LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox won their second straight game against the Senators by a final of 7-1 last night. A six-run first inning ignited the Baysox via a grand slam from **Ryan Higgins**, his first career grand slam. **Samuel Basallo** tallied a game-high four hits and **Dylan Beavers**, **Frederick Bencosme** and **Silas Ardoin** all recorded RBI. Starting right-hander **Alex Pham** threw five shutout innings with five strikeouts, **Levi Stoudt** threw two perfect innings and **Bradley Brehmer** dealt two innings with four strikeouts to seal the

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for 2nd in the Eastern League in total bases (158) and is tied for 4th in hits (97). Last night, Basallo recorded his first four-hit game at Double-A and the second four-hit game of his professional career. The No. 2 O's/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 2nd-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (15) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit homers in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in '18. Basallo will turn 20 years of age next Tuesday.

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

With his 17th homer of the season on Tuesday, OF **Jud Fabian** stands alone as the Eastern League's leader in home runs after his leadoff solo shot. Amongst Double-A hitters, he is tied for 4th in home runs. The O's No. 8 prospect has 32 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has tallied a hit in 11 of his last 13 games. Over his last 10 games, the Orioles No. 24 prospect is batting .441 (15-for-34) with two doubles, a homer and six RBI. Bencosme has five multi-hit games in his last eight played. Against Somerset last week, Bencosme went 11-for-19 in the series.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** set a new a career-high in home runs on Tuesday with his 12th of the season. The 22-year-old has reached base in 71 of 89 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (48) and stolen bases (24), both tied for 4th-most in the Eastern League.

SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is batting a team-best .389 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .522 and OPS of .994. The 23-year-old has collected a hit in seven straight contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 22 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

FIRST TO 1000

The Baysox pitching staff is the first Eastern League team this season to reach 1,000 strikeouts. Amongst Double-A staffs, Bowie's 1,016 strikeouts is second-most behind Northwest Arkansas. Bowie finished 17th in strikeouts in all of Double-A last season.

SIZING UP THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators are in last place in the Southwest Division with a record of 12-21. The Double-A affiliate of the Nationals is at the bottom of the league in AVG, OPS and HR but its pitching staff owns the second-best ERA in the circuit. Eight of the Nationals top 30 prospects are on the Senators active roster - OF Daylen Lile (No. 9), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 16), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 19), SS Kevin Made (No. 20), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (No. 25), RHP Andry Lara (No. 26), RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Andry Lara makes his 14th start of the season for the Senators. Lara was promoted from High-A Wilmington on May 14 after recording a 2.35 ERA in six starts with the Blue Rocks. Since joining Harrisburg, Lara has gone at least five innings in all but one start this year. In his first start against the Baysox, Lara threw five innings and gave up four runs on seven hits with seven strikeouts over three walks in a no decision. The Nationals No. 26 prospect signed as an international free agent from Coro, VZ for \$1.25 million.

2024: Received from Triple-A Norfolk on 8/6. Pitched in 10 games (3 starts) with Tides and recorded a 9.29 ERA in 31 IP with 28 K over 27 BB. Made Triple-A debut on 6/6 @ SWB. Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 6/4. Began season on Bowie Opening Day roster as a tandem reliever. Pitched in nine games and recorded a 3.30 ERA in 30 IP with 36 K and a 1.07 WHIP. Threw 12.0 consecutive scoreless innings to end month of May over final four outings. Has pitched 16.2 consecutive scoreless innings of relief on the road beginning on April 23. Enters second season with Baysox.

2023: Spent entire season with Double-A Bowie primarily as a starter. Threw third-most innings (79.2) and recorded third-most strikeouts (89) on the team. Gave up second-most home runs on team as well (15). Posted a 3.43 ERA on the road. Best month pitched was in July when he posted a 2.74 ERA in 23 IP. Pitched five innings in five outings. Struck out Double-A high 10 batters in four innings on 6/1/23 vs HBG.

2022: Spent entire season with High-A Aberdeen as a full-time starter. Was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month in May after recording a 0.49 ERA and holding opponents to a .098 average. Struck out 81 batters over 57.1 innings. Placed on the injured list two separate times after June before eventually being placed on the IL for remainder of season on 8/4.

2021: Debuted professionally with Single-A Delmarva. Pitched in six games (three starts) and struck out 13 batters over 12 innings.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 5th round of the 2021 Draft out of UT-Arlington. Pitched two seasons with the Mavericks, where he set a single-season program record for strikeouts as a junior in '21 with 117. Led Sun Belt Conference in strikeouts. Pitched nine no-hit innings as part of an 11-inning combined no-hitter against Little Rock on 5/1/22. Transferred to UT - Arlington from Weatherford College in 2020 after pitching at Weatherford for two seasons.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach
