### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox collected their seventh win in their last eight games with a 6-1 victory on Wednesday night. Reed Trimble broke the scoreless tie in the fourth with a bases clearing double for his first Double-A hit. Bowie also drew a season-high 12 walks, including a bases loaded walk from Frederick Bencosme. Dylan Beavers reached base four times, including a two-run double in the ninth. Peter Van Loon matched his career-high with eight strikeouts over 4.1 shutout innings.

### **BASALLO BASHES**

C/1B Samuel Basallo, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for 2nd in the Eastern League lead in total bases (166) and is tied for 3rd among active Eastern League players in hits (102). The No. 3 O's/ No. 11 MLB prospect is 3rd among qualified Eastern League hitters with a .381 batting average (16-for-42) in August.

### BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. made his Double-A debut on Tuesday and recorded his first Double-A hit and RBI on a single to right in the 4th. At the time of promotion, the Orioles 2023 first rounder stole 59 bases, which led the South Atlantic League and was second in all of Minor League Baseball.

### THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF Jud Fabian retook the Eastern League lead in home runs with his 18th on the season on Tuesday. Amongst all Double-A hitters, he is tied for 4th in home runs. The O's No. 13 prospect has 33 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

After reaching base four times yesterday, OF Dylan Beavers has reached base in 77 of 95 games played this season. The Orioles No. 8 prospect is 2nd in the Eastern League in walks (55) and tied for 3rd in stolen bases (25).

### WELCOME TO DOUBLE-A

IF/OF Tavian Josenberger and OF Reed Trimble have recorded their first Double-A hits since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen on Tuesday. Josenberger collected a pair of hits in his debut while Trimble cleared the bases with a double down the line. At the time of their promotions, Josenberger stole 45 bases, 2nd most in the South Atlantic League, while Trimble went 27-for-27 in stolen base attempts.

#### SECOND HALF SILAS

C Silas Ardoin is batting a team-best .339 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .448 and OPS of .841. The 23-year-old has hits in 10 of his last 12 games with multi-hit performances in five of those contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 23 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

### START ME UP

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation is tied with Binghamton for the lowest starter ERA in Double-A at 2.05. Over the last three games, the starters have combined to throw 13.1 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run.

### TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve are tied for fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 16-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Pirates has won 10 of the last 11 games against the Baysox. Three of the Pirates top 30 prospects are on the Curve active roster - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 7), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 8), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 18).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Grant Ford makes his first start of the season. He is expected to serve as an opener for LHP Nick Dombkowski. Ford is 2-2 on the season with a 4.35 ERA in 26 appearances. The 26-year-old has faced the Baysox five times in his career and holds a 2.89 ERA in 9.1 innings. Ford was drafted by the Pirates in the 5th round of the 2019 Draft out of Nevada. This is his second season with the Curve.

### **QUICK HITS**

Arsenal: 4-Seam, Changeup, Curveball, Slider Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on June 4, returned to Double-A Bowie on Aug. 6 Drafted in the 5th round by the Orioles in 2021 out of UT Arlington

2024: Made first start of season on 8/9 vs HBG and threw 3.0 IP, allowed 2 R, 4 H, and 3 BB over 3 K in no decision. Received from Triple-A Norfolk on 8/6. Pitched in 10 games (3 starts) with Tides and recorded a 9.29 ERA in 31 IP with 28 K over 27 BB. Made Triple-A debut on 6/6 @ SWB. Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 6/4. Began season on Bowie Opening Day roster as a tandem reliever. Pitched in nine games and recorded a 3.30 ERA in 30 IP with 36 K and a 1.07 WHIP. Threw 12.0 consecutive scoreless innings to end month of May over final four outings. Has pitched 16.2 consecutive scoreless innings of relief on the road beginning on April 23. Enters second season with Baysox.

**2023:** Spent entire season with Double-A Bowie primarily as a starter. Threw third-most innings (79.2) and recorded third-most strikeouts (89) on the team. Gave up second-most home runs on team as well (15). Posted a 3.43 ERA on the road. Best month pitched was in July when he posted a 2.74 ERA in 23 IP. Pitched five innings in five outings. Struck out Double-A high 10 batters in four innings on 6/1/23 vs HBG.

**2022:** Spent entire season with High-A Aberdeen as a full-time starter. Was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month in May after recording a 0.49 ERA and holding opponents to a .098 average. Struck out 81 batters over 57.1 innings. Placed on the injured list two separate times after June before eventually being placed on the IL for remainder of season on 8/4.

**2021:** Debuted professionally with Single-A Delmarva. Pitched in six games (three starts) and struck out 13 batters over 12 innings.

**College/Personal**: Drafted by the Orioles in the 5th round of the 2021 Draft out of UT-Arlington. Pitched two seasons with the Mavericks, where he set a single-season program record for strikeouts as a junior in '21 with 117. Led Sun Belt Conference in strikeouts. Pitched nine no-hit innings as part of an 11-inning combined no-hitter against Little Rock on 5/1/22. Transferred to UT - Arlington from Weatherford College in 2020 after pitching at Weatherford for two seasons.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

### **CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX**

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organizations. All Ribens, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain basebal team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia an New Zealand in 2011.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
