**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Rumble Ponies, 10-9, in 10 innings. Richmond trailed, 7-5, entering the eighth. **Carter Williams** hit a solo homer and **Andy Thomas** added a sac fly to the score, 7-7. In the top of the ninth, **Brady Whalen** hit a solo homer to give the Flying Squirrels an 8-7 lead. With two outs in the bottom of the ninth, Luke Ritter scored the tying run on a balk by **Blake Rivera**. In the top of the 10th, **Marco Luciano** moved Richmond ahead, 9-8, with a sac fly. Binghamton tied the score in the bottom of the 10th with a triple by Joe Suozzi and won on a bases-loaded walk by Rowdey Jordan. Richmond scored the game's first run in the first inning on an RBI single by Whalen. Binghamton moved ahead with a two-run double by Brandon McIlwain in the bottom of the first and pulled out to a 6-1 lead through the third. Luciano started the rally with an RBI double in the fourth and Thomas closed the gap to 6-5 with a three-run homer in the sixth. Wyatt Young clubbed an RBI double in the sixth to extend the Ponies' lead to 7-5.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today is the 13th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-2 against the SeaWolves at The Diamond from April 18-23. Erie won five-of-six at UPMC Park from May 9-14. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head back to Erie for six games to close the regular season from September 12-17.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** dropped from a tie for first place in the Southwest Division down to fourth with Thursday's loss. Saturday's loss dropped them under .500 for the first time this season. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 16-of-their-last-23. Their 7-16 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. The Richmond pitching staff has a 3.94 ERA, which is fourth in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 153.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 222.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 2.88 ERA, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball.

**THE SEAWOLVES** are in first place in the Southwest Division, one game ahead of Altoona, and won four-of-five games last week over Somerset at home. The SeaWolves' offense leads the Eastern League in runs scored (254), hits (378), total bases (625), triples (11), RBIs (235) and OBP (.353). Erie's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), RHP Ty Madden (No. 4), INF Colt Keith (No. 5), C Dillon Dingler (No. 7), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 18), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 26) and INF Gage Workman (No. 27). Andrew Magno is rated by Baseball America as having the best curveball in Detroit's system. Dingler is rated as the best defensive catcher, Perez is rated as the best hitter for average and Workman is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Keith (No. 2), Flores (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Dingler (No. 14), Hurter (No. 21), Workman (No. 28) and Keider Montero (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his eighth start of the season and his fourth appearance against the SeaWolves. Last time out, Murphy allowed one run over 3.2 innings in a start at Binghamton last Wednesday. He first faced Erie in a start on April 18 at The Diamond and allowed three runs over four innings. He pitched out of the bullpen against the SeaWolves on April 23, allowing two runs in 3.2 innings. Murphy's most recent appearance against the SeaWolves was on May 12 at UPMC Park, when he allowed four runs, tying a season high, over 3.1 innings in a loss. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. *For more on Murphy, see page two.*

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Wilmer Flores makes his 10th start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Wednesday against Somerset and worked five scoreless innings. After starting the year 0-2 with a 8.27 ERA (15 ER/16.1 IP) in five starts, he has gone 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (5 ER/20.0 IP) in his last four starts since May 6. Flores faced the Flying Squirrels on April 18 at The Diamond and allowed a season-high seven runs over 2.2 innings in a loss. He started the series finale of that week on April 23 and threw four scoreless innings, his only scoreless outing in April. On May 12, he allowed one run in five innings in a win over the Flying Squirrels at UPMC Park. Flores signed out of Arizona Western with the Tigers in 2020 and made 19 starts for the SeaWolves in 2022, going 6-4 with a 3.01 ERA. He made two starts against the Flying Squirrels last year, striking out a season-high eight batters in both of them, on June 11 and September 12 at The Diamond. Flores is the younger brother of Giants infielder, Wilmer Flores.

**THOMAS TAKING OFF:** **Andy Thomas** is riding a six-game hitting streak since May 21, during which he is batting .320 (8-for-25) with two homers, two doubles, seven RBIs and six runs scored, raising his season batting average from .192 to .218. He started the stretch with a solo home run in the Flying Squirrels' comeback win over the RubberDucks on May 21. On Sunday at Binghamton, he drove a three-run homer to help the Flying Squirrels overcome a five-run deficit.

**THE NEW GUY:** Playing his second game with the Giants organization on Thursday at Binghamton, **Brady Whalen** picked up three hits, including a homer and a triple. With the Flying Squirrels trailing, 1-0, with two outs in the ninth, he hit a solo homer to tie the score. On Sunday, he clubbed a go-ahead homer in the ninth inning before Richmond fell in extras. Whalen signed with the Giants as a free agent in December and missed the start of this year with an injury. He was activated on the Richmond roster on Saturday and played his first games for the Flying Squirrels last week in Binghamton. To open his season, he is batting .333 (5-for-15) with two homers, a triple and four RBIs in four games.

**ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE:** **Carter Aldrete** homered three times over a five-game stretch from May 17-21. He has driven in nine runs over his last 11 games since May 17. In his last 19 games since May 6, he is batting .289 (22-for-76) with four homers, five doubles and 11 RBIs. Aldrete has hit safely in nine straight games dating back to May 19, the third-longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League. He has also reached base in 13 straight games since May 14. For the season, he is tied for seventh in the Eastern League with 25 RBIs.

**VAUN RETURNS:** Outfielder **Vaun Brown** was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average. Brown has reached base in each of his six games with Richmond.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** Richmond relievers have posted a 2.88 ERA this season, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in the minors. Of Eastern League pitchers who have worked at least 15 innings and have not made a start this year, five Flying Squirrels relievers are ranked in the top-15 in the Eastern League in ERA. **Nick Swiney**, who is now in Triple-A, is ranked second in ERA (1.15). **Raymond Burgos** (1.80) is seventh, **Wil Jensen** (2.00 ERA) is ninth, **Juan Sanchez** (2.49) is 14th and **Blake Rivera** is 15th (2.50). Out of all Eastern League pitchers, starters and relievers, who have thrown at least 25.0 innings this year, Jensen has the fifth-lowest ERA.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Luis Matos** is ranked fifth in batting average (.304) and 10th in OBP (.398). **Ismael Munguia** is eighth in batting average (.300). **Carter Aldrete** is tied for seventh in RBIs (25). **Riley Mahan** is tied for seventh in RBIs (25). **Hayden Cantrelle** is third in OBP (.412). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for first in triples (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is third in strikeouts (52) and is 10th in WHIP (1.22). **Evan Gates** is tied for eighth in saves (4).

**WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK:** Among the Eastern League leaders, Colt Keith is second in batting average (.321), sixth in homers (9), second in RBIs (35), fourth in SLG (.570), fourth in OPS (.964), second in hits (53), fourth in extra-base hits (21), second in total bases (94) and tied for eighth in runs scored (28). **Trei Cruz** is ninth in SLG (.511) and tied for eighth in runs scored (28). **Jake Holton** is tied for sixth in walks (30). **Wenceel Perez** is tied for eighth in runs scored (28). **Angel De Jesus** is tied for first in games pitched (16).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Vaun Brown** (No. 6), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Wade Meckler** (No. 23) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
