## ROUGHRIDERS FALL IN PITCHERS DUEL

The Frisco RoughRiders outhit the Amarillo Sod Poodles but were edged 2-1 on Friday night at Riders Field. Following a weather delay of one hour and 53 minutes, Owen White (1-1) made his eighth start of the season and allowed just three hits in five innings. Amarillo (16-21) scrapped for a run in the second and a run in the fourth to lead 2-1. Neither team scored the rest of the game. Evan Carter recorded the lone RBI for the RoughRiders (16-20), lacing a single in the third inning to bring home Cooper Johnson. Johnson had doubled earlier in the inning for his first hit with Frisco. Luke Albright (3-2) went five innings for Amarillo with just one run allowed. Jake Rice went 1-2-3 in the ninth inning for the save. Frisco snapped a three-game winning streak with the loss and Amarillo halted a four-game losing streak. The Frisco bullpen posted four scoreless innings on Friday. Marc Church struck out two and didn't allow a base runner in the sixth, followed by scoreless innings from Hever Bueno, Alex Speas and Eudrys Manon. RoughRiders relievers have given up just one run and four hits this series across 13.2 innings.

## SINGLE-INNING HISTORY:

On Wednesday, Nick Tanielu hammered two home runs in the fifth inning for the Riders. It was the first time in franchise history that a player hit two home runs in the same inning. It was also the fourth multi-home run game for Tanielu in his career. The 30 -year-old veteran is on fire at the plate, hitting four homers in his last three games and riding a nine-game hitting streak while batting .353/.421/.882/1.303 with five home runs and 10 RBIs.

## PERFECT TIMING:

The RoughRiders took down the Amarillo Sod Poodles 3-2 on Tuesday for their first win in games decided by one run or two runs on the season. Dustin Harris' solo home run in the eighth was also the first game-winning hit for the RoughRiders in their final at-bat on the year and the first time they won when tied in the sixth inning or later.

## TOP 100 RERANKING:

MLB.com has reranked their Top 100 prospects and the RoughRiders have four Top 100 players that have seen some movement. Outfielder Evan Carter is now the No. 11 prospect in baseball (previously No. 36) while pitcher Owen White is No. 51, infielder Luisangel Acuña places at No. 58 and pitcher Jack Leiter is at No. 80. The Rangers fourth-round pick in 2022, pitcher Brock Porter, is the No. 81 prospect as well. He is currently pitching for Low-A Down East.

## THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 18 games, he is hitting .390 ( 30 -for- 77 )/.427/.584/1.011 with four doubles, a triple, three homers, 15 RBIs and 13 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .385/.403/.554/1.011 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

## IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder Kellen Strahm has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting $.304 / .392 / .478 / .870$ with four doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBls while walking 10 times. Over the last 18 games, he has raised his average 106 points and his OPS 279 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just $.136 / .337 / .226 / .563$ on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing $.305 / .406 / .445 / .851$ over his last 82 games of the season.

## ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting . 318 (47-for-148)/.378/.459/.837 through the first 34 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (47), tied for sixth in doubles (10), fifth in total bases (68) and tied for second in stolen bases (16). Over his last 31 games, he is batting .333/.407/.492/.899. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (123).

## WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 183 walks are first among Texas League teams while their . 359 team OBP is third in Double-A. Dustin Harris is second in the league with 28 walks while Evan Carter is eighth in OBP (.421) in the league and third in the league with 27 walks.
