NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 12 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 6 and split 2 ... the Storm Chasers have an 9-16 record over their last 25 games.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- The Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days this season at or above .500.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Storm Chasers have 20 comeback wins this season, while Omaha also has blown a lead in 22 losses.
- 20 comeback wins are the 7th-most in the International League, 11th in Triple-A ... 22 blown leads are the 4th-most in the league, 7th in Triple-A.
- The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 10 of their last 16 losses, including 3 games where the team led for over half the game.
- In the last 40 games (since May 9), Omaha is 19-21 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 13 of 19 wins and led at some point in 12 of 21 losses, meaning 25 of Omaha's last 40 games have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 28 of 40 games have been decided by 3 runs or less ... Omaha's 15 losses by 1 run are the most in Triple-A.

YOU GO, WE GO, LUGO

- Matthew Lugo** has been Omaha's best hitter in June since joining the Storm Chasers at the start of the month.
- Since the Royals claimed Lugo off waivers from the Angels on June 2, he has hit .358 (24-for-67) with 13 extra-base hits and 19 RBI in 16 games.
- Lugo's 1.111 OPS since June 2 (min. 60 PA) ranks 7th in the International League ... his 17 RBI in 13 games since June 9 are also the 5th-most in the IL in that stretch.
- Lugo has hits in 13 of 16 games with Omaha - including an extra-base hit in 10 of 16 - and has reached base in 14 of 16 ... he's driven in a run in 9 of 16 games.

JUNE BUGS

- Beyond the offensive success from **Matthew Lugo**, he's had good company in Omaha's lineup in the month of June.
- Abraham Toro** has hits in 15 of his 17 games in June, batting .348 (23-for-66) with 4 doubles, 3 triples, 5 homers and 19 RBI for a 1.130 OPS.
- Peyton Wilson** has hits in 12 of 16 games this month, batting .328 (22-for-67) in June with 9 doubles, 6 RBI and 7 walks for an .855 OPS.
- Since rejoining Omaha on June 18, **Brandon Drury** has hits in all 5 games he's played, hitting .526 (10-for-19) with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 6 RBI for a 1.591 OPS.

HONEST ABE

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- Since May 12, Toro's .339 average (37-for-109) is tied for the best among qualified hitters in the IL, ranking 2nd in OPS (1.049), 3rd in SLG (.633) and 9th in OBP (.416) ... his 30 RBI over 30 games since May 12 are tied 4th-most in the league.
- From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit just .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 21 of 30 games.

ST. PAUL SLUGGING

- The Storm Chasers' 15-12 win Sunday at CHS Field was one for the history books, both as a team and individually.
- Abraham Toro** hit for the 6th cycle in modern Omaha history on Sunday, finishing the day 5-for-6 with 6 RBI ... he singled in the 2nd inning, tripled in the 3rd, hit a 2-run homer in the 5th and connected for a go-ahead 3-run double in the 8th to finish his cycle, later adding an RBI single in the 10th ... Sunday was Toro's 3rd career 5-hit game, while 6 RBI and 11 total bases set a new career high.
- 15 runs and 24 hits as a team were season-highs for Omaha ... 24 hits ranked tied 6th-most in a game in modern Omaha history (since 2005), matching the Chasers' total from August 23, 2025 @ Columbus.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- + **Kris Bubic** was a first-time All-Star in **2025** with the Royals, recording a 2.55 ERA that ranked 4th in the American League (min. 20 starts).
- + Named American League Pitcher of the Month for May **2025**, during which he went 3-0 in 5 starts with an AL-best 0.56 ERA (2 ER in 32.1 IP)...it was the 3rd-best ERA in any month in Royals history (min. 5 starts).
- + Was limited to 46.1 regular season innings in the Majors from **2023-24** due to **Tommy John** Surgery... was reinstated from the Injured List on July 6, **2024**, 447 days after he was placed on the IL.
- + Made his Major League debut in **2020**, after recording just 187.1 innings over 36 starts in the minors...according to Royals Hall of Fame Director, **Curt Nelson**, Bubic became the seventh known player in club history (excluding Rule 5 picks) to make the jump from A-ball to the Majors.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- + Recorded 116.1 innings over 20 starts, surpassing his total from **2024**, when he pitched 70.2 innings (Majors and minors) in his return from **Tommy John** Surgery...the 116.1 innings in **2025** were his most since **2022**, when he threw 129.0 innings.
- + Allowed 3 runs or fewer in 16 of his 20 starts and had 6 starts of at least 5.0 scoreless innings.
- + One day after his start on July 26 (Game 2), he was placed on the Injured List with a left rotator cuff strain, ending his season.
- + Despite the injury, he set a career high with 8 wins and made 20 starts, his most since **2022** (27 starts).
- + Had 3 straight starts of 7.0 innings and 1 run or fewer from May 19-June 1, after which he owned a 1.43 ERA (12 ER in 75.1 IP) through 12 starts, which led the Majors and was the best mark through 12 starts of a season in franchise history.
- + Allowed just 6 home runs in 116.1 innings for a 0.46 HR/9, the lowest mark in the Majors (min. 20 starts)... he didn't allow more than 1 HR in any game and had a career-best 32.0-inning homerless streak from May 13-June 24.
- + Despite allowing only 6 HR, 12 of the 38 runs he allowed came via home runs (31.6%).

