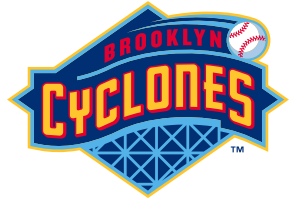

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones earned their second-straight victory with a 6-4 comeback win over the Blue Rocks on Tuesday evening...Brooklyn erased a 4-0 deficit entering the 5th and a 4-1 margin going into the 7th...Clones grabbed the lead in the 8th on a bases-loaded walk to SS **César Berbesi**, an RBI infield single from 3B **Junior Tilién**, and a sacrifice fly by LF **Rhyan Thomas**...C **Drake Osborn** capped a 3-hit night with an RBI single in the 9th...Tilién, Thomas, and 1B **Mateo Gil** each composed multi-hit games...Gil doubled and tripled...2B **Darren Baker** collected 3 hits for Wilmington, while 1B **T.J. White** garnered a double, triple, and an RBI...LHP **Quinn Brodey** tossed 2.0 spotless innings of relief to earn his first professional win...RHP **Paul Gervase** hoisted a scoreless 9th inning to collect his 3rd save...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** permitted 4 runs (3 earned) over 6.0 innings and was credited with a quality start...RHP **Kyle Luckham** registered 6.0 frames for 1-run ball for the 'Rocks.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 11th come-from-behind victory of the 2023 season with a 6-4 win over Wilmington on Tuesday...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory, matching their largest deficit erased on the campaign...The 'Clones erased a 4-0 margin entering the 5th and a 4-1 deficit going into the 7th...Brooklyn also erased a 4-run ledger on Opening Day — April 7 — vs. Jersey Shore...The Cyclones trailed 4-0 after the 1st inning that day, ultimately topping the BlueClaws, 9-8, in 11 innings.

STU-PENDOUS: RHP **Tyler Stuart** tossed 7.0 more innings of 1-run ball in his last start on June 29 vs. Jersey Shore, earning his 3rd win...He set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), in his start on June 22 vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old was the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Stuart was also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP **Conner Grey** tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum was the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP **Kevin Canelon** whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.42)...Triple-A Durham's LHP **Jacob Lopez** (1.78) is 2nd in the minors...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (89.1%), is 3rd in FIP (3.05) and WHIP (1.06), 4th in xFIP (3.41) and batting average against (.206), 5th in innings pitched (69.2), 7th in strikeouts (28.4%), tied for 8th in strikeouts (79), and 9th in walk rate (7.9%).

PITCHING IN: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has posted an MLB-low 2.72 ERA (115 ER in 381.0 IP) over their last 44 games, holding a 24-20 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (2.75) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 5 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.1% and a walk rate of 11.5%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted the fewest home runs (12), are tied for the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.78), and hold the 4th lowest opposing OPS (.601) in that time period...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (1.34) and **Tyler Stuart** (1.43) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 40.0 IP).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.16) in the entire South Atlantic League, and 3rd lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East leads (3.09) in MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.45) is 2nd in the circuit...RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.07) is 1st and RHP **Wilkin Ramos** (2.75) is 7th in ERA among SAL relievers (min. 30.0 IP).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville, and has tossed 7-straight scoreless outings since that date (12.0 IP)...Gervase averages 13.90 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.9% strikeout rate for the season...Since June 9, the numbers have ballooned to 16.50 K/9 and a 44.9% strikeout rate.

CAPTAIN KEVIN: C **Kevin Parada** has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .309/.371/.593 with a .963 OPS and 158 wRC+ in 21 games...Parada has accrued 11 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 17 RBI, 7 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...The Pasadena, Calif. native had a 10-game hitting streak (15-for-39; .385/.429/.821) and a 15-game on-base streak (.333/.397/.632) snapped on Saturday...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Wednesday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (16), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (28), 7th in total bases (115), and tied for 7th in hits (67).

AL-WAYS ON: OF **Alex Ramírez** is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in walks (19), tied for 4th in runs scored (19), and 6th in pitches-per-plate appearance (4.202) since the beginning of June...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Wednesday, the Dominican native is 4th in franchise history in RBI (68) and is 23 behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark and is tied with IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** (68) for 3rd...He is also 3rd in doubles (28), tied for 4th in hits (123) and tied for 5th in total bases (183).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** finished the 2-week homestand on a tear for the 'Clones offensively...Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .333/.419/.815 with a 1.234 OPS and 220 wRC+ over his last 8 games...Lugo is 9-for-27 at the plate (.333) with 2 doubles, a triple, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, 3 walks, and a hit-by-pitch in that span...The Dominican native has raised his season batting average by 22 points (.181 to .203) during that time.

