YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 6-4, in the series opener at The Diamond. Erie's Dylan Rosa led off the game with a solo homer to put the SeaWolves ahead, 1-0, in the first. He added an RBI single in the second to open a 2-0 lead. In the bottom of the second, **Shane Matheny** drove in a run with a single and **Brett Auerbach** hit a two-run single to give Richmond a 3-2 lead. Erie tied the score in the third with a solo homer by Kerry Carpenter, his 20th of the season. The Flying Squirrels reclaimed the lead in the bottom of the fifth with an RBI single by **Frankie Tostado**. **Mike Gigliotti** hit a solo homer, his third of the season, in the seventh to extend the lead to 5-3. Luis Carpio closed the gap to one run with an RBI single in the top of the eighth. Matheny added an insurance run for Richmond with a single in the eighth. **R.J. Dabovich** picked up his fourth save of the season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the second series between the two teams this year. From April 20-24, the Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six at UPMC Park in Erie. The two teams will meet again for a six-game series at The Diamond from September 13-18 to close the regular season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won six-of-eight games after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won four-of-six on the road at Akron, knocking the RubberDucks out sole possession of first place. The Flying Squirrels have won five series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 568 strikeouts. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 224 walks issued. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 0.79 ERA (2 ER/22.2 IP) over the last seven games since May 31.

THE SEAWOLVES have gone 13-5 since May 19 and are tied for first place in the Southwest Division with Akron, one game ahead of Richmond. Erie has won each of its last three series against New Hampshire, at Bowie and at home against Harrisburg. On the year, the Erie pitching staff has a 3.58 ERA, which is second in the EL. Erie's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Dillon Dingler (3), Gage Workman (10), Wilmer Flores (14), Reese Olson (16), Parker Meadows (18), Andre Lipcius (24) and Austin Bergner (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Bryan Brickhouse** makes his 11th start of the season and second against the SeaWolves. He last pitched in the second game of a doubleheader on Friday in Akron and surrendered four runs over five innings in a win. He has faced the SeaWolves one previous time this year, working 5.2 innings and allowed five runs in a loss on April 22 in Erie. Brickhouse was signed as a free agent with a non-roster invitation to spring training by the Giants on December 15, 2021. Last year, Brickhouse signed with the Los Angeles Dodgers and spent the season with Double-A Tulsa, making 10 starts and nine relief outings. He was originally drafted by the Kansas City Royals in 2011 and retired in 2017 after battling injuries. He returned to the field in the 2018 season. **For more on Brickhouse, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Chance Kirby makes his fifth start of the season and his 13th overall appearance. Last time out, Kirby allowed two runs over a season-high six innings against Harrisburg on Thursday at UPMC Park, picking up his second straight win. He began the year as a reliever for the SeaWolves and has posted a 1.31 ERA in eight bullpen outings this year. As a starter, Kirby is 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA in four starts with 21 strikeouts and three walks. Kirby was selected in the 25th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Hyde Park High School in Austin, Texas. He began the 2021 season with the High-A West Michigan Whitecaps before earning a promotion to Double-A Erie in June. With the SeaWolves, he went 4-2 with a 5.51 ERA in 11 outings (seven starts). Kirby was sent back to High-A in August for the end of the season.

#WINNING: The Flying Squirrels have posted their best record in franchise history through 52 games at 29-23, ahead of the previous best of 28-24, which was set in 2013, 2014 and 2018. The Flying Squirrels' best start through 53 games is 29-24, which was set in 2013 and 2014 and can be surpassed with a win tonight.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (5,987) and rank second in total attendance (149,676). Richmond is 10th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 65 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (75). **Sean Roby** is third in the league with 13 homers on the season, with 10 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 173 home runs.

FITZ ON FIRE: After opening the season hit .162 through May 26, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is batting .406 (13-for-32) with three homers, five doubles and seven RBIs over his last nine games since May 27. On May 29, Fitzgerald homered twice and tied a single-game franchise record with five hits. He also set new single-game franchise records with five runs scored and 13 total bases. He hit his seventh home runs of the season in the second game of Friday's doubleheader at Akron.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1 **Shane Matheny** is batting .343 (25-for-73) with five homers, four doubles, a triple and 17 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. Matheny is currently riding an 11-game hitting streak dating back to May 14, during which he is batting .417 (15-for-36). He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 29 and reinstated on Tuesday. In his return, he picked up a pair of RBI singles.

ARMANI ARRIVES: **Armani Smith** hit .429 (6-for-14) with a triple and two walks in his four games played in last week's series at Akron. After going hitless in his Double-A debut on May 15, Smith has picked up at least one hit in nine-of-his-last-12 games played. During that 12-game span since May 17, Smith is batting .222 (15-for-45) with two doubles, a triple, three RBIs, six runs scored and five walks.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last 20 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .315 (23-for-73) with five homers, four doubles, three triples and 15 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer last Tuesday at Akron in a 3-2 win and drove in the go-ahead run in last Thursday's 8-4 win over the 'Ducks.

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** is batting .338 (49-for-145) with seven homers, eight doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs over his last 38 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. On May 11, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 40 of his 48 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked second in batting average (.322), 10th in OPS (.873), second in hits (59) and third in total bases (93).

ROBUST: With his three-run homer on Friday in Game 2 of the doubleheader in Akron, **Sean Roby** held his spot in third in the league with 13 home runs this season. With two homers on Sunday against Hartford, he set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. He has hit 10 homers at The Diamond this season, which is tied for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history with **Adam Duvall** (2013). Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking four in his last nine games since May 26.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked second in batting average (.322), 10th in OPS (.873), second in hits (59) and third in total bases (93). **Sean Roby** is third in home runs (13). **Brandon Martorano** is seventh in SLG (.522). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for third in saves (6). **Jake Dahlberg** is seventh in ERA (3.55) and tied for first in winning percentage (.750). **Taylor Rashi** is tied for fourth in games pitched (18). **Kai-Wei Teng** is first in games started (11).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: In the Eastern League, Kerry Carpenter is first in batting average (.328), first in homers (20), first in RBIs (42), first in SLG (.718), first in OPS (1.106), first in extra-base (29), first in total bases (127), second in runs (38) and third in hits (58). Quincy Nieporte is tied for fourth in homers (12) and sixth in SLG (.535). Gage Workman is tied for third in doubles (14) and fifth in stolen bases (15). Andre Lipcius is seventh in OBP (.402) and fourth in walks (37).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Will Wilson** (16), **R.J. Dabovich** (17) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Wilson (21), **Brett Auerbach** (27) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
