Today is the fourth of a six-game series at historic Modern Woodmen Park and the fourth of 12 meetings this year between the Lugnuts and River Bandits, who split a six-game season series last year in Davenport. Lansing won the series opener, but Quad Cities has won the last two.

Yesterday: River Bandits 4, Lugnuts 3. Austin Charles delivered a two-run double in the fifth inning to give the Bandits a 4-1 lead, and then Quad Cities held on tight through Lansing threats in the sixth, seventh, eighth and ninth innings, each one ending in a tight play at first base. Jose Dicochea tossed two scoreless innings while Nate Nankil and Devin Taylor each went 2-for-4 in the losing effort. Manager Javier Godard was ejected in the ninth inning, his first ejection of the year.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and River Bandits play through Sunday, enjoy an off day on Monday, and then Lansing returns to Michigan's state capital to welcome in the Dayton Dragons for seven games in six days, April 27-May 3 with a morning doubleheader on a Grand Slam School Day, Wednesday, April 28.

LUG-NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 15 (**Gavin Turley**) No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Bobby Boser**) on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

Roller Coaster: This series has already seen ten lead changes (three on Tuesday, five on Wednesday, two on Thursday), and the team that scored the first run has only won one of the three games (Quad Cities on Wednesday).

Rallying Against the Relief: The River Bandits have used nine relievers so far in the series – and each one has allowed at least one run to the Lugnuts' offense (18 runs in 14 innings, 11.57 ERA). On the other hand, Quad Cities' starters have combined to allow only two runs in 13 innings (1.38). This is nothing new for Lansing, which leads the Midwest League in top batting average (.307), most hits (101), highest OBP (.403) and highest OPS (.868) against relief pitching, but is slashing just .206/.307/.321 against starters, third lowest in the league.

Big Nate: After opening the season 2-for-15 and then landing on the Injured List, **Nate Nankil** returned to action yesterday and went 2-for-4 with a pair of singles and a run scored. This should be no surprise considering how well he's played at Modern Woodmen Park in his career: In 2025, a pair of three-hit games en route to .429/.478/.429, 9-for-21, 3 R, 1 RBI, 1 BB, 1 K, 1 HBP in five games. And in 2024, he batted .368/.381/.579, 7-for-19, with a double and a monstrous home run. All told, Nankil is hitting .409/.438/.500, 18-for-44, with eight runs scored, one double, one HR, two walks and two strikeouts in 12 games in Davenport.

All Aboard: Shortstop **Bobby Boser** has reached base in 16 straight games (19 hits, 10 walks and four HBPs). **Davis Diaz** has reached base in 14 straight games (17 hits, 13 walks, one HBP).

Milestone Watch: Lansing is 10 wins away from the 2,000th win in Lugnuts history and 3 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Cooperstown Bound: Happy 49th birthday, **Carlos Beltrán!** Carlos was an original 1996 Lugnut, a member of the very first starting lineup on April 5, 1996, and went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Miller Time: The most dominant former Lugnut in the Majors is untouchable Padres closer / 2022 Lugnut **Mason Miller**, not to be confused with Quad Cities southpaw **Mason Miller**. In 12 appearances spanning 12 1/3 scoreless innings this season, batters are 3-for-39 with two singles, two walk and 27 strikeouts. Miller has tossed 34 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings, tying Cla Meredith's franchise record.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher **Daniel Susac**, has opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with two doubles and a triple through 11 games with the Giants. Debuting on April 1, Susac hit safely in his first five at-bats, setting a new Giants modern-day franchise record and coming up one shy of the Major League modern-day franchise record set by Boston OF Ted Cox in 1977. Susac was taken in the Rule 5 Draft by Minnesota and traded to San Francisco.

APRIL 24TH IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2012: The Chiefs scored six runs in the bottom of the ninth, capped by a Paul Hoilman grand slam, to beat Ajay Meyer and the Lugnuts, 6-2. Starter Aaron Sanchez struck out seven batters in three scoreless innings in a no-decision.

2017: Edward Olivares hit for the cycle, finishing with a two-run triple in the eighth, and the Lugnuts beat the South Bend Cubs, 11-5, at Cooley Law School Stadium. It was the first cycle for a Nut since 2010 (Brad Glenn) and the third consecutive game that the Nuts had scored at least 11 runs.

In a Nutshell: Earned his first pro win in his Lansing debut, April 3 vs. Dayton, with five scoreless innings in a 5-1 victory over the Dragons... making his fourth professional outing tonight (Sept. 20, 2025, for Las Vegas)... member of the A's Spring Breakout roster, but did not pitch in the game... made three Cactus League appearances (3 2/3 IP, 6 H, 6 R, 3 HR, 1 BB, 3 K).

Scouting Report: MLB Pipeline's grades on Taylor's stuff - 55 fastball, 50 curveball, 50 slider, 55 changeup, 50 cutter, 55 control... "A mainstay in UNC Wilmington's rotation over his four years there, Taylor produced one of the best seasons in school history as a senior in 2025 by leading NCAA Division I in K/BB ratio (9.6) and WHIP (0.76), while also ranking second in walk rate (1.0 per nine innings) and fourth in ERA (1.98). Entering the 2025 Draft as one of the top senior arms in the class, he was selected in the fifth round by the A's and signed at a full-slot bonus of \$513,900, becoming the highest-drafted pitcher out of UNCW since supplemental first-rounder Bradley Holt in 2008. With Triple-A Las Vegas in need of a starter at the end of the season, Taylor was called upon for his pro debut with a start for a playoff-bound Aviators squad."
