YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Bowie Baysox, 12-1, at Prince George's Stadium. **Matt Frisbee** tied franchise records with 10 earned runs allowed and three hit batters. The Flying Squirrels pitching staff set a single-game franchise record with five hit batters. **Ricardo Genoves** gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI single. Bowie took a 4-1 lead with a grand slam by Cesar Prieto in the third and he added an RBI single in the fifth. The Baysox scored seven runs in the fifth, capped with a three-run homer by J.D. Mundy. Mundy added a solo homer in the seventh inning to open a 12-1 lead.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. This series is the third this year between the Flying Squirrels and the Baysox. They opened the season with a three-game series at Prince George's Stadium from April 8-10, with Richmond winning two. The teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 26-May 1, with the Flying Squirrels winning five games in the set.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on Sunday afternoon paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 17-10 since May 29 after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they split a six-game series at home against the Sea Dogs. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost three and split two this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 786 strikeouts and rank second with 91 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 18-17 on the road this year.

THE BAYSOX finished the first half with the worst record in the Eastern League at 27-42, 13.0 games behind Richmond in the Southwest Division standings. The Baysox are 4-6 in their last 10 games, including dropping four-of-six in last week's series at Erie. Bowie's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Colton Cowser (4), 3B Coby Mayo (7), 2B Connor Norby (10), INF Cesar Prieto (11), SS Joseph Ortiz (14), OF Hudson Haskin (15), LHP Drew Rom (16) and INF Adam Hall (26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his Double-A debut. After missing the start of the season with a back injury, Murphy joined High-A in Eugene in May. He made seven starts for the Emeralds, going 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond on June 28. During his time pitching for Eugene from May 15-June 22, Murphy led the Northwest League with 47 strikeouts, ranked seventh with a 2.90 ERA and ranked third with a 1.03 WHIP. Last year in his professional debut season, Murphy pitched for Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene. He finished the year second in the Giants system and third in the minors with 164 strikeouts, earning a selection as an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Giants out of NCAA DII Le Moyne College in New York. He is currently rated by MLB.com as the No. 11 Giants prospect and No. 10 by *Baseball America*. **For more on Murphy, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: LHP Drew Rom will make his 12th start of the season for the Baysox and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He made his season debut as the Opening Day starter for the Baysox against the Flying Squirrels on April 8 and allowed three runs in three innings. He faced the Flying Squirrels against on April 28 at The Diamond and allowed three runs in three innings in a no-decision. Rom last pitched on Friday at Erie and threw five scoreless innings in a win. Last year, he began the season with High-A Delmarva, going 8-0 with a 2.79 ERA in 14 outings, including 13 starts. He was promoted to Double-A Bowie on July 31. At the time of his promotion, he ranked tied for seventh in the High-A East with 73 strikeouts. Rom went 3-1 with a 3.83 ERA in nine outings (seven starts) for the Baysox. He started Game 3 of the Double-A Northeast Championship Series at Akron on September 24 and pitched 5.0 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts before the RubberDucks scored six runs over the final two innings to clinch the league title. Rom finished the 2021 season ranked fifth in the Orioles organization with 120 strikeouts, first with 107.2 innings pitched, and first with 11 wins. Overall on the year, he went 11-1 with a 3.18 ERA in 23 outings (20 starts) and was selected as an MiLB.com Orioles Organization All-Star. In 2019, he was a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star with Delmarva. Rom was selected in the fourth round (115th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Ky.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,198) and total attendance (216,919). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 91 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (93). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 19 homers on the season, with 16 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 177 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GO! After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .420 (21-for-50) with four doubles, four homers and 15 RBIs over his last 13 games since June 7. He started the stretch with two doubles on June 7 against the SeaWolves and hit his first homer of the season the next day. He collected a season-high three hits in the series finale against the SeaWolves on June 12, capping the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. It was his second walk-off hit as a member of the Flying Squirrels. He has homered in three of his last six games played.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .311 (37-for-119) with seven homers, five doubles, a triple and 21 RBIs in 37 games. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the month of June, he has walked 15 times and struck out 15 times in 17 games. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked fourth in batting average (.297), second in OBP (.429), 10th in SLG (.503) and fifth in OPS (.932). He is also ranked third in the EL is wRC+ (162) and wOBA (.415) and first among active EL players.

TOASTY: Over his last 16 games since June 9, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .175 (10-for-57) with three homers and six RBIs. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked seventh in batting average (.291), tied for fourth in hits (71) and seventh in total bases (117).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 19th homer of the year on Sunday afternoon against the Sea Dogs, moving ahead of **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lison** (2014) for the most homers in a season in team history, trailing only **David Villar's** record 20 homers last season. He is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 16 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

GENO: Since joining the Flying Squirrels, **Ricardo Genoves** has picked up at least one hit in eight of his nine games played to open his Double-A career. On Tuesday, he picked up his first Double-A homer, going deep against rehabbing MLB pitcher Matt Harvey. He added an RBI single in Wednesday's loss. Genoves began the year with Triple-A Sacramento, batting .233 in 38 games with three homers and 21 RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked seventh in batting average (.291), tied for fourth in hits (71) and seventh in total bases (117). **Sean Roby** is second in homers (19). **Shane Matheny** is fourth in batting average (.297), second in OBP (.429) and third in OPS (.932). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for fifth in stolen bases (17). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: In the Eastern League, Gunnar Henderson is second in batting average (.312), first in OBP (.452), second in SLG (.573), first in OPS (1.025), tied for fifth in walks (41) and seventh in runs scored (41). Adam Hall is eighth in stolen bases (16).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (10), **Ricardo Genoves** (24) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genoves (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
