### Big Week on the Road

The Fightin Phils hit the road for their penultimate road trip of the 2026 regular season. It will be a big matchup at the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, who reading currently holds a 2.5-game lead over in the Northeast Division Standings. It is the 13th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and seventh-of-12 at Hadlock Field in Portland. Entering play today, the Sea Dogs hold a 7-5 edge in the season series.

### All Chesapeake on Saturday

The Reading Fightin Phils (25-19, 55-58) fell 9-3 to the Chesapeake Baysox on Saturday night at FirstEnergy Stadium, evening the six-game series at three games apiece while maintaining a two-game lead in the Eastern League Northeast Division. Chesapeake's Aron Estrada delivered a historic performance, going 5-for-5 with three home runs, five RBIs and two runs scored. Estrada opened the game with a leadoff homer, added another solo shot in the third and capped his night with a two-run double in the eighth, becoming the 30th player in Baysox franchise history to record five hits in a game. The Baysox built a 7-1 lead through five innings, with Thomas Sosa adding an RBI double, Victor Figueroa hitting a solo homer and Dom Keegan launching his third home run in as many games. Reading finally mounted a late rally in the ninth, scoring twice on RBI plays from Bryan Rincon and Pedro León, but the deficit proved too large to overcome. Braydon Tucker took the loss after allowing seven runs on 10 hits over five innings, while Trace Bright earned the win with five innings of relief and seven strikeouts. Rincon provided one of the few offensive highlights for Reading, going 3-for-5 with a double and a run scored. Despite the loss, the Fightin Phils remain two games ahead of both Portland and Somerset with 28 games remaining.

### Destiny in Our Hands

The Fightin Phils next two series are against two of the teams chasing them in the Northeast Division standings. First up is Portland, who is 2.5 games back and then next week Binghamton comes to Reading, as the Rumble Ponies have roared their way all the way back to 3.5 games behind the R-Phils. Somerset is also mixed into a crowded playoff picture as well, also 2.5-games back of Reading, but those two teams don't match up again this season. This marks the latest in the season that the Fightin Phils have been in first place since they finished the 2019 second half with a 41-31 record, which clinched the second half division title that season.

### Binelas Bashes

Alex Binelas, who played for Portland for parts of three seasons ('22-'24), enters play tonight with 25 home runs, which matches a career-high (2022) and has the most home runs in the Eastern League this season. His 25 home runs have all come with Reading and it made him the first Fightin Phil to hit the 25-home run mark since Mitch Walding in 2017. With 24 games remaining, Binelas is five home runs away from being the first R-Phil to hit over 30 long balls in a season since 2016, when Dylan Cozens (40) and Rhys Hoskins (38) both surpassed the mark.

### Mr. Doubles

Raylin Heredia enters play tonight with a team-high and Eastern League-best 32 doubles this season. This is the second-straight season that a R-Phil had over 30 doubles, as Felix Reyes had 34 in 2025. The last time Reading had a player with over 30 doubles in back-to-back seasons was Brock Stassi (32) in 2015 and Dylan Cozens (38) in 2016. Heredia is the 24th R-Phil in franchise history to have over 30 doubles in a single-season and currently ranks as tied for the 17th most doubles in a single-season in team history. Greg Jacobs (2007) and David Doster (1995) hold the franchise record in single-season doubles with 39.

### Bringing in Reinforcements

With the stretch run of the season in full swing, the Fightin Phils are set to get some of their most productive players back in the lineup. Bryson Ware returns from the injured list tonight, after being placed on the IL on June 29. He slugged 13 home runs in 61 games before getting injured and has posted an .825 OPS this season. Dante Nori began his rehab last week with Clearwater (A) and has moved up to Jersey Shore (A+) this week. Austin Murr will also begin a rehab assignment with Jersey Shore this week. So, it seems as if Murr and Nori should re-join Reading in the very near future.

### One Year Turnaround

The Fightin Phils finished the 2025 season with a 55-81 record, which was the lowest win total under Al Pedrique (since 2023). Entering play tonight, Reading has matched its win total from last season through the first 113 games of the 2026 campaign. Reading won 59 games in 2024 and 2023, while 2019 (80-53 overall record) is the last time the Fightins eclipsed the 60-win mark. Reading lost the first four games of the season and is 55-54 since. After starting the second half off 0-2 in Altoona, the Fightins are 25-17 over a 42-game span.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

August 18, 2015: At Reading, the Fightin Phils rally from 5-2 deficit for their 4th straight win, a 6-5 decision over New Hampshire. Andrew Knapp homers, doubles, drives in 2 and scores 2 as he extends his hitting streak to 16 consecutive games.

### Playing Portland

The Sea Dogs enter tonight with a 58-55 overall record and 23-22 mark in the second half, 2.5-games behind Reading for first place. Portland most recently dropped five-of-six games against Binghamton, and following this week, they begin a two-week road trip, first at Richmond. Portland's roster features eight of the Red Sox top-30 prospects: Justin Gonzales (2), Henry Godbout (6), Yoeilin Cespedes (14), Jack Winnay (23), Mason White (26), Hayden Mullins (27), Miguel Bleis (28) and Johanfran Garcia (29).

### Baysox Pitcher

Lefty Dalton Rogers makes his 17th appearances/13th start of the season. Rogers is 1-4, with a 5.79 ERA (39 ER, 60.2 IP), along with 54 strikeouts. He last pitched on Aug. 11 against Binghamton, allowing seven runs over 4.2 innings in a loss. In two starts against Reading this season, Rogers is 0-1, allowing four-earned runs in six innings, with four strikeouts. Rogers split last season between Greenville (A+) and Portland, going 6-6, with a 3.09 ERA over 23 games. The Red Sox took the 25-year old in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Southern Mississippi.
