NATURALS WIN HIGH-SCORING AFFAIR:

NATURALS WIN HIGH-SCORING AFFAIR:

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals' four-run first inning provided the difference on Thursday, capturing a 10-7 win over the Frisco RoughRiders at Riders Field. Keyber Rodriguez launched a three-run home run and doubled to keep the RoughRiders (30-30, 61-67) close, Jax Biggers added a solo blast and Kellen Strahm chipped in a triple and a double, but Frisco could not overcome the early margin. Northwest Arkansas (29-30, 58-70) planted six runs on the board over the first two innings and never relinquished the lead.

Seth Nordlin (2-6) took the loss with seven earned runs over four innings. Strahm helped get the Riders on the board by tripling to lead off the second inning. He scored on Chris Seise's RBI infield single. Frisco trailed 8-1 in the fourth but rebounded with a three-run home run by Rodriguez. He culminated a two-out rally that started with David Garcia and Josh Hatcher's walks. Hatcher then recorded a two-RBI single the next inning, bouncing a ball off of the second-base bag to bring in Strahm and Seise. Biggers' solo blast to right field in the seventh inning was his 12th homer of the year. Biggers has hit 12 of his 20 career home runs in 2023, his fifth professional baseball season. Emilio Marquez (1-0) garnered the win with two unearned runs over one inning. Anderson Paulino took the save by going 1-2-3 in the ninth. Frisco's bullpen covered five innings with one earned run, highlighted by Robby Ahlstrom's two perfect innings. He struck out three, and Danny Duffy tossed a clean ninth inning with one punch out.

West Come, what I:

Wyatt Langford, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday.

THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER:

On Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that No. 1 prospect and former RoughRiders outfielder Evan Carter was called up to the Major League roster. A second-round selection in 2020 by the Rangers out of Elizabethton High School in Elizabethton, Tennessee, Carter spent the last week of 2022 and the playoffs with Frisco before beginning the season with the RoughRiders in 2023. During the 2022 season, he won the Tom Grieve Texas Rangers Minor League Player of the Year award, batting .295/.397/.489/.886 with 21 doubles, 10 triples, 12 home runs and 28 steals over 106 games. In 97 games with the RoughRiders in 2023, Carter hit .284/.411/.451/.862 with 15 doubles, six triples, 12 home runs, 62 runs, 74 walks, 68 runs scored and 22 steals. When he was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock, Carter was second in the Texas League in walks (74) and on-base percentage (.411) while he was sixth in OPS (.862).

BROKEN BATS:

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.5 runs per game, a .237 batting average and 20 home runs over their 33 games. The 20 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in six of the last 12 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 96 over their 128 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.370/.435/.805 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 639 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .355 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: Evan Carter (74, 5th), Trevor Hauver (71, 6th), Kellen Strahm (68, 8th) and Aaron Zavala (68, 8th). In 2015, Drew Robinson set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 133. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 42 games, Hicks is batting .299 (43-for-144)/.418/.389/.807 with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 22 RBIs, 24 walks and 18 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on August 17th in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 11 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trey Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

DEDEDTAIDE

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning completegame, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a $1.28\,$ ERA over $10\,$ outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house.'

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
