RIDERS FALL IN HOME REGULAR SEASON FINALE TO WICHITA:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Wichita Wind Surge 4-2 on Sunday evening from Riders Field. Wichita (25-38, 56-76) found the run column first in the top of the third inning against Frisco (36-27, 80-52) starter **Kohl Drake** when Jorel Ortega delivered a leadoff solo homer to give the Wind Surge a 1-0 lead. In the home half of the fifth inning, **Keyber Rodriguez** singled before coming around to score on a triple by **Theo Hardy**. **Alejandro Osuna** gave the RoughRiders a 2-1 advantage with an RBI double. Drake finished after 5.0 innings, allowing just one run on one hit and two walks while fanning six Wichita hitters. **Skylar Hales** and **Nick Krauth** combined for a pair of scoreless innings, surrendering just one hit and two walks to preserve the Riders lead. The Wind Surge evened the game in the top of the eighth inning against **Ricky DeVito**. Kala'i Rosario opened the inning with a single before a pair of walks and a hit-by-pitch allowed him to tie the game. **Dane Acker** entered the game and on his first pitch induced a 5-4-3 inning ending double play. In the top of the tenth inning, **Larson Kindreich** issued a leadoff walk before a two-run double by Jake Rucker allowed the automatic runner and the walk to score. The lefty settled in to strike out the side, keeping it a 6-4 deficit. The RoughRiders went down in order in the bottom of the tenth inning, falling 6-4 in the series finale. Offensively, the Riders collected five hits as Osuna picked up the lone multi-hit game. Frisco went just 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Riders infielder **Max Acosta** has been en fuego at the plate, hitting .314 (50-for-159)/.383/.484/.867 over his last 41 games. In his last 28 games, he is hitting .327 (36-for-110)/.402/.509/.911. Acosta now has a career-best in all slashline categories and is one of five qualified players in the Texas League this year who is 21-year-old or younger.

THOSE ROUGHRIDERS ARE SO HOT RIGHT NOW:

The RoughRiders have been playing well recently, winning 12 of their last 17 games. In the 17 games, Frisco is second in the Texas League in runs per game (4.9) and second in OPS (.735) while hitting 18 home runs in the 17 games. The RoughRiders are within reach of both the franchise records for most wins (85, 2007) and best winning percentage (.607, 2007). The Riders need to finish 4-2 in their last six games to get the winning percentage record and 5-1 to tie their wins record.

HATCHIN HOMERS:

Josh Hatcher has been one of the hotter hitters in the Texas League recently, batting .333/.396/.469/.865 over his last 37 games with eight doubles, four home runs and 20 RBIs. In his last 10 games, he is hitting .375 (15-for-40)/.432/.550/.982 with four doubles, one home run, six RBIs, six runs scored.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 43 games, Ortiz is hitting .294/.388/.521/.909 with eight doubles, nine home runs, 30 RBIs, 29 runs scored and 24 walks. Since July 10th, in those 42 games, he is fifth in average (.294), fourth in OPS (.909), third in RBIs (30), fifth in home runs (nine) and third in runs scored (29). In his last 24 games, he is batting .326 (29-for-89)/.439/.596/1.035 with four doubles, six home runs, 22 RBIs, 17 walks, 21 strikeouts and 19 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .284 with an .868 OPS, raising his batting average to .229 and a .707 OPS.

HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 24 home runs in the last 21 games, with those 24 home runs being second in the Texas League over the last 21 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 100 across their 132 games (on pace for 105, which would be for the 12th in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders were fantastic at home this year, going 44-24 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco had a +69 run differential, a 3.88 ERA and is averaging 5.2 runs per game with a .743 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 36-28 with a 3.46 ERA, but a +28 run differential while averaging 4.1 runs per game and owning a .659 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 14 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .303/.392/.524/.916 at home as opposed to .147/.223/.253/.476 on the road.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.
