### Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP Trenton Denholm to the mound today, looking to salvage a series split. Worcester will counter with LHP Payton Tolle. Columbus is 1-3 (.250) versus left handers this year. Tolle has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, as today will be just his 6th game in Triple-A (debut was on 8/10/25).

### vs. the Red Sox

Against the WooSox, Columbus is 13-9 all-time and, dating to August of 2014, Columbus has pounded Boston's Triple-A affiliate 38-22. This week marks the fourth trip to Massachusetts in as many seasons, as the Red Sox have still not been to Columbus since moving from Pawtucket. Kody Huff has gone 12x38 (.316) with 9RBI against Worcester in his career (10G).

### Sunday Scaries

Columbus was 6-19 on Sundays last season (lost 11 of 13 in the second half), the worst record in minor league baseball (Rocket City was 7-19; Rochester was 2nd worst in the IL, 9-17). The Clippers were outscored 143-107 on Sundays last year, despite a positive HR differential (+4, 23-19). They are 1-1 this season, using a 9th inning comeback to take down Iowa at the end of March.

### Walk Before You Run

This week's matchup features the top two in the IL in walks, with Worcester (94) outpacing Columbus (90, no other IL team has more than 74BB; Columbus +5 this week). Both offenses rank among the top five in the IL in scoring with the Sox plating the most (89) and Clippers checking in at 5th (81). The Clippers have turned in a .351OBP this week, hitting just .250 (.158, 15x95, Wednesday-Friday).

### Could Have Been Worse

Columbus kept Worcester off the board last night, holding the Red Sox hitless with runners in scoring position (6AB; 1x17 on Friday, 1x10 on Wednesday). The series numbers stand at .164 (9x55) with 43LOB. However, Columbus is 2-3 this week despite that success (went 6-3 through first 9G, allowing opponents to hit .295 with RISP). Clipper batters are 13x52 (.250) with RISP this week (0x10 yesterday).

### Left Behind

Today will mark the fifth time this year that Columbus will face off against a southpaw starter (33G last year) and, even with a left-heavy lineup, Columbus is slashing .260/.373/.340 (5th, 5th and 12th in the IL) with 1HR in 100AB. Last season, 19.9% of Clipper PA came against lefties (7th highest rate in the IL) and they hit .228/.307/.390 in such situations (worst average and OBP, 7th worst SLG).

### George Town

George Valera was the King of Worcester on Tuesday night, tying a career high with 6RBI (6/25/19 with Mahoning Valley) on four singles and a couple sac flies. His 2-run homer Friday gave him a team-high 11RBI on the year, even though he has played in only half the games for the Clippers. Dating to the 2024 All-Star Break, he is hitting .275/.352/.511 with 15HR and 46RBI in 75G for Columbus.

### Big Dog

Nolan Jones saw his 15G hit streak with the Clippers snapped on Sunday (dated to 9/21/22, hit .352, 19x54, with 6HR, .778SLG, and 16RBI over the stretch). Including his time in Albuquerque, he is slashing .326/.444/.660 with 22HR and 76RBI over his last 78G in Triple-A, having reached base in 71 of them (has 21 hitless games). He has also scored 72 times and gone perfect in steal attempts (5).

### Delayed Start

Kody Huff was 1x8 with 5K in March (2G), but has rebounded to hit in each of 9G during April (.324, 11x34), drawing 8BB to 6K. He has 9RBI this month, including an RBI streak of 4G from 4/3-4/8 (8RBI total, multi-RBI in 3G). Huff has gone 5x15 (.333) with runners in scoring position, following a 2025 in which he batted .299 (hit .193 in all other situations), but is hitting .222 (2x9) off LHP.

### Free For All

Clipper backstops have allowed 11SB in the last 4G (11SB in first 10G), while catching just a pair of runners (had 4CS in first 10G). Through the first two weeks of the season, none of three Clipper catchers have had a passed ball, but each of the three has committed a throwing error on a steal attempt (Kody Huff has twice). Among the IL, Columbus has allowed the 5th most steals (22, -6 from the top).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

4/12/2018

**Adam Plutko** (7.0IP, 1H, 8K) and **Jeff Beliveau** (2.0IP, 3K) combined for a 2-0 victory over Durham at Huntington Park.

The win was the first of a breakout season that saw Plutko go 7-3 with a 1.70ERA in 14GS, including a bid at perfection on 4/28 vs. Indianapolis (retired all 23 batters faced, relieved due to pitch count) and a no-hitter at Syracuse on 6/2 (lost perfect game with one out in the 8th).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,409 to 1,355).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-16 at home (.619, but 4-6 in last 10G). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

## Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

## Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Milan Tolentino** moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 394-412 (.489), 364-366 with Columbus (.498).
