

# RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES 2025 GAME NOTES

## LHP Sterling Patick (1-2, 5.22 ERA) vs. RHP Chris Clark (1-5, 5.58 ERA)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes continue a six-game road trip with the fourth game of a six-game series against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on June 17th, when they host the Lake Elsinore Storm as part of the final home stand of the first half. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE 66ERS:** Today's game is the 16th of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the tenth of 12 here at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes have taken five of six in both series so far against the 66ers. After taking two of three in this set, they have a 12-3 mark against the 66ers. In 2024, Rancho went 10-2 at San Manuel Stadium, 17-7 overall. **LAST GAME:** The Quakes trimmed their magic number to one to clinch the First Half South Division, shutting out Inland Empire on Thursday night by a final of 5-0 at San Manuel Stadium. Christian Zazueta (6-2) improved to 4-0 against the 66ers this year, tossing five innings of scoreless baseball. Cody Morse and Myles Caba each threw two scoreless frames to help earn Rancho their sixth shutout of 2025 and their second straight win overall. Mairo Martinus drove in three and scored twice, as Rancho's offense collected just four hits on the night. Inland Empire starter Nixon Encarnacion (0-1) gave up one run on one hit, but walked six over 3.2 innings in the loss.

**WIN AND YOU'RE IN:** With back-to-back wins in this series and two straight losses for Visalia, the Quakes have put themselves in a pretty good spot, as any win over their final six games will clinch the First Half South Division crown and send them back to the playoffs for the first time since 2023, when they lost in the Championship Series to the Modesto Nuts. Should the Quakes lose all six games that remain in the first half, they could still clinch with one loss by Visalia and one loss by Lake Elsinore. Up north, San Jose now has a two-game lead over Modesto with six to play. Those two teams finish the first half with three head-to-head games in Modesto.

**ZEROS:** Last night's shutout gives Rancho six on the year, tying them with Lake Elsinore for the most in the league. Rancho's ERA is second in the league, now at 3.95, behind only San Jose at 3.37. Inland ranks dead-last in ERA at 6.18. **CLEAN SWEEP OF MONTHLY AWARDS:** The Quakes have continued their dominance of California League awards in 2025, as a pair of Quakes were honored last week. OF Eduardo Quintero was named the Player of the Month for May, while RHP Christian Zazueta was named Pitcher of the Month. Quintero's May was outstanding, as he batted .391 and led all of minor league baseball in hits (43). He led the league in doubles (10), triples (4), RBIs (28), stolen bases (15), slugging (.718) and OPS (1.195). Zazueta went 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA in six starts. His 31 strikeouts over 30 innings led the league. Sean Paul Linan was named April's Cal League Pitcher of the Month, before heading to High-A. **STERLING PATICK:** 19-year-old Sterling Patick makes his seventh start and 11th appearance, his second against Inland Empire. In his lone appearance against the 66ers, Patick allowed six runs on four hits, while only retiring one batter. Patick's last start was on June 6th against San Jose, where he allowed just one run on two hits over four innings, in a no-decision. Patick was a 2023 18th-round selection for the Dodgers out of South Hills High School in West

Covina. **CHRIS CLARK:** Chris Clark makes his 13th start and his third against the Quakes. In two games against the Quakes, he's 0-1 with a 6.97 ERA, allowing eight runs on ten hits over 10.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on three hits over six innings in a no-decision at Visalia on June 7th. Clark made six appearances for the 66ers in 2023, before spending all of 2024 in High-A Tri-City of the Northwest League, when he went just 3-12 with a 6.09 ERA across 22 starts. Clark was a fifth-round pick for the Angels out of Harvard back in 2023. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog. from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
