LET'S WIN A SERIES: After three straight wins over the Hillcats, the FredNats will try to take the series on Sunday afternoon in Lynchburg behind former first round pick Mason Denaburg on the mound. The FredNats have scored 28 runs in the last three days, and the pitching staff put together its best night of the season last night. So far this year, the FredNats are 2-1 in series finales, and that includes a walk-off win over the Hillcats on Opening Weekend at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. This is the final game of this six-game road trip before the team returns home next week to face the Down East Wood Ducks.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats scored the game's first run for the third straight day, and never trailed in a 5-2 win. Branden Boissiere, Daylen Lile and Elijah Green all went deep, and Green drove in the fifth run with an RBI fielder's choice. Pablo Aldonis had a strong start, pitching four innings of one-run ball, and he was followed by 2 2/3 innings from Pedro Gonzalez, who earned the win in relief. Franklin Marquez pitched an inning, and Tyler Yankosky got the final four outs for his first save in his 2023 debut in a rehab assignment for the FredNats.

OFFENSE IS AWAKE: The FredNats have scored double digit runs in 2 out of the last 3 games, and the team has won three in a row for the first time in 2023. The FredNats have racked up double digit hits in each game, and have combined for 28 runs in the last three wins.

HE'S HIM: 2022 first round pick Elijah Green had a breakout game last night for the FredNats. He drove in three runs, and his first home run in Fredericksburg 400+ feet to dead center field. His three RBIs were the difference in a 5-2 win, and he's only struck out in 33% of his plate appearances this week, a noticeable improvement from previous weeks.

2021 CLASS: The Nationals' top two picks in the 2021 draft are off to great starts in 2023 after being injured for most of 2022. Brady House played in just 45 games last year, and this year, he leads the entire Nationals Minor League organization in slugging (.646), OBP (.466), and OPS (1.112). Daylen Lile, the 2nd-round pick that missed all of 2022 with Tommy John, is second in the Carolina League in doubles (6), hit his second home run last night, and drove in the game-winning run in Friday's win over Lynchburg.

CARDIAC NATS: In three out of the seven wins so far for the FredNats, the team has trailed in the last inning. One of those games was against Lynchburg on Opening Weekend when Daylen Lile hit a game-tying single in the 10th inning which was followed up by Elijah Green's walk-off single. Johnathon Thomas hit a go-ahead three-run home run in the 9th inning last road trip in Fayetteville to give the FredNats the win that day. Friday night, Branden Boissiere had a game-tying base knock with 1 out in the 9th inning after the FredNats trailed by 3 runs entering the final frame.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Frelich. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Frelich steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Mason Denaburg takes the ball tonight as he looks to build off of an encouraging return to the mound in 2022. A late-first round selection in 2018, Denaburg made 13 starts in '22 for the FredNats, working to an ERA just north of 4.00, while holding opponents to a .229 batting average against.

LONG ROAD BACK: Denaburg has certainly been tested in his young career. After scuffling in his first taste of pro ball in 2018, the injury bug struck. Denaburg underwent surgeries on both his elbow and his shoulder after the '18 campaign, holding him out for 1,027 days between his last start in 2018, and his Fredericksburg debut in 2022.

Mason did work under a pitch count last season, so extending himself and working deeper into games is a big key for his 2023 season.

SMILE: Denaburg had the word "Smile" embroidered over the thumb on his glove, to remind himself to stay relaxed and have fun on the mound.

LAST TIME OUT: Denaburg improved on his first start of the year, in his second outing against Delmarva. He tossed three innings, allowing a pair of runs on just one hit. Crucially, he kept the ball in the yard after allowing two homers in his first appearance this year.
