NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster for Omaha, but the Storm Chasers enter today's game on a season-best 8-game winning streak.

Of 18 series this year, the Chasers have won 7, lost 8 and split 3 ... yesterday's win secured back-to-back series wins and the club's 7th series victory of the year.

Month by month, the Chasers went 13-12 in April, 13-14 in May, and 10-15 in June – their first back-to-back losing months since May/June 2025 ... July has been a turnaround: at 11-7, Omaha needs to go 2-4 over the final 6 games to finish with a winning month.

GOING STREAKING

Omaha's 8-game winning streak is tied for the longest active streak in the Minors, the longest by a Royals affiliate in 2026 and the club's longest since 2024.

The Chasers have won 9 of the last 10 games going back to July 10 ... the 8-game winning streak is Omaha's best since a 9-game streak from May 29 to June 6, 2024 ... the club's longest winning streak is 11 games, from June 6 to 18, 2023.

During this 8-game winning streak, the Storm Chasers are hitting .338 (99-for-293) and lead all Triple-A teams with 66 runs scored and a 1.099 OPS, both rank 3rd in the Minors over this stretch.

Omaha has scored 8+ runs in 5 straight games and 6+ runs in 8 of the last 10.

During the 8-game winning streak, **Gavin Cross** leads all Triple-A hitters with 28 total bases, while Cross and **Brandon Drury** are tied 2nd with 10 RBI each.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Chasers have 28 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 28 losses this year.

The 28 comeback wins are tied for 2nd-most in the International League and tied for 3rd in Triple-A (Salt Lake leads all of Triple-A and full-season Minor League ball with 33) ... Omaha's 28 blown leads rank tied 3rd in the International League and tied 5th in Triple-A.

Over the last 64 games (since May 9), Omaha is 31-33 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 22 of their 31 wins in that stretch, and led at some point in 18 of their 33 losses – meaning 40 of Omaha's last 64 games (63%) have featured a comeback from the eventual winner ... it's also been a tight stretch overall: 42 of those 64 games (66%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer.

5 of Omaha's last 9 wins have been comebacks, with the Chasers trailing for at least 2.0 innings in all 5 and overcoming multiple deficits in 4 of them ... over the last 4 comeback wins, Omaha has erased 8 separate deficits – trailing twice last night, 3 times Tuesday at Salt Lake, and twice more Sunday against Lehigh Valley.

CROSS ME UP

Gavin Cross had one of the league's slowest starts to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.

Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 52 games (since May 16), he's hitting .319 (61-for-191), with 22 extra-base hits and 39 RBI, with 19 multi-hit games, including 9 of his last 13 games.

Cross enters today on a career-best 16-game hitting streak, Omaha's longest of the year and the longest active Triple-A hitting streak, tied for the 2nd-longest active streak in the Minors ... since July 2, he's hitting .382 (26-for-68) with 13 extra-base hits, 17 RBI and a 1.152 OPS.

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May

Since May 12, Toro has a .326 average (62-for-190) ... in this stretch, he ranks 1st in the IL in OPS (1.019), 1st in SLG (.621) and tied 7th in AVG (.326) ... his 47 RBI over 51 games since May 12 rank as the 6th-most in the league.

From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 13, Toro has hits in 38 of 51 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.

SUMMER HEAT

A trio of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.

In his last 23 games (since June 21), **Brett Squires** is slashing .333/.422/.607 (28-for-84) with 19 RBI ... from June 16 to July 2, he hit safely in a career-best 14 straight.

Drew Waters has hit safely in 18 of his last 20 games (since June 16), a stretch where he is slashing .317/.356/.500 (26-for-82) with 9 extra-base hits and 11 RBI.

From his first game with Omaha on June 4, **Matthew Lugo** has hit .285 (39-for-137) with 28 RBI in 35 games ... since his arrival, he is 5th in the International League in extra-base hits (21), tied 5th in home runs (9), tied 7th in doubles (11), 8th in total bases (79) and tied 8th in runs scored (28).

- ✓ Mitch Spence is making his **16th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **19th overall appearance** of the season.
- ✓ Playing his **7th professional season** this year ... the Royals are his 3rd Major League organization, after being drafted by the Yankees and spending the last two years with the Athletics.
- ✓ Spence ranks 1st on the Storm Chasers in starts (15), 2nd in strikeouts (58) and 2nd in innings pitched (69.0) ... he's also allowed the 2nd-most hits (76) and tied for the 2nd-most runs (46) and home runs (12).
- ✓ This is Spence's 2nd career appearance against Salt Lake and his 9th against the Angels and their affiliates ... with the A's the last two years, he has a 2.90 ERA (10 ER in 31.0 IP) in the Majors against the Angels

- ✓ **QUALITY CONTROL:** Spence is tied for the team lead in quality starts (3) ... most recently, he allowed 1 run over 6.0 innings on July 2 vs. Indianapolis ... he also fired consecutive quality starts in May.
- ✓ **ROAD WORK:** Spence has been one of the Chasers' best pitchers on the road this year, working a 3.60 ERA (14 ER in 35.0 IP) with 34 strikeouts and a .181 opponents average in 7 road starts for Omaha.
- ✓ **A SPENCE OF PURPOSE:** Spence had a career-worst start on May 26 vs. Memphis (STL), allowing 13 runs on 15 hits in 3.0 innings, but has been reliable since ... over his last 8 Triple-A starts (since May 31), Spence has pitched to a 3.50 ERA (14 ER in 36.0 IP).

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, JULY 19 VS. LEHIGH VALLEY

- ✓ Made his 15th start of the year for Omaha ... allowed a pair of runs in the top of the 1st inning behind a trio of singles ... an error allowed a one-out baserunner, then Robert Moore hit a 2-out, 2-run home run to in the top of the 2nd inning ... gave up an RBI single in the 3rd inning before finishing the frame ... worked a scoreless top of the 4th inning and did not return for the 5th.

- ✓ Was designated for assignment by the Athletics on February 10 and traded to Kansas City on February 12 in exchange for RHP A.J. Causey.
- ✓ Worked back-to-back quality starts for the Storm Chasers on May 7 and May 15, allowing 5 runs on 6 hits and 4 walks over 12.2 innings (0.79 WHIP) between the two games.
- ✓ Has made 3 MLB appearances over 3 stints with Kansas City: April 9 to 19, June 15 to 16 and June 26 to 27.

 - ✓ Spent much of the year in the Major Leagues with the Athletics, splitting time as a starter and reliever ... made the A's Opening Day roster for the second straight year and opened the season as a reliever, making 22 relief appearances with a 4.38 ERA (19 ER in 39.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts before June 2.
 - ✓ Made his first start of the year June 5 and worked a 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP) in his first three games as a starter ... optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 10 and pitched in 8 games (7 starts) before the Athletics recalled him on September 10 for the remainder of the season.
