RBIs and a .632 slugging percentage over his last 17 games entering the series. No. 10 prospect Jake Cook is graded out as an 80-grade runner and smashed his first career home run, a grand slam in last week's series finale. No. 14 prospect Blaine Bullard rounds out the strong group at the plate, riding a 12-game on base streak entering the week.
