YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox lost their third consecutive game to the Altoona Curve by a final of 3-2. The Baysox went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position and left nine on base. Starter **Trey Gibson** pitched 3.2 innings and allowed two runs on six hits and four walks but struck out seven. **Preston Johnson** and **Raul Alcantara** combined for 5.1 innings of one-run ball in relief. Chesapeake had the bases loaded with one out in the ninth but the game ended after a double play started by right fielder Mike Jarvis.

START THE SECOND HALF

On Tuesday, the records reset as the second half of the 2025 Eastern League season began. After spending the majority of the first half on the road, the Baysox play 36 of their 66 remaining regular season games at Prince George's Stadium. **53 of those games are against opponents who held a sub .500 record in the first half.**

ALL SET FOR O'NEILL

Orioles' OF **Tyler O'Neill** is scheduled to continue his rehab assignment this week here at Prince George's Stadium. **O'Neill** is **recovering from a left shoulder impingement that has kept him on the injured list since May 18.** The 30-year-old began his rehab assignment in Aberdeen on Sunday. He is the third Oriole this season to make a rehab assignment with the Baysox. O'Neill is 0-for-6 in two games at the plate.

LEAVE THE RETZ TO ADAM

C/1B **Adam Retzbach** is having a career year in his first full season with the Baysox. **Retzbach currently has career-highs in AVG (.251), OBP (.351), SLG (.425), OPS (.776) and 2B (11).** Additionally, he is one home run away from matching a career-high from last season in 28 fewer games played.

Chesapeake has won just 10 games at home this season, which is the fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The last time the Baysox finished a season at least 10 games below .500 at home was in 2016 (30-41). The Baysox have dropped 12 of their last 15 home games since May 27.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.00 ERA, which is fourth-best in Double-A and sixth-best in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 361 hitters, which is third-most in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

Chesapeake has won 16 one-run games this season - **most in the Eastern League.** The Baysox have played 29 one-run games this season, **which is the most in all of Double-A.** Additionally, Chesapeake won its eighth extra-inning game of the season last Friday. Eight extra-inning wins are the second-most amongst full-season MiLB clubs (Quad Cities - High-A KC).

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

The Altoona Curve - Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates - finished the first half with a 30-38 record. Despite winning four of six in Bowie in the most recent series meeting April 22 - 27, Altoona recorded the second-worst road record in the first half (10-20) behind Richmond. Altoona's roster includes only two of the Pirates' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - 2B/SS Termarr Johnson (No. 4), OF Mitch Jebb (No. 13).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Alessandro Ercolani is scheduled to make his 13th start of the regular season for Altoona. The 21-year-old is coming off five scoreless innings vs Richmond last week. Ercolani is enjoying his best month of the season where he has recorded just a 2.65 ERA in 17 innings pitched. The Borgo Maggiore, San Marino native has faced Chesapeake once this season and gave up three homers in four innings on April 26 in a no-decision.

Posted a 3.27 ERA in first half. Recorded a 3.66 ERA in 19.2 IP with 16 K over 7 BB in month of May. Lasted only one inning on 5/17 vs AKR due to left abdomen discomfort. Pitched first career quality start with career-high 6.0 innings of two-run ball on 5/10 @ POR. Pitched 5.0 IP with 5 K in first Double-A start on 4/26 vs ALT. Started season as a tandem reliever before being inserted into starting rotation on 4/26. Notched first Double-A save on 4/15 @ RIC. Enters first season in Chesapeake. Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
