LAST GAME

The Baysox salvaged a split in their series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels by taking the finale, 5-0, on Sunday afternoon. Billy Cook provided the big swing for the Bowie bats, as he launched a grand slam in the top of the third to get the Baysox on the board. Zach Watson would also score on a wild pitch later in the frame. On the mound, Connor Gillispie dominated, tossing five innings of two hit, shutout baseball, walking just a single batter and striking out a pair. The five innings from Gillispie is all Bowie would need, as the game went into a rain delay in the top of the sixth and be called as official shortly after.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter this weekend with a 42-39 overall record - 7-5 in the second half, which has them sitting in second place in the Southwest division second-half standings. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, Akron holds the third-best ERA (3.75) in the Eastern League this season, but has also committed the third-most errors (76), while hitting the fewest home runs (58) through 81 games. The RubberDucks' active roster is headlined by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, including IF Angel Martinez (No. 7 CLE), OF Petey Halpin (No. 13 CLE), IF Juan Brito (No. 14 CLE), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 18 CLE), IF Jose Tena (No. 19 CLE), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 26 CLE) and RHP Jack Leftwich (No. 28 CLE).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Ross Carver is set to get the ball in the opener of this short, three-game series for Akron. Despite allowing just a single home run with the RubberDucks in seven appearances (six starts), Carver has still struggled with consistent contact, yielding 20 hits and 15 earned runs in 21.1 innings. Carver spent time on the injured list following the end of April, missing almost two months before returning to Akron at the end of June following a pair of appearances with the ACL Guardians. Carver has allowed 10 runs in 8.2 innings in his three appearances since coming off the IL, but did throw four innings of one-run baseball in his most recent appearance on July 5 against Harrisburg. Carver did start against Bowie back on 4/14, allowing a pair of runs across four innings, including an RBI double to John Rhodes. Carver was originally a 20th round pick of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2021 out of Dallas Baptist. He was acquired by Cleveland in a trade with Arizona for RHP Carlos Vargas in November of 2022.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Tonight is the Double-A debut for the No. 1 overall prospect in baseball, per MLB Pipeline, Jackson Holliday. Last year's No. 1 overall draft pick has soared through the Orioles' system. This season, Holliday ranks top five in the system with a .331 average (2nd), .466 on-base percentage (1st), .523 slugging percentage (5th), .989 OPS (3rd), six triples (1st), and 64 walks (1st). Holliday's walk total and on-base percentage also rank fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. He is the second No. 1 overall prospect to don a Baysox uniform in quick succession, as Adley Rutschman (2021-22) also topped the prospect rankings during his time in Bowie. Holliday is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday. He is the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

SECOND HALF SLUMP??

Despite sitting just three games out in the Southwest division second-half standings, the Baysox are looking to buck some troubling trends that have persisted in the second stanza. Bowie has the highest staff ERA (4.98) and the lowest team average (.195) in the Eastern League in the second half. Part of that has stemmed from the pitching staff's struggle with the long ball. The Baysox have allowed 22 home runs through 12 contests in the second half - 10 more than any other team in the league. Offensively, Bowie has been plagued by a lack of timely hits thus far in 2023. The Baysox are hitting .230 this season with runners in scoring position - the third-lowest total in the Eastern League.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has enjoyed a breakout at the Double-A level in the summer months. Cook has hit .313 since the calendar flipped to June - third-highest average in the Eastern League among players with at least 100 at-bats. Cook's 16 extra-base hits in that stretch (nine doubles, five home runs) are also fifth-most in the league, while his 12 stolen bases in as many attempts are second-most. On Sunday, Cook launched his fifth career grand slam and his first at the Double-A level - part of a 10 RBI week. Cook currently leads active Baysox hitters in home runs (9), RBI (43), slugging (.431), OPS (.762), and stolen bases (17).

TANDEM TROUBLES

The abundance of starting pitching experience on the Bowie roster has led to a reliance on tandems at times this season. Despite a collective starters' ERA of 3.80 - best in the Eastern League, when Baysox starters enter the game as relievers, they sport a collective 5.76 ERA. Bowie has utilized a tandem in 40 games thus far in 2023, going 20-20 in those contests. Tuesday night was the seventh blown lead from the back end of a tandem for the Baysox this season and the fourteenth time a back-end tandem arm has allowed four runs or more in an outing.

- .206 opposing average was fifth lowest in the South Atlantic League at promotion.
- **2022:** Ninth-most innings, sixth-most starts and tenth-most strikeouts among the Orioles' system.
- Had a very up-and-down season. Began by surrendering 20 ER in 29 innings through April and May
- Bounced back with a 1.35 ERA in June. Allowed 13 ER across 18.2 innings in July, followed up by allowing just 3 ER in his final 24 innings of the season, including a 0.90 ERA in August.
- Struck out 11 in five, one run innings on August 18 vs Asheville – one of four outings with 8+ strikeouts last season.
- Made two starts for Aberdeen in the 2022 postseason, where he allowed four runs across 9.2 innings.
- Spent the first half of 2021 with the then-GCL Orioles. Accumulated a 1.80 ERA in 20 innings with 28 strikeouts to just four walks, before being promoted to Single-A Delmarva on July 27.
