GAME INFORMATION

TUNG TERRIFIC: RHP **Jonah Tong**, the Mets' No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 57 prospect, is slated to make his 16th start of the season tonight. Through 15 starts, Tong is 6-4 with a 1.83 ERA and 125 strikeouts in 78.2 innings. Tong leads all of Minor League Baseball with 125 strikeouts, a 14.30 K/9, and a 40.8 K%. Tong ranks among full-season minor leaguers with a .141 BAA (1st), 0.93 WHIP (4th), and 1.83 ERA (5th). The 22-year-old has given up the fewest hits (38) and is tied for the 4th-fewest earned runs (16) allowed among full-season qualified minor league pitchers. Tong represented the New York Mets in the MLB All-Star Futures Game at Truist Park in Atlanta last Saturday and he tossed a perfect second inning with a strikeout. In his last start with Binghamton on July 4 against Hartford, Tong recorded 10 strikeouts over 5.2 innings and allowed just two runs on four hits. He has recorded 10+ strikeouts in five different starts this season. He was the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for June, becoming the first player in Binghamton franchise history to win an EL monthly award in consecutive months.

2025 MLB ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: RHP Jonah Tong and OF Carson Benge both represented the New York Mets in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game on Saturday at Truist Park in Atlanta. Tong took the mound for the second inning and recorded one strikeout in a perfect inning. Benge went 0-for-1 with a flyout and came off the bench to play left field. Tong, the Mets' No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 59 prospect, has spent the entire season with Binghamton and leads Minor League Baseball with 125 strikeouts in 78.2 innings, while holding 6-4 record and a 1.83 ERA in 15 starts. Benge, the Mets' No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 74 prospect, was promoted to Double-A on June 23.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Altoona Curve, 7-5, on Sunday, July 13, in the series finale at Mirabito Stadium. Binghamton won the series 4-2. The Ponies led 5-0 in the first inning on home runs from **D'Andre Smith** and **Nick Lorusso** and a double from **Kevin Parada**. Altoona scored seven unanswered runs, highlighted by Wyatt Hendrie's go-ahead grand slam.

THE JETT: SS/CF Jett Williams, the Mets' No. 1 prospect & MLB Pipeline's No. 43 overall prospect, is riding a three-game hit streak and went 10-for-26 (.385 AVG) with a 1.218 OPS, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 5 R, 4 2B, 6 XBH, and 3 three-hit games over six games against Altoona last series. Williams recorded the second multi-home run game of his professional career on Friday, with the first coming at Richmond on June 11 against RHP Manuel Mercedes. The 21-year-old ranks among Double-A: 24 2B (T-1st), 37 XBH (T-2nd), 5 3B (T-4th), .891 (T-4th), 52 (6th), .495 SLG (5th), .396 OBP (9th) and among the Eastern League: 2B (T-1st), 37 XBH (T-2nd), 3B (T-2nd), OPS (2nd), R (3rd), OBP (3rd), SLG (3rd), 49 BB (4th), .26 SB (4th), .288 AVG (5th), 81 H (6th).

KEVINI!!: C Kevin Parada went 8-for-16 (.500 AVG) with a 1.313 OPS, 2 RBI, 4 R, and 5 2B in four games against Altoona last series and has recorded five hits and four doubles over his last two games. Over his last 19 games, Parada is hitting .362 (25-for-69) with a .987 OPS, 2 HR, 12 RBI, 11 R, 11 2B, 13 XBH. Parada had his first three-hit game of the season on May 16 at Hartford and since then has produced a .326 AVG, .385 OBP, .581 SLG, .967 OPS, 7 HR, 25 RBI, 22 R, 12 2B, and 19 XBH. Since, May 16, Parada ranks among Double-A: SLG (2nd), OPS (3rd), AVG (6th) and among the Eastern League: OPS (2nd), SLG (2nd), AVG (4th). HR (T-6th). XBH (T-7th). OBP (8th).

MORABITO MAGIC: OF Nick Morabito, the Mets' No. 16 prospect, is riding a six-game hit streak (7 H, 2 RBI, 3 R, 4 BB, 2 SB). Morabito ranks among AA: 33 SB (2nd), 23 2B (T-3rd) and among the Eastern League: SB (2nd), 2B (T-3rd), 85 H (4th), .290 AVG (4th), 48 R (5th), 43 RBI (7th), .362 OBP (10th), 29 XBH (10th). This season, Morabito has set career highs in RBI, 2B, XBH, and tied a career high in HR.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford**, the Mets' No. 6 prospect, blasted 2 HR (3-run HR & grand slam) and recorded a career-high 7 RBIs on Tuesday. Clifford has hit 4 HR and driven in 12 runs over his last 10 games. Over his last 32 games, since June 6, Clifford has produced a .922 OPS, 9 HR, 24 RBI, 19 R, 6 2B, 16 XBH, 21 BB. Clifford ranks T-2nd with Kyler Fedko (Wichita, MIN) in Double-A with 17 HR, behind Brock Wilken (18 - Biloxi, MIL) and also ranks among AA with 54 RBI (T-4th), 50 BB (T-6th), 32 XBH (T-5th). The 21-year-old ranks among the EL: HR (1st), RBI (3rd), BB (3rd), XBH (T-4th), .814 OPS (8th), .465 SLG (9th). **WINNING:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies are 57-28 overall this season and are 29 games above .500. Binghamton has the best winning percentage (.671) in Double-A and holds the second-best winning percentage in Minor League Baseball, behind High-A Greensboro (.698) (PIT). Binghamton is on-pace for 91 wins this season, which would surpass the franchise record for wins in a single season (86 - 2013). Binghamton won the Northeast Division First-Half title and went 45-22 (.672) in the first half.

LAST START: Tong recorded 10 strikeouts over 5.2 innings and allowed two runs on four hits and two walks in the loss on Friday, July 4 against Hartford at Mirabito Stadium... Tong allowed two runs in the first inning and then retired 13 of the final 15 batters that he faced, including ending his outing on five-straight strikeouts...Tong struck out 10+ batters for the fifth time in 15 starts this season.

REID BRIGNAC

YEAR WITH BNG: 4th YEAR WITH NYM: 6th

HOMETOWN: St. Amant, La. -Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16). -In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.

-In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5 in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca). -Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.

-Mariano Duncan begins his fourth year as bench coach with the Rumble Ponies and seventh year in the Mets organization. He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2021 & in the same role with Kingsport in 2019. -Duncan has Major League coaching experience, after serving as the first base coach for the Los Angeles Dodgers for five seasons from 2006-2010. He has spent time on various minor league staffs affiliated with the Dodgers and Chicago Cubs, before joining the Mets organization in 2019.

-The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Dodgers, Cincinnati Reds, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Toronto Blue Jays. He is a two-time World Series champion ('90 Reds and '96 Yankees), one-time All-Star (with Philadelphia in 1994), and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008. He made his MLB debut for the Dodgers on April 9, 1985, at the age of 22. Duncan finished third for the 1985 N.L Rookie of the Year.