O SAY, CONSUEGRA: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has pummeled the ball since returning from the injured list prior to the Jersey Shore series...The 22-year-old has picked up a base hit in 5-of-6 games played...4 of his 5 hits have gone for extra bases...Consuegra is 5-for-22 at the dish (.227) but has scored 3 times, collected 2 doubles, 2 home runs, and garnered 5 RBI...Since his return on June 29, the right-handed slugger holds a .831 OPS and a 103 wRC+ with an ISO of .364.

vs. WILMINGTON: After a 2-week homestand, the Cyclones open up a 6-game road trip against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS **Brady House** (3), LHP **Jake Bennett** (8), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (10), OF **T.J. White** (12), and RHP **Andry Lara** (15)...C **Israel Pineda** (19) and 2B **Darren Baker** (28) are on rehab assignments...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Frawley Stadium since May 9-14...Wilmington captured 5-of-7 games...In 2023, the Cyclones are 5-8 against the Blue Rocks through 2+ series...Dating back to 2021, the 'Clones are 31-32 (.492) all-time against the 'Rocks.

MARATHON MEN: Brooklyn is in the midst of their longest stretch without an off day for the 2023 season...The Cyclones will play 12 games in 12 days from Wednesday, June 28, until Sunday, July 9...Brooklyn completes their 2-week homestand with a 6-game series at Maimonides Park vs. Jersey Shore until Monday, July 3...The 'Clones will then travel south to Wilmington for a 6-game set at Frawley Stadium against the Blue Rocks starting on Tuesday, July 4...So far, Brooklyn is 4-3 during the stretch...Following the 12 games in 12 days, Brooklyn will have a 4-day break for the Major League All-Star Game before returning to Coney Island on Friday, July 14, to open up a brief 3-game home series vs. Greensboro.

LUCKY NUMBER SEVEN: Last Thursday and Friday, RHP **Tyler Stuart** and RHP **Blade Tidwell** became the first pair of Cyclones starters to toss 7.0-plus innings in consecutive games during the 2022 season...It was the first time Brooklyn had their starting pitcher toss 7.0-full frames in consecutive contests since three arms did it in three-straight days in 2022...RHP **Luis Moreno** (September 7), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (September 8), and RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (September 9) all went 7.0 frames in the final series of the regular season at Winston-Salem.

BEND, BUT NO TE-BRAKE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 12 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.23 ERA (3 ER in 22.0 IP) on 10 hits and 10 walks, registering 34 strikeouts (13.91 K/9)...That equates to a 39.5 K% (34/86) and 11.6 BB% (10/86)...Since moving to a relief role, Tebrake is 2nd among SAL relievers (min. 18.0 IP) in opposing OPS (.391) and hits-per-9 innings (4.09), tied for 2nd in strikeouts (34), and 4th in WHIP (0.91), ERA (1.23), and strikeouts-per-9 innings (13.91).

TURNING THE TID-E: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old has tossed 3-straight quality starts dating back to June 17 at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in all 3 outings, permitting just 2 run on 10 hits over 20.0 innings...He has walked only 4 (5.6 BB%) and struck out 26 (36.6 K%) in those contests...He whiffed a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 on Friday vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 8 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 5-0 with a 1.34 ERA (6 ER in 40.1 IP) with just 20 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 24 and struck out 59 (36.6 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .146 batting average (20-137) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.146) and is 2nd in strikeouts (59) and ERA (1.34) since that date (min. 30.0 IP)...On the season, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 5th in strikeouts (86) and tied for 5th in wins (5).

OH MY, OMAR: OF **Omar De Los Santos** has 29 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 99 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (105), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (103), and D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (100) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 58 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 41...Omar is already 3 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: RF **Omar De Los Santos** provided Brooklyn their 6th walk-off win of 2023, scoring on a wild pitch in June 25's victory vs. Hudson Valley...DH **Kevin Parada** delivered a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C **José Mena**'s added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B **Chase Estep** provided a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramírez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** garnered a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 6 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after June 16's loss at Aberdeen...20.0% (15-of-75) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 22.5% (9-of-40) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...34.7% (26-of-75) have been determined by just 1 run.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (15), RHP **Christian Scott** (16), and RHP **Tyler Stuart** (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (19), RHP **José Butto** (23), RHP **Luis Montas** (24), OF **Rowdy Jordan** (25), and RHP **Matt Allan** (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.