ADDITIONAL CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- + Bubic missed the 1st 90 games of the **2024** season while rehabbing an injury to his left elbow that required **Tommy John** Surgery in **2023**.

ADDITIONAL CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (CONT.)

- + He made 14 appearances (10 starts) in the minors while rehabbing the injury, and he posted a 3.53 ERA (14 ER in 35.2 IP) with 42 strikeouts and just 13 walks, making stops in the Arizona Complex League (3 starts), Double-A Northwest Arkansas (2 starts) and Triple-A Omaha (9 games, 5 starts).
- + He was reinstated off the Injured List on July 6, 447 days after he was initially placed on the IL, and made his return to a big league mound the next night at Colorado, logging a scoreless 9th inning.
- + Had 39 strikeouts and 5 walks in 30.1 innings for a 7.80 K/BB ratio, 4th best in the Majors (min. 30.0 IP).
- + He issued a walk to **Matt Chapman** with 2 outs in the 9th inning on Sept. 22, marking his 2nd unintentional walk of the season, and the 1st since July 20 vs. the White Sox (**Corey Julks**), snapping a streak of 92 consecutive batters.
- + Earned his 1st career save in his final appearance of the season on Sept. 29 at Atlanta.

KRIS BUBIC

ADDITIONAL CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (CONT.)

- + Finished the **2024** season with 30.1 innings pitched and 5 walks, 3 of which were intentional...he became just the third pitcher since 1955 to issue no more than 5 walks in a season—3 of which were intentional—(min. 30.0 IP), joining **Dan Otero** (2018) and **Dick Hall** (1968).
- + Added a slider to his repertoire in **2023** and held opponents to 2-for-14 (.182) with 6 strikeouts on that pitch through 3 starts, after which he underwent **Tommy John Surgery**.
- + In his 2nd start of the season on April 9 at San Francisco, he held the Giants to 2 hits over 6.0 scoreless innings and matched a career best with 9 strikeouts.
- + Bubic in **2022** tied **Daniel Lynch IV** for the team high with 27 starts, and for the second straight year he led the team in double plays induced (19).
- + Had a 13-start stretch from June 4-Aug. 10, **2022** in which he recorded a 3.59 ERA (29 ER in 72.2 IP), before going 0-7 over his next 7 starts.
- + On Aug. 21, **2021** at Wrigley Field, Bubic took a no-hit bid into the 7th inning...after he walked the second batter of the game, he retired the next 17, including 7 strikeouts in a nine-batter span...despite no raindrops falling, the game was interrupted by a 34-minute "rain" delay in the top of the 7th...once play resumed, he issued a walk to the first batter, followed by a 2-run HR.
- + Named Royals Pitcher of the Month for September/October **2021**, posting a 2.20 ERA (8 ER in 32.2 IP) in 6 appearances (5 starts) to mark the best ERA in September/October by a Royal (min. 5 starts) since **Zack Greinke** had a 1.38 ERA (6 ER in 39.0 IP) to end his 2009 **Cy Young** Award-winning season.

MINOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS

- + Led the minor leagues with 185 strikeouts in **2019**, a season in which he was named to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, a Carolina League postseason All-Star and a *Baseball America* High-A All-Star.

MINOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS (CONT.)

- + Named Advanced-A Wilmington Pitcher of the Year in **2019**, going 11-5 with a 2.23 ERA (37 ER in 149.1 IP) in 26 starts, including his time with Low-A Lexington.
- + Additional accolades in **2019** included being named the **Paul Splittorff** Pitcher of the Year, an MiLB.com Organization All-Star and the MiLB.com Fan Choice for Best Starting Pitcher.
- + Pitched back-to-back complete games in **2019**, on Aug. 8 and Aug. 15, including a 1-hit shutout in the latter, with the lone hit coming to begin the 9th inning.
- + Had 7 starts with at least 10 strikeouts in **2019**, including 12 strikeouts with Lexington on April 12.
- + Named a Pioneer League midseason All-Star in **2018**.

POSTSEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- + Bubic made 4 appearances during the **2024** postseason, and pitched in all 3 of Kansas City's wins.
- + Was credited with a hold in each of the Royals 3 wins, but suffered the loss in Game 3 of the ALDS vs. the Yankees, after he allowed a go-ahead, solo HR to **Giancarlo Stanton** in the 8th inning.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- + Kris resides in Cupertino, Calif.
- + Bubic pitches and bats left handed but does everything else right handed.
- + Since **2020**, he's donated proceeds from his Cameo account to Royals Charities (now The Kansas City Royals Foundation) and the Harvester Food Network.
- + Attended Stanford University, where he went 8-1 with a 2.62 ERA (25 ER in 86.0 IP) and 101 strikeouts in 15 starts as a junior in **2018** for the Pac-12 champions... named All-Pac-12 and was one of 40 players named to the Golden Spikes Award midseason Watch List.
- + Majored in communications at Stanford and aspires to one day be a sports color commentator.
- + Graduated from Archbishop Mitty HS (Calif.) in **2015**.
